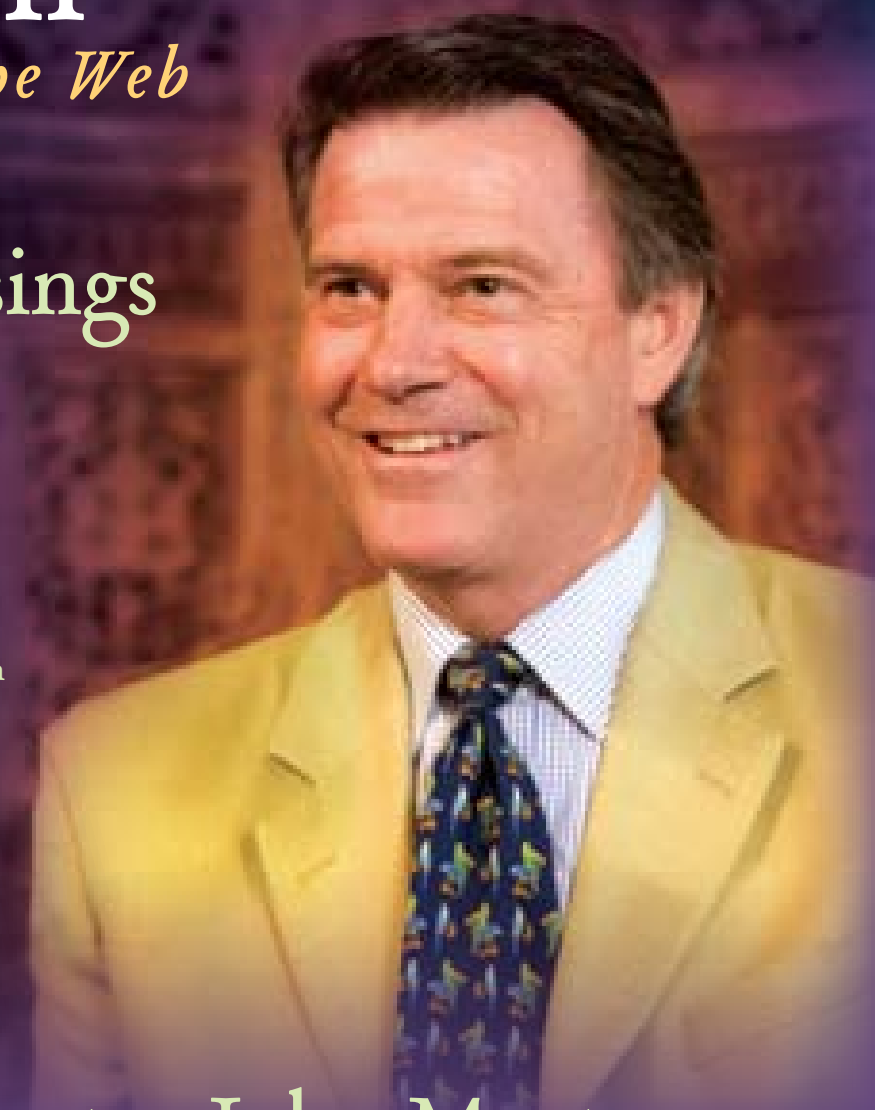

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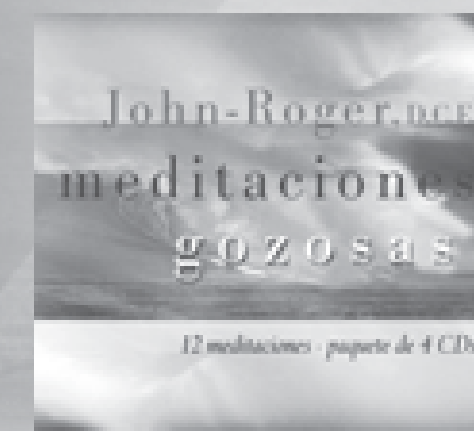

RESPONSIBLE CREATIVITY

(This article recently appeared in the 2013 Windermere calendar.)

We're going to come here and renew and regenerate ourselves in peace, love, and Spirit and also share it with those around us.



I have said that we were reaching a critical mass of energy, with more people coming onto the land at Windermere to make it start to move. I want to tell you that we reached that. And we're going to come here and renew and regenerate ourselves in peace, love, and Spirit and also share it with those around us. People who fight against us are going to be fighting against themselves because in order to go into negativity, they have to sit there with it until they get sick and tired of being negative.

A lot of people in the Santa Barbara area have gone up to Windermere and said, "I had the most wonderful experience." They say things like, "I walked down to see the horses, and one of the horses came up to see me. I've never been anyplace where a horse would just come up to you to see you." One person went for a walk on a trail, and a horse walked with her. It's not every day that you get to go for a walk on a trail and have a horse accompany you, unless you've got a rope around its neck.

We had a person come up to the ranch who could be considered "mentally handicapped." The staff told me that the person was walking around the horses and that the horses were watching out for this person so they wouldn't get hurt. It's strange to think of horses as babysitters, but this person does have a very childlike consciousness. The staff realized that the horses were concerned about the person and that they were passing the

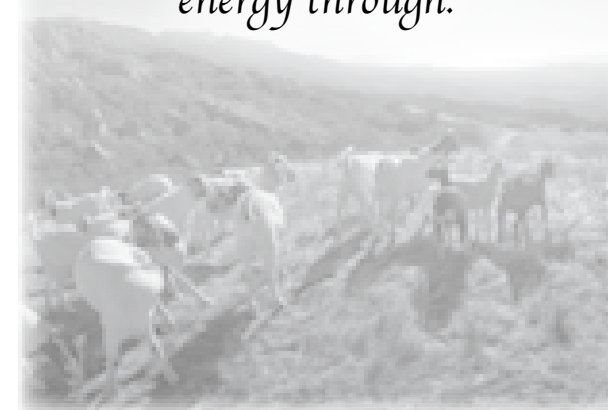
person off from one horse to another. A couple of the horses the person walked around were ones that I wouldn't walk behind unless I was very far away, because that horse might back up and kick me.

It's wonderful to hear the things people tell me about what goes on up at Windermere. Some part of me goes, "That's just got to be nonsense." Then I go back up to the ranch, come onto the land, and start to renew the energy fields in my body with the vibration there. I look at the horses, and, sure enough, they're busy taking care of whoever is around.

People come up to Windermere and volunteer to train our horses, but in other places people have to be paid to train them. And they do such a great job. I look at the person training the horse and say, "Wow, you train the horse really well. Why can't you do that to yourself?"

When you start to look back at the energy field of what a horse represents and what a human being represents, you may come to some really unusual ideas about what a horse is and what it is thinking or doing. We've watched horses figure out how to open and close gates, how to untie knots, how to find the way over a trail or around a rock that we can't climb over. They can make you believe one day that they know what's going on, and the next day you do the same thing with them and come up against the dumbest horse in the universe. Then the next day it's the smartest horse in the universe. It's amazing to watch them

find out where you are in your strength and then push, to see if you'll fall over or not. Does that sound anything at all like human beings in relationships?

In the ancient times of the 12 tribes of Israel, they would fight about how "our tribe's better than your tribe" and "our God's better than your God." It's all the same God, but people sometimes think they have to be "special" in order to be special. Actually, I've found that you have to be ordinary to be special because if you're special you're off by yourself, wondering why you're so alone and alienated, why nothing's happening, and why life is terrible for you. Then you become ordinary, and you're invited to everything. But if you start to make yourself special again, you get separated out again.

We've noticed that with our horses at Windermere. When we see one or two of them get special, they will be pushed out to the edge of the herd and made to stay there until they realize they're a horse like the other horses. One very interesting horse was at the bottom of the pecking order (or with horses it might be the kicking order, the bucking order, the biting order, or the rearing-up order). We worked to train her to carry a person so that she knew the relationship of responsibility with a human being. No one from the ranch has written

to me about this horse being outcast or being away from the group, even though she still has some of the same nagging personality problems. Even though she has the same patterns, she is respecting herself in a different way, so the pattern is acceptable.

That's a big key to your spirituality through your self-esteem: what you do in this world comes back to your personality through your self-esteem; it goes back in and touches the Soul and pulls the Spirit energy through. If you do the same thing without being in spiritual alignment, you get thrown out.

Humans are going to come to the place where we stop thinking that we own this planet. We have to reframe a lot of things that are presently going on in our society. We have to reframe our thought patterns and positions. Where does the reframing start? I'll bet that everybody could say, "Look at what all those dumb, stupid people are doing! Look at those no-growth people, those polluters, those business people who only care about a dollar. Look at all this food that's a little old, and they're dumping it out in the fields rather than selling it at a reduced rate." We run down the list, and after we've done that and been righteously indignant and really upset, we go home to our loved ones and carry the

vibration into them. And, someplace inside of them, they're thinking, "God, I was feeling so good until you came home."

We have to stop making other people bad, and we have to bring ourselves into the position of monitoring our thought process. In other words, I can't put the responsibility of my existence onto anyone else. I can request things from them, I can ask them to participate, I can present myself for opportunities, but it's always from the point of view of me and my responsibility. When I've done that, I've always been at peace. It's when we start to range way out there about what the future will be that we fog up and go into negative talk. It isn't extremely negative; it's just not focused in a positive direction. That sets up the

winds of our own karmas to start to flow, and peace whips right away from us.

As individuals, we have to come back to responsible creativity in ourselves. One place to start is by trying to get some peace and calm. Every time I've been at Windermere, I have never had an anxiety attack, even walking behind or close by the horses. I have concern, caring, watchfulness, and protection, but I don't have any anxiety or panic.

Windermere is not "J-R's thing". I didn't buy the ranch. I didn't buy the horses; they were given to me, and I gave them to the ranch. They're all there for you people, because I can only ride one horse at a time.

People are coming more and more awake that we're all tied in together, even into the horses and the dogs, and we're learning how to get the information from them and how to become more grateful and thoughtful about ourselves here and now. We're going to make mistakes along the way. In fact, we've probably made some that we don't know about, but they'll be pointed out to us, and

that's nice because we'll make the correction and keep moving. The only way out is to go through it, and we will go through it.

And we want your support—through prayers, Light, money, being physically involved in the processes at the ranch. All of that helps. Even a random thought during the day of "God bless Windermere and the Peace Institute" does remarkable things. On the subtle levels, it is so powerful. It's like the light of ten million Roman candles going off in one area: it's total white-out. And it takes a long time for the negative stuff to come back in because it can only be Light to exist there. So I want you to know that what you do is really important.

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Weathering Life's Storms

with Spirit

In the "Eye of the Storm" there is a perfect calm. As you move from the outer edges of a storm and closer to the center of that energy, what's referred to as the vortex, the energy gets very powerful. Then the further away you get, the energy decreases. But in the actual point of the greatest power which is in the very center of the storm, it's calm and peaceful.

One of the ways you can recognize your connection with the Spirit is right in the very core of your being, in the very center, it's calm and peaceful.

On the physical level, everyone that embodies here is subject to the conditions of this world. Nobody is exempt. No matter how highly involved a person becomes, we're all still subject to what's here in this world. Spirit can intercede on our behalf and provide for a greater protection so that we're allowed to pass through this level with only the kind of interference that's necessary for our learning and growth as souls.

When we call ourselves forward into the Light, we ask for Spirit's protection and for the Light to fill and surround us. The Light places an energy with us so that we can open up to our experiences with a kind of immunity. We can know we are walking in the light of Spirit's protection while we navigate our way through life's challenges.

This physical level is designed for us to do things, to be involved. If we didn't do things here, we'd start decreasing. Consider what would happen to us if we didn't move physically, not just for hours but for days. We would experience atrophy.

When we exercise our physical attributes, we experience our abilities. We feel good. We strengthen. And if we do it too much, we experience over-exertion. We can get sick and stressed out. So there's a balancing needed. We seek to balance ourselves.

Some recent storms, including hurricanes and cyclones, resulted in a lot of physical damage to areas on the planet. Yet in the very center of the storms, which we call the "Eye of the Storm," there is a perfect calm. As you move from the outer edges of a storm and closer to the center of that energy, what's referred to as the vortex, the energy gets very powerful. Then the further away you get, the energy decreases. But in the actual point of the greatest power which is in the very center of the storm, it's calm and peaceful.

One of the ways you can recognize your connection with the Spirit is right in the very core of your being, in the very center, it's calm and peaceful. It's also silent. It can seem as if nothing's going on because of how still and peaceful it is in that center. Within each of us is a vortex where all of our levels of consciousness incorporate. That center is the force of life. If scientists attempt to dissect us physically in order to find that force of life, they won't find it physically because that center is not physical. That vortex, our spiritual center, is in the invisible. Yet, it is the vortex of energy that creates all of who we are.

As you move out and away from the center, it gets very powerful. We're all like storms or hurricanes depending on the power of our force. It's important to learn how to balance yourself so you can manage all the power that surrounds you. The more you learn to balance this presence inside, then the more powerful you become.

In terms of storms, typically a storm doesn't become so powerful that it ruins things. With most storms, something comes along that breaks it up and decreases its power before significant damage can be done. It's unusual to have the kind of storms that we experienced recently. If we looked at these storms from a different view, a higher view, remembering that it's all good when we see through the eyes of the Lord, what could we consider to be the positive direction?

We usually associate a hurricane with destruction. Such a storm is bringing together powerful forces of nature. We can learn to see that power in a way that is a blessing rather than a point of destruction. That's also a way we can look at the human condition.

As there are cycles in nature, there are cycles in our own consciousness. There are cycles that appear mentally, emotionally and physically. When someone asks, "How are you today?" your answer reflects a composite of all the levels of our awareness. To answer, you might reflect on ways you're feeling really good. You might also realize that in other ways, you're not doing so well. All of that is about balancing our levels.

One of the things that the weather teaches us is that as powerful as we are in this level, we are not in control. Nobody knows how to stop the hurricanes and the forces of nature. Often, what happens when faced with those types of conditions, people become engaged in more religious practices or more focused on their spirituality.

During major storms, we often hear about how people find they can worship together regardless of their religious differences. Sometimes they didn't have much choice and other times they chose to be together in their worship and prayer. On the news, at any given time, we can hear about terrible conditions and conflicts occurring based on religious differences around the planet. We hear about places where it isn't safe to worship openly at any time. Yet, the adversity of weather conditions often results in bringing people together in ways they hadn't done before, including worshipping openly, side by side. That's a blessing.

When adversity shows up in your life, when you're in the midst of a storm, look for the blessing. Focus on what God is doing for you. One of the primary teachings in the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness is to use everything for your upliftment. Why do you suppose we would say such a thing? Because we can use everything for our upliftment.

Finding the Humor

Why does a dog lick himself in a place we can't? There are probably two answers: One, because he can, and two, because he likes to. One of the ways to weather the storms with Spirit is to find a touch of humor. I don't know of any single way that is more effective and lifting than humor. It's like instant relief from God.

Have you ever noticed that if you're in pain, whether it's physical, emotional or mental, and you laugh, the pain diminishes or even vanishes? Or sometimes you laugh with so much strength it hurts, but it hurts in a good way?

It's amazing that when we're in a state of being disengaged from the severity of what's happened, we're able to see things we hadn't considered before.

We can laugh in the face of our suffering even though humor and suffering may not seem as though they go together. I find that when we listen to comedians, their subject is primarily human suffering. They somehow find a way of laughing at the negative aspects of human conditions.

Most of you probably smiled as you envisioned a dog licking himself. But maybe it's not a laughing matter for some of you. If you consider it a disgusting matter, that wasn't the intent. My intent was to give an example of how we can break through the seriousness and gravity of looking at challenges in the world. We can take ourselves far too seriously.

Consider how often you've associated Jesus with laughter. Do you suppose Jesus was capable of laughing? Do you think Jesus would have a good sense of humor?

It's interesting that Jesus's humor didn't seem to find its way into the Scriptures, unless of course it's sitting there for us to discover. Perhaps instead of taking the Scriptures always in a serious way, some of them were meant to be humorous. Wouldn't it be interesting if I gave you all some homework and said, "There are lots of jokes in the Holy Scriptures. I want you to find the Holy Scriptures that are jokes." What do you think you would discover?

Now somebody might consider my suggestion blasphemy. Many people see worshiping the Holy Scriptures as something that must be done very seriously, like "dead serious." That's not my experience of Scripture, and that's not my experience of the presence of Spirit.

One of the key signs of the presence of Spirit is joy. When we are in the Spirit with one another, we find things to be joyful about. We find the lightness in the situation. Sometimes it becomes very sacred and solemn out of the profundity of what we're experiencing. It can become quiet and still, but the joy remains even in the silence.

There's a Scripture that says something to the effect of, "You are to have joy and have it more abundantly" [John 10:10]. If we are following the Spirit, then we must be about joy. We are to steer away from fault-finding, criticism, what we call "back-biting," judgments, fears, and doubts. Those choices have a downward movement. Choosing the Spirit is an upward, uplifting joyful movement.

Weathering Karma

The nature of our karma is like the weather. It changes and shifts. Have you ever noticed there are times when no matter how good yesterday seemed and even though you were in a blissful state when you went to sleep, you woke up feeling terrible? You might wonder, "What happened? Am I living with demons? Is everybody and everything out to get me?" That's a hellish state to experience. But is it real?

One of the qualities of those things that are real is they last. What is real endures. We refer to them as eternal truths. Those are the things to choose as your focus, the things that last day in and day out.

You might say, "But it seems no matter how good or wonderful I feel, it's not too long before I start feeling down. Happiness and joy don't seem to last." Instead you might choose to shift so you can realize, "No

matter how bad I feel, at some point it changes. I start feeling better. I get to smile and laugh again."

What do you choose? That's an important decision because it's a declaration of choosing an upward movement or a downward movement, a positive movement or a negative one. It's a decision you make on this level in each moment. There's plenty of evidence for both sides. It's up to you to decide which side you're playing on, which movement you're choosing.

In the Movement of Spiritual Awareness, we decide for the uplifting side. We choose for the eternal truths. This is the path that leads to God. It's a heavenly path in the greater and greater states of reality. Our perceptions to the higher reality may seem hidden. But while they're hidden, we still have choices to make. We don't get to sit on the fence. We must take a stand, and one of the stands is neutrality which is a position of balancing. Neutrality is a powerful position. It allows you to be in the middle of the storm, in the neutral, calm center, while things around you are lifting and descending.

Weather changes. Karma shifts. Some days are up. Some days are down. Some days we feel up. Some days we feel down. But in the center, where God lives with us, it's always in balance. A state of peace reigns.

If we are measuring the strength of a hurricane, as it gets further out from the center, it becomes less powerful. It's much more powerful when it's close to the center, the perfect calm where it seems as though nothing's happening there. Yet, right in the center, in the eye of the storm, is the source of the power.

Often when people come into a spiritual movement, they are looking for the force and the power. Perhaps as you get close to the physical center, you find things that are powerful. But the true power is the place where it is silent and peaceful. So a person could come in looking for the power, thinking "Oh, I found it! I found it!" as they near the center. Then when they come into the center, they say, "Nothing's really happening!" And they go right out the other side and miss the blessings of Spirit.

If you had to balance yourself on one toe on top of a stake in the ground, do you think that would be pretty difficult? Maybe for an instant it would be manageable. But what if you had to do that for two hours, just standing on one toe, maintaining your balance? That would take tremendous effort and intention. Is it possible? Sure, it's possible. There are plenty of people in circus acts to show us it is possible. But it takes great strength, focus and determination.

If you strive towards something, you gain the ability. John-Roger has said, "The willingness to do gives the ability to do." We are all students learning, and we have a range of abilities. This classroom of the Traveler always makes us students.

You may be learning or working through something much more subtle than someone who's sitting next to you or vice versa. What's interesting is the spiritual learning rarely shows up outwardly. It's very difficult to determine how involved in their spiritual growth someone may be based on their looks or their expression. There are qualities that express the Spirit, and that's what's important for you to look upon as a reference. As you take on the intention to go to God, that's an inner intention. It's registered inside with the God that dwells in you.

He is Greater Within You

Do you consider you have direct communion with God? If you do, then choose to act like it. That means consulting and communing with your God within. Whatever form that takes outwardly, how you practice your worship, whether it's in some kind of an edifice, a church, a synagogue, a temple, a field in nature, the floor beside your bed, in the shower, through your crying or your pleading, the communion with God inside is still present.

I suggest that one of your prayers be, "To better hear You and know You, Lord." Strive with that intention. Whatever any of us are doing, as great and wonderful as it might be, the greater presence is inside. "Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world [1 John 4:4]."

There's part of a storm that manifests itself in the world. It blows the trees and brings the rain. But the greater part of the storm is in the center, in the calm. That's where the power is, and it's in the silence of your being. That's the greater presence of who you are.

Don't be so concerned with your expression and the forms that things take around you. Keep your eye on the calm and peace that is present. Allow it to extend as that force of the Spirit. When you do, you'll find your expression is uplifting, first in your own being and then extending out to those in your world.

When the storm dissipates, the vortex is still present although it may be taking another form. Where does that force come from in the first place? Out of God. So be careful in what confronts you. Don't become that nature of downward energy. Choose to become a calming, uplifting force for those who are disturbed and angry. Does this happen in an instant? Not likely. It's gradual, so you have to maintain your course and allow those that will confront you to decrease.

Have you ever had someone who is angry and has upset you then follow you around, maybe from room to room? When that comes to you, it takes great patience along with the understanding that somehow this is your level of concern. It's not important to have the answer to why. Just figure the answer is "because." There is a cause. There is a reason, but you don't have to know what it is. Just know enough that you maintain your course and you hold your loving and your calm present. As you learn to connect to the peace and calm within, then that is what can be extended to you and outward from you.

You may realize that the greatest way to handle a confrontation is to steer clear of it. Just as sunny weather may move in as a storm moves away, you can move too. Sometimes you just endure. If I was to look at a singular quality that maintains M.S.I.A., I'd consider it's our endurance --- the willingness to endure and maintain our intention on Soul Transcendence no matter what challenges we face.

You probably know by now that you don't have all the answers. If you've attempted to understand everything, you've been frustrated. If you make your understanding something validated by outer circumstances, you may get very frustrated. Understanding is not found out in the world. It's found inside.

If M.S.I.A. as an outer movement was no longer here, the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness would still exist. You would still have the connection because you know it inside yourself. You have the experience with the Presence. You have the inner transformation, and you know it's good. However, as soon as you go out into your life, that's when it's challenging because your karma more directly meets up with you.

Karma occurs when we choose to move away from the Spirit within. That's the law. Karma will take you into your debts, into what you've done incorrectly, and show it to you. And you must overcome it eventually.

The Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness is a path of grace. We can choose to bypass the karma by not reacting to those things that are negative and by not entering into things that are unnecessary. 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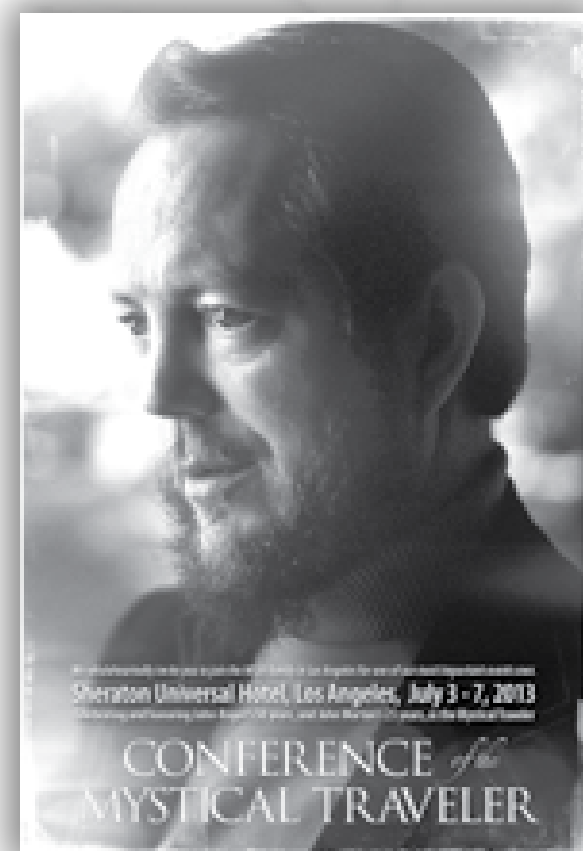
The Birth of The Movement

Jack Reed Shares How It All Began

as told to NDH reporter Teri Breier

A Destined Meeting

"I remember you...you killed me on Atlantis." Those were the first words John-Roger ever said to me (in this lifetime, anyway)...but he didn't seem to take it personally.

It was August 1966, and we had just been introduced at Neva Dell Hunter's annual conference in Flagstaff, Arizona. [Ed. Note: Hunter was a prominent spiritual figure who pioneered the aura balancing technique.] I knew right away that J-R would be a very important person in my life and on my spiritual journey. In fact, that startling comment planted a seed for what eventually became the Church of the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness (MSIA).

Much later (actually about a year ago), I found out that, before leaving for that conference, J-R had told Lee Clausen that he was supposed to meet a "New Age seeker" there. Although I was only 20 years old, and recently discharged from the Air Force Academy, I had been looking for spiritual meaning for quite some time already. In fact, that spring I had been on a cross-country "New Age pilgrimage" with a friend to investigate the various New Age activities that were taking place around the United States, as more and more people became aware of them.

A Growing Friendship

Once back in California, J-R and I continued our friendship; I would often stay with him when traveling down to Los Angeles from my home in Santa Barbara. He was hands-down the funniest person I have ever met, cracking me up with one joke after another.

I remember a bet we placed on the sex of my brother's soon-to-be-born baby. J-R said daughter, I said boy—and the prize was a steak dinner. When my nephew was born, J-R conceded his loss gracefully (while suggesting a female Basic Self, of course), and took me out to a steakhouse in Rosemead. He proceeded to flummox our waitress with uncannily accurate comments about her life, family and circumstances, each time she came by our table. She finally turned to me, eyes wide, and asked "Who IS this guy?"

Here's an interesting tidbit. You may have heard the word "deflect" being used by MSIA'ers to cancel out a negative statement. That actually originated from a theatrical skit I once saw at Santa Barbara High School, where the actors repelled bullets with their hands while yelling "Deflect...deflect!" Then, when I humorously used the deflect technique to nullify some playful insults J-R would throw at me, he adopted the term to counteract any karmic effects from speech. I think that really captures the concept of using everything for your advancement!

[J-R] proceeded to flummox our waitress with uncannily accurate comments about her life, family and circumstances, each time she came by our table. She finally turned to me, eyes wide, and asked "Who IS this guy?"

My friend Anna was also there, and, as we sat around Muriel's table, J-R not-so-subtly suggested that this was the girl I should marry. I was a little surprised, considering that we were not dating and I was pretty clueless about girls back then. Anna did initiate a relationship right after that comment and we were married three years later, officiated by J-R with Pauli McGarry (now Sanderson) as Anna's maid of honor.

In Feb. 1968, Muriel, Robert Waterman (then a student at University of California Santa Barbara) and I went to Arcadia for Neva Dell's Prophecies for 1968 gathering. It was right after that meeting that the three of us decided to invite J-R to come up to Santa Barbara for a set of talks.

Starting on May 4, 1968, Muriel, Robert and I hosted a series of six Friday night talks at her home. These seminars would turn out to be the only early-days live seminars J-R did in Santa Barbara, but, as the word spread, they laid the foundation for this incredible Movement that has endured over 44 years and counting. Soon after, some of the early attendees wanted J-R's seminars in Newbury Park, Thousand Oaks and various homes around L.A., and the momentum built. Early attendees I remember from those first Santa Barbara seminars who are still around after all these years include Robert, Pauli, Marie Torkelson (Gerhardt) and Genie Ford.

Some of the many profound experiences I can recall in those early days with J-R were the times that he demonstrated the process of transfiguration. We would face each other, and I could see all these different faces superimposed over his, one after another, as if he were projecting past incarnations. And I would get brief flashes of those past lifetimes that we shared together. After a while, I got pretty good at transfiguration myself, just as he had told me I would in the next sentence after "...you killed me on Atlantis."

Also, J-R used to do something with people called a "Light Study." He used a 4-page form that had scales for assessing various personality traits, strengths and weaknesses. I had mine done in 1968; he was able to come up with the measurements just by looking at me, and it was very accurate.

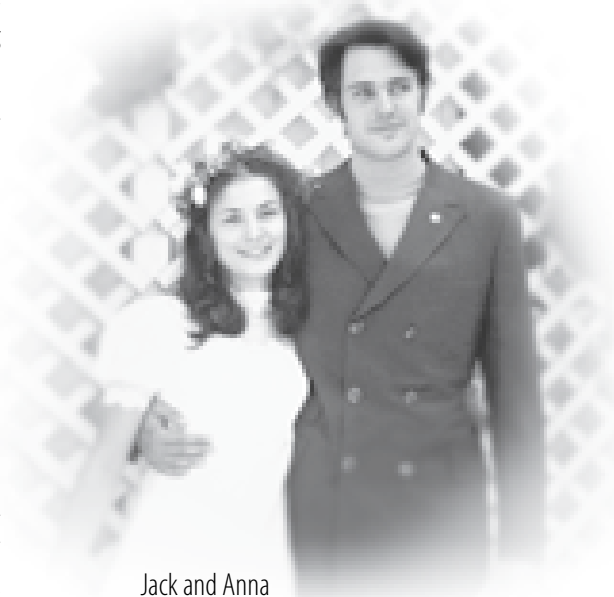
The First Seminars

During one of my many weekend visits to J-R's Rosemead apartment, he put out the idea to me that he wanted to start talking with groups. To that end, in August 1967, I organized a talk in Santa Barbara with the help of Muriel Engle, whom I had met through Neva Dell, but had not yet met J-R. After that talk we adjourned to Muriel's for a spaghetti dinner. Muriel once wrote about that first meeting, which was recently reprinted in the New Day Herald. Briefly, she had been told by a psychic that she would know her spiritual teacher by his having praying hands at the end of a chain. During that meal, J-R took out a chain to use as a pendulum for transmuting alcohol...with a pendant in the shape of praying hands. From then on, Muriel was a cornerstone of MSIA. Although I did not know of that prophecy for Muriel, I did feel the room go into a tremendous swirl of energy and I wondered what was happening.

In Gratitude

In telling these stories, I realize how blessed I have been. Most people who come into meetings to hear a person talking about Spirit or perhaps looking for a teacher, just see a strange person talking to a group. Then it's up to the individual to try to discern if this is an approach for them.

Unlike nearly everyone else who came into MSIA, I never had to do that. I had the unique opportunity to know J-R as a friend for almost two years before we set up the first seminars. I didn't have to guess or even intuit who that person was up-front. I knew who he was, I knew what he could do, and I knew that the consciousness he worked with was with me all the time. I knew all of that before those first seminars. I am so grateful to have known John-Roger as a friend as well as a teacher...and it makes me a little misty-eyed just thinking about it.

Marry at Prana...plus New Year's Spa Day

New Year's Spa Day begins with a prelude to one of the best love stories ever told.

John Morton leads us on a spectacular journey into the arms of the beloved with a divine demonstration of openness and vulnerability.

We call in the light by chanting the sacred names of God as a group, inviting empathy and God's energy into the home of the Traveler. John stands before us elegantly dressed in groom attire with his heart as open as a child, cradled in the arms of love in clear sight.

I am invited to share in a sacred love story of ancient ascent, where all time and space converge, full, whole, infinite, and satisfied. I am once again privy to walk with God in my heart, experiencing the souls of my feet breach the knowing that there exists an experience of heaven while walking on earth.

John shares about forgiveness, freedom and resolution. He shares, "I forgive you". He says, "The freedom we take for ourselves is the freedom we give to others." I take the opportunity to write down what I want more of in my life and the gratitude for all that I have manifested thus far.

As I write down my last few words about my New Year's resolution, John shifts gears and shares from Leigh Taylor-Young's journal. His voice is filled with compassion, gratitude and humility. His eyes fill with tears. His voice vibrates as the ocean does when waves are forming. He reads a journal entry from January 30th, 2005. "The man for me comes forward equal or better than John Morton." Talk about resolution. John talks about the precision that Leigh writes with as she manifests her heart's desire. He stands laying claim to what she has called forward and what we all witness as the love story unfolds.

She writes: "I want a good man, an attractive man, who loves me, adores me, a very wealthy man with a huge presence of heart. He's in his 50's...financially generous with me. He generally wants the highest good...Loves cat, J-R and honors MSIA. Good to be with. Good with money...Encourages me to fly. Straight - available - not married...full glorious hair on his head." The room rumbles with laughter.

I write like lightning as I capture the words written by Leigh. I marvel at her ability to create what is in her heart. I receive her blessing as my own, for what we behold we can become. I am grateful to witness the ways in which I am one with God. John says, with great honor, that what was singing in her heart was singing to him.

For me, the New Year is a new beginning, where we make resolutions, recommit ourselves to the best inside of us coming forward, and let go of all the past that no longer serves us. I forgive it all and step free onto a blank page where I write down my own love story. I tell my story as it vibrates within God's creation.

The Wedding begins...

John relaxes into the experience of the groom and his expression melts into a sea of gratitude, reverence and playfulness. There is a whimsical vibration floating through the air and loving is contagious. John begins with a story. In 1985 J-R asked a question: Did you know that Leigh Taylor-Young is interested in marrying you? John later found himself sitting next to Leigh on a plane to Cairo. John talks about the poem by Kahlil Gibran "Speak to us of marriage." He remembers the phrase about "not growing in one another's shadow". I flash back to Leigh's journal entry where she asked for a man that would support her in flying. The poem by Kalil reads:

"Then Almitra spoke again and said, And what of Marriage, master? And he answered saying: You were born together, and together you shall be forevermore.

You shall be together when the white wings of death scatter your days.

Ay, you shall be together even in the silent memory of God.

But let there be space in your togetherness, And let the winds of the heavens dance between you.

Love one another, but make not a bond of love: Let it rather be a moving sea between the shores of your souls.

Fill each other's cup but drink not from one cup. Give one another of your bread but eat not from the same loaf.

Sing and dance together and be joyous, but let each other of you be alone, Even as the strings of a lute are alone though they quiver with the same music.

We share our blessings with the bride and groom. We dance. We dance. We enjoy John in his top hat, expressing his inner Prince Charming, fully available and sharing the love at hand.

Leigh and John share the last dance together to "Stand by Me". We watch, dance and applaud the beauty seeded in the home of the Traveler.

We throw rice into the air and wave goodbye to our beloved Mrs. And Mr. Morton, for now.

I walk away with a wonderful sense of original innocence that is born from loving.

expounded on the loving she found in each character.

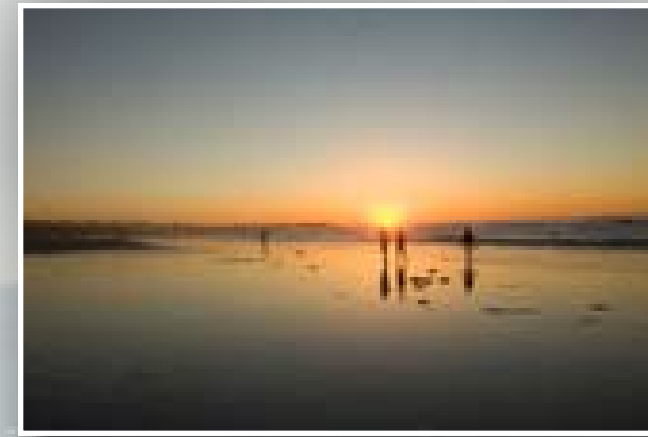

With 130 participants from 14 countries, the first Living in Grace en Español began on November 5, 2012.

The retreat took place at the resort Marbella, two hours from Santiago, the capital city of Chile. Vincent Dupont facilitated the event, Marcos Cajina served as translator on stage and Nora Valenzuela translated the quotes and extracts from John-Roger.

Although I had taken this retreat several times at Asilomar, I chose to go to Chile because as a native Chilean, I wanted to support the efforts made by the MSIA community in Chile. And furthermore, I could not miss the opportunity to share this event with my Latin brothers and sisters. I congratulate myself for having put my body on the line because the depth of my experience exceeded any expectations. In this LIG event, I healed my greatest hurt. Why here and why now? I think there is a time and a place for everything. And this was my time and my place, which also had to do with the particular story that I'm sharing here.

It was in Chile that years ago I discovered eternity and stopped being an atheist; it was in Chile that I was willing to give my life for my people; it was here that I chose to be true to myself and to let go of my children who were still small; it was in Chile that I found John-Roger and started studying the teachings of Soul transcendence. And now, I have healed what was my deepest hurt, filling that space with love. My biggest hurt became my biggest love. I have no way of explaining or tracking what that means. To say in a few words what has taken a lifetime is something that only one who has lived something similar can understand. My process makes me think of a seminar by John-Roger entitled, "The Understanding of Suffering" in which he says that the depth of our suffering is the depth with which we pray to God.

According to what I heard from others, this experience that I lived was being replicated by each participant. Each one was being transformed and healed according to their needs. We were assisting each other by pulling ourselves up. Some had the opportunity to share before the Traveler, John Morton, and Michael Hayes. The rest of us witnessed the formidable healing taking place thanks to the power of God's love, as we made those our healings and extracted the learning according to what each one was open to receive. There was one woman who let go of her physical crutches, and there were others who let go of their emotional and mental crutches.

I found it surprising to witness the enormous love that the majority of Latinos expressed toward John Morton, which is returned by the Traveler, who demonstrates a potent loving force, that in my experience is greater than anything I've seen of him so far. I talked to a man who felt transported after talking to the Traveler for a few minutes during the lunch break. And, I saw others living something similar after sharing with him on the microphone. It was something very powerful and beautiful to observe.

The renewing action of Spirit was available more than we can imagine in events like this one, thus allowing for a letting go of limitations, lightening of our burdens, completing, facing blocks and dark things, and spiritualizing them by filling them with love and Light. I could see how all of us opened our hearts, allowing the action of love to transform our agonies into our victories. Sometimes, the processes of liberation were accompanied by soft tears of joy, or open laughter.

To listen to the voice of the Traveler repeat to us on and on during the 6 days things we have already heard was in itself transformative, but here the words acquired more potency. Here are some of those sentences: "Living in Grace is loving God in all His forms."; "Loving is your greatest protection."; "That which we want we already are."; "The Kingdom of God is at hand."; "If you resist you do not win, only when you let go you heal yourself.";

"Take care of yourself so you can help take care of others."; and "Love as God loves."

We achieved the purpose of going beyond the suffering towards Grace, and we witnessed and experienced the triumph of love over the sufferings of life. And, we did it blessed by the balm of the laughter and loving of our "compañeros."

After what we lived during those 6 days, the MSIA communities in South America will never be the same. The Latin American integration received a great push, and may God allow us the wisdom to continue developing what we started, so that the action of the Christ may take place in all Its splendor. I believe that now we are more aware of our value as individuals and as a cultural group, as well as of what we can contribute to the MSIA family and the world. Colombia is offering a Walking in the Light next January, and Brazil wants to have a Spiritual Exercises Workshop at the Iguazu Falls. Now, nobody doubts that there will be another Living in Grace where the Souls wishing to go home to God will gather. We only need to take care of the details, like a place and time, but what is more important is the willingness to go forward as a continent. If not in one country, it will happen in another, and we will all support the action of Spirit. Baruch Bashan

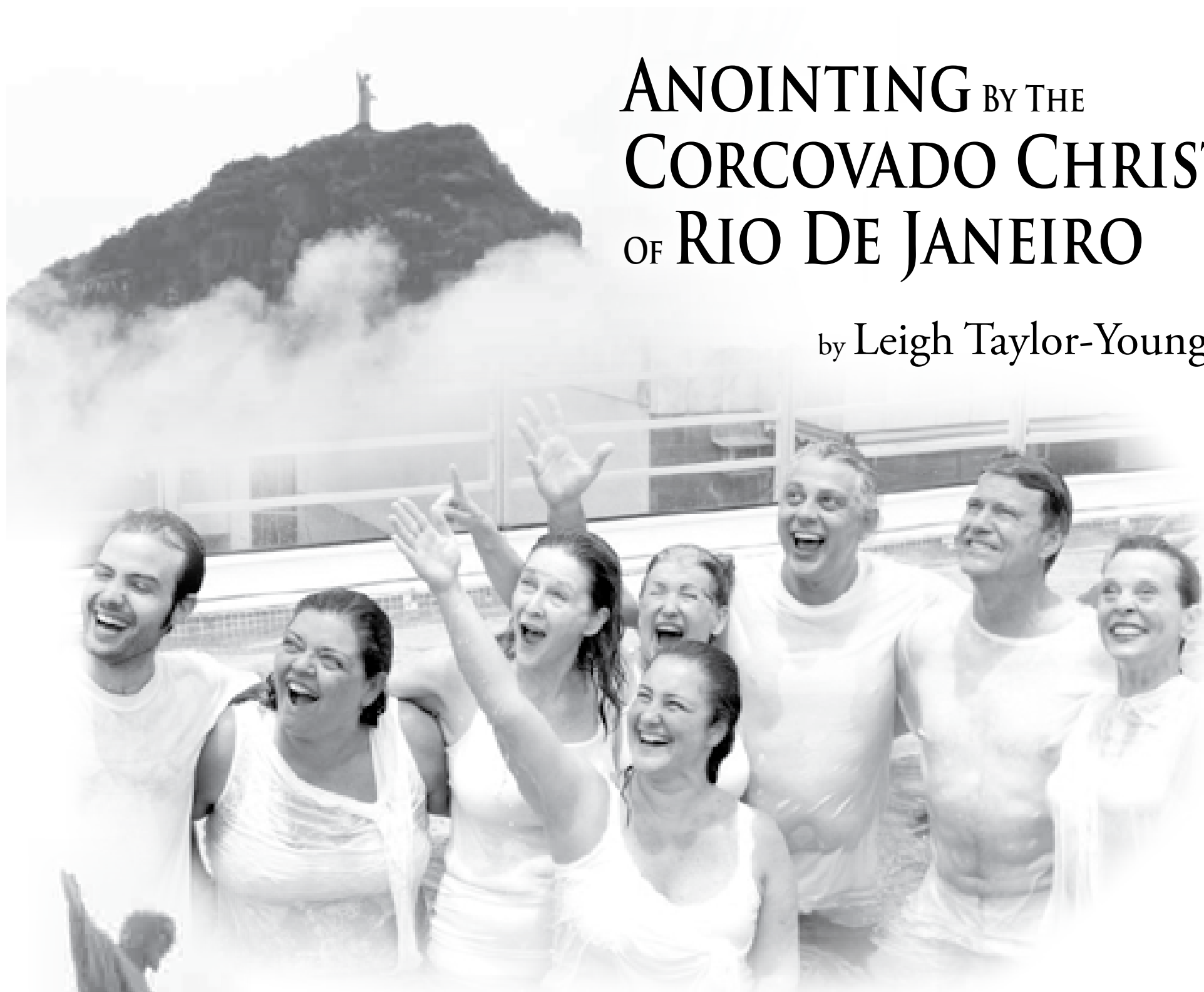

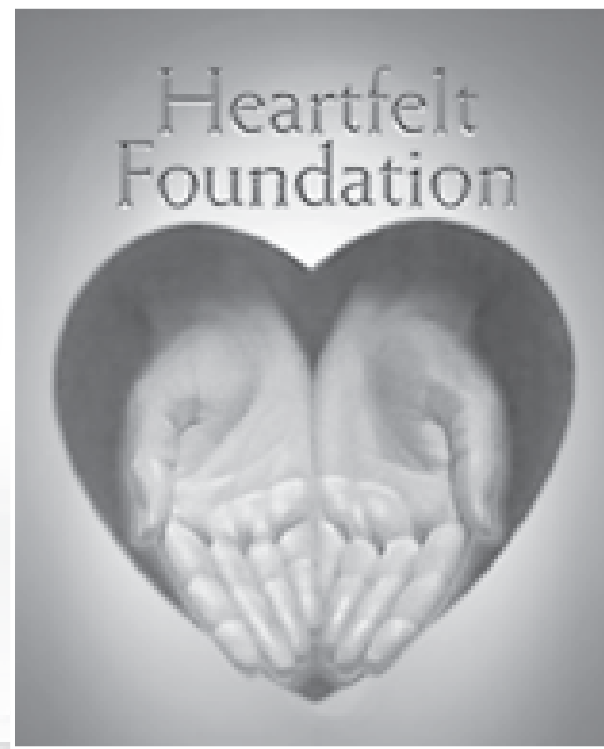

A Heartfelt Christmas

Dear Family,
Here is an update on the Heartfelt Christmas/
Holiday Service Project held on Saturday,
December 15, 2012 at the Santa Monica Pier.

It was a most beautiful, God-filled, blue-skied/sunny weather for our project -- sandwiched between two days of rain! I'd given John-Roger and John Morton the hours of the project needing protection -- 11-3. The skies were clear up to 2:59 pm, and at EXACTLY 3:00, the wind came up and brought in fog, clouds, cold, and a portent of rain! The project was officially over, and my heart marvelled at the amazing Grace of the Travelers and Father/Mother God in caring for their children.

This was Heartfelt's largest project ever, as we served about 4,000 people! 3,000 children came from the east, west, north, and south of LA city and county; not including their parents, as well as more than 175 volunteers. From toys, Santa, games, petting animals, and fun activities -- to tacos, hot dogs, popcorn, cookies and candy -- the Loaves and the Fishes were in full effect all day. So much so that children ended up receiving two toys each, when we only started the project with 3,000 toys. And as always, we brought toys back to the 2101 building to share with agencies pouring in on the Monday after the Christmas project, to get needed toys for the children they help. The toys never gave out until the last group was served.

Heartfelt also held another sweet project at a local Nursing Home, led by the Pepper family. This group visited 99 residents of the home and gave out beautiful lap blankets, candy, gifts for the staff, and holiday loving cheer. They were led in caroling by the joyful piano playing of Barb Wieland, and delighted the residents further by the impromptu ballroom dancing of Morgan Pepper and his partner Asumi.

My personal and deeply held belief has always been that each person touched by Heartfelt's service, is touched by the Traveler and connected to his Heart. Sometimes it's almost visible, sometimes not. But the transformations that are undergone in such a short time, move and touch each one of us blessed to witness them. I am grateful to be a part of this holy work.

Janet Graham here with an update of
Heartfelt action from Kalamazoo:

During this season of Love, Light and Gratitude, Kalamazoo Michigan ministers experienced the joy of service both in organized public projects and all the private, even secret, ways of the heart. After our December Ministers Meeting, Barry Nobles, Michael Kudlas, Scott Steurer, Jane Emanuel, Cheryl Tiernan, Irene and Bob Skylis, Larry and Kay Stolsonburg, Leslie Crowell, Lorraine Andrew and Janet Graham assembled 180 plastic quart zip-lock bags for "party favors" for guests at Michael Kudlas' upcoming birthday party at Ministry with Community—the only day shelter for homeless, hungry, under-served and hard-to-serve people in Kalamazoo. Each bag had another bag folded inside along with a travel pack of tissues, a lip gloss, hand lotion, three cough drops and three foil-wrapped chocolate kisses with individual blessings from the minister who put them in the bag.

Since late last winter for one day each month I've been providing most of the food and heading a volunteer team that helps prepare and serve lunch to every member at Ministry with Community. No one is turned away at MwC. The service teams have included the county sheriff, labor leaders, a local head start founder, political campaign workers, college students and retired factory workers, teachers and college professors. Believe me, when we volunteer, we really WORK and we leave with eyes and hearts opened to a new level of awareness and loving action.

I suggested that they consider offering people "an opportunity to be of service" (the Heartfelt Model) by setting up a donation program to sponsor a meal. People could chip in to honor a pastor, a family member, a special day, an anniversary. The kitchen staff already works miracles. Every single day somehow they come up with a hot breakfast and a hot lunch for anywhere from 100 to 250 or more people. Kalamazoo is a very generous community and thanks to donations from bakeries, restaurants and caterers plus the local food pantry and their meager budget, they manage to come up with something to serve. They figured if they could count on \$250 -- oh my gosh -- they could go all out. It would be wonderful. Oh the meal they could prepare! (Yes, \$1/person.)

By late November the Sponsor a Meal plan was ready to go and I asked Michael if he'd like his birthday gift and birthday celebration to be one of the pioneer events in the program, and he thought it was a great idea. Way better than getting another tie! However, instead of having me just write a check, he wanted people to have a special meal and to have some MSIA ministers help on the serving team. So working with the kitchen manager and chef we planned a suitable celebration meal: spaghetti (ro-tini) and meatballs, homemade sauce with actual seasoning, garlic bread, parmesan cheese, fresh salad with fresh tomatoes and shredded cheese, buttermilk ranch dressing (members' all-time favorite).

Having meat is a treat, having 6 meatballs per serving is unheard of, having fresh salad is a rare pleasure but the real deal was dessert: ICE CREAM with a mini-fresh-baked cupcake. The word got out on the street that there was a great meal at MwC and there were 275 people served -- with love and respect -- for Michael's birthday. We ran out of the party favors, but nobody went away hungry. And yes, this was way over the \$1/meal budget but it lifted a lot of spirits and that moment of joy on an otherwise bleak day was a blessing for all.

The ministers and dear friends who were able to join the volunteer serving team were: Jane Emanuel, Bob Skylis, Michael Kudlas and me. And then Kay and Larry Stolsonburg spent a day the following week delivering food boxes in an impoverished rural area.

This experience has opened the way to other possibilities of gathering in service. Thanks for the ongoing inspiration! Keep shining.

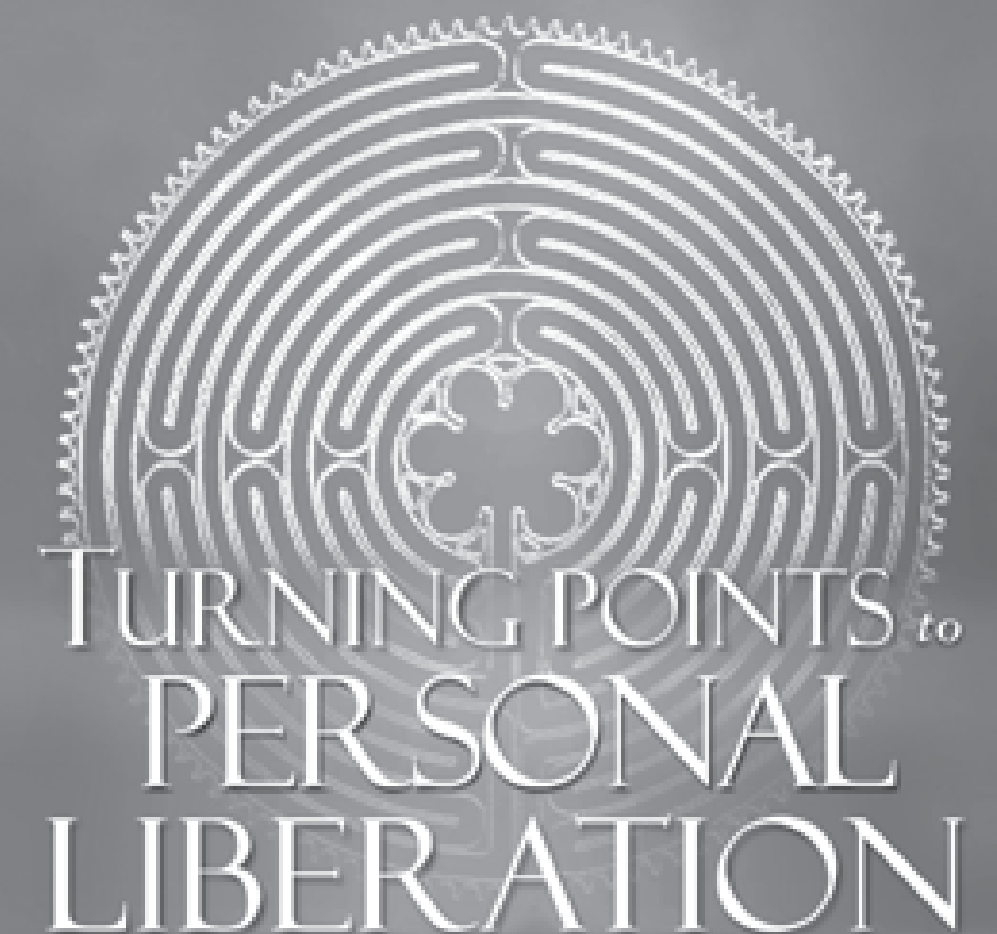

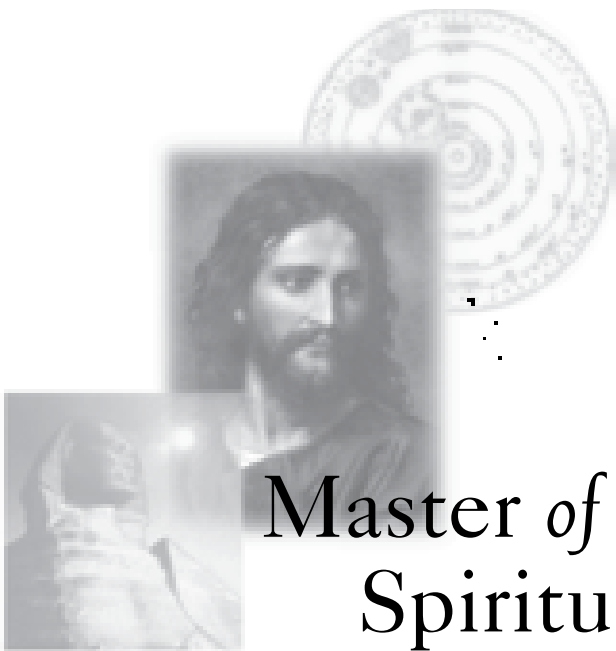
