# TEACH ME TO UNDERSTAND

Even though you may be walking around physically, you may be sleeping. So, wake up from that sleep, that trance, your self-hypnosis, and your unconsciousness.

People say to me, "Teach me to understand." And I tell them, "Understand the teachings." They ask, "How do I do that?" The answer is: understand the teachings the best way you can, at anytime, wherever you find yourself. The way you understand the teachings is to apply yourself to that understanding. To do this, you may find that you have to wake up from your sleep. You see, even though you may be walking around physically, you may be sleeping. So, wake up from that sleep, that trance, your self-hypnosis, and your unconsciousness.

Often when you are with people, and the focus of the group is to awaken spiritually to the greater reality, you will hear something said that will spark something

inside of you. At this time you may feel the pressure of your heart inside of you, moving, opening, stretching ... and you feel the energy of Spirit moving inside of you. That energy often feels unfamiliar and sometimes uncomfortable in its quality of bursting free of previous limitations. And so, out of nervousness, you may seek to disperse that energy, to dissipate it so that you can return to the more familiar sensations. You can dissipate the energy by talking, moving, shouting, sex, eating, drinking, and drugs. Know that when you involve yourself in these distractions, you are choosing that rather than sitting with the energy of Spirit and experiencing it as it is.

Far too often, I see people who are right on the apex of insight talk them-

selves right out of it, out of nervousness. When you are experiencing that energy that is the Spirit moving inside of you, experience that to its fullest extent. Don't talk about it. Don't distract yourself from it, even if it's uncomfortable for you. When you feel that awakening inside, go for it. You don't have to have words for it. You don't have to identify it. You don't have to know what it is. You don't have to know what you are feeling about it. Just let it reveal itself to you, without any preconceived notions about whether it is good or bad or anything.

Far too often, you want to KNOW way ahead of time what your experience will be. You don't have to KNOW; you can just be present with your reality and let it occur in its own timing. Sometimes when people are going to hear me speak, they will say to a friend, "I'm going to hear John-Roger talk."

The friend says, "What's he going to talk about?"

"I don't know."

"Then why are you going to go?"

"I'm going to go and find out what he's going to talk about."

"If you don't know what he's going to talk about, I don't see why you go."

If you look at that conversation from another point of view, you might wonder why anyone would listen to me talk if they did know what I was going to talk about. If you already KNOW something, you don't need to hear it again. Often in seminars, I will talk about things that you already know but have forgotten or pushed aside in some way so that they are no longer present for you in your life. But the moment those things are explained to you, you say, "I knew that."

Often I explain what is presently happening at the time the seminar is given. And since you are experiencing the same moment of reality that I am, when I explain what is happening, you recognize that reality within yourself, and you catch the truth of my words. Now you can go out later and with your mind doubt what I said. Through this you may attempt to validate it by doubting it -- and that's a backwards approach. You don't validate very many things by doubting them. You destroy them by doubting them. You may say, "But I want to test it." Who are you to test? You may not have passed a test in a long time. You say, "Well, I want to evaluate it." With what? What tools do you have for evaluation? Do you know? Maybe you just want to judge it. That's easy. It doesn't require any tools. You can just say, "THAT'S NO GOOD!"

If something is no good, how can it be present? If it is present, how can it not be good? In the Scriptures it says that there was darkness, and then God created heaven and earth, and when He was through, He looked down and said that it was good. If God says that it is good - all creation is good - how are you able to look at any part of that and say that it's bad?

Perhaps you say that you never heard it was good. And perhaps you are always so busy in your

mind, with your opinions, and your judgments, that you never give yourself a chance to listen to God's voice. Yet you say, "When God tells me, I'll listen."

Try quieting and attuning yourself to the place inside where God is speaking.

"Where is that?"

Inside of you.

"It's my mind; it won't leave me alone."

Why don't you leave it alone?

"You mean, I can leave my mind alone?"

It's yours; you can leave it alone.

"It's mine!?"

Yeah.

"It's my anxiety. I just can't get past my anxieties."

It's your mind that creates your anxieties.

"Well, that's just the way I feel."

You choose those feelings.

You can feel anything you want to. Why feel that?

"You mean I'm choosing all this?"

Right!

"I'm doing this?"

Right!

"By myself?"

No.

"Thank God! Who can I blame?"

Why blame anyone? Why make it wrong? Why not say you don't know what's going on?

"I have to KNOW. How can I say I don't know? What will people think?"

Try it and see.

"Okay, I don't know ... Nothing happened."

Right.

"You mean, it's okay not to know?"

Often it's healthy not to know.

"What if I feel like I have to know?"

It's called PARANOID.

Paranoid is caring too much, far too much. Those who are expressing paranoid are caring too much what other people are thinking, what they are doing, what feelings they are having, caring that they may "get me", caring that they are wondering what is going on, etc. Eventually if you are expressing paranoia, you may start thinking that people are out to get you, and that's bad news. Or maybe the bad news is that they aren't out to get you; they don't even know you exist.

Part of the paranoid pattern that you create in your life is "editing" what you tell people, in an attempt to control and manipulate their thoughts toward you. Instead of just living in the present moment and loving your life, you attempt to "orchestrate" your life. You deceive people, consciously and purposely. You don't tell them all of the truth. And then you want them to function as if it were all of the truth. You tell them just so

much, but not the whole picture. And you justify that by thinking that you are saving yourself the "hassle" of having to deal with their reactions to the whole truth. That's judgment, my friends. However you look at it, it's judgment.

If you tell them the whole truth and they "hassle" you, guess what? You'll build strength. And you'll build trust. You will trust yourself more and they will trust you more. Sometimes you may turn away from the truth or the full truth because you are not sure that you can handle the end result. But the end result will be the end result, and you will be able to handle that the same way you handle your life today. Sometimes you handle things okay and sometimes not so okay. And you're here. Sometimes, in my various lives, I've handled situations by crawling on my knees through dirt and garbage. And sometimes I've handled my lives magnificently. And I'm here. Sure, I could look back and make it all wrong, and I'm here. Or I can look back on it and make it all magnificent, and I'm here. And it was neither wrong, nor mag-

nificent. There may be things that I wouldn't want to do again, and I would be willing to repeat any of it, if that was the thing to do.

As soon as you can just do the things that are present with you, the things that are there for you to do - and not do anything as a thought or a feeling, or with any consideration or concern of what you might get out of it, or what you deserve or what the neighbors might think - then you are beginning to live in the freedom of your own consciousness.

When you can live your life in the moment that it happens, not looking for anything in particular to take place, just being open to the present, you are living in Spirit; and you will find yourself experiencing so much joy and so much freedom.

In that moment of NOW, you begin to know yourself and that is the beginning of your knowledge of God.

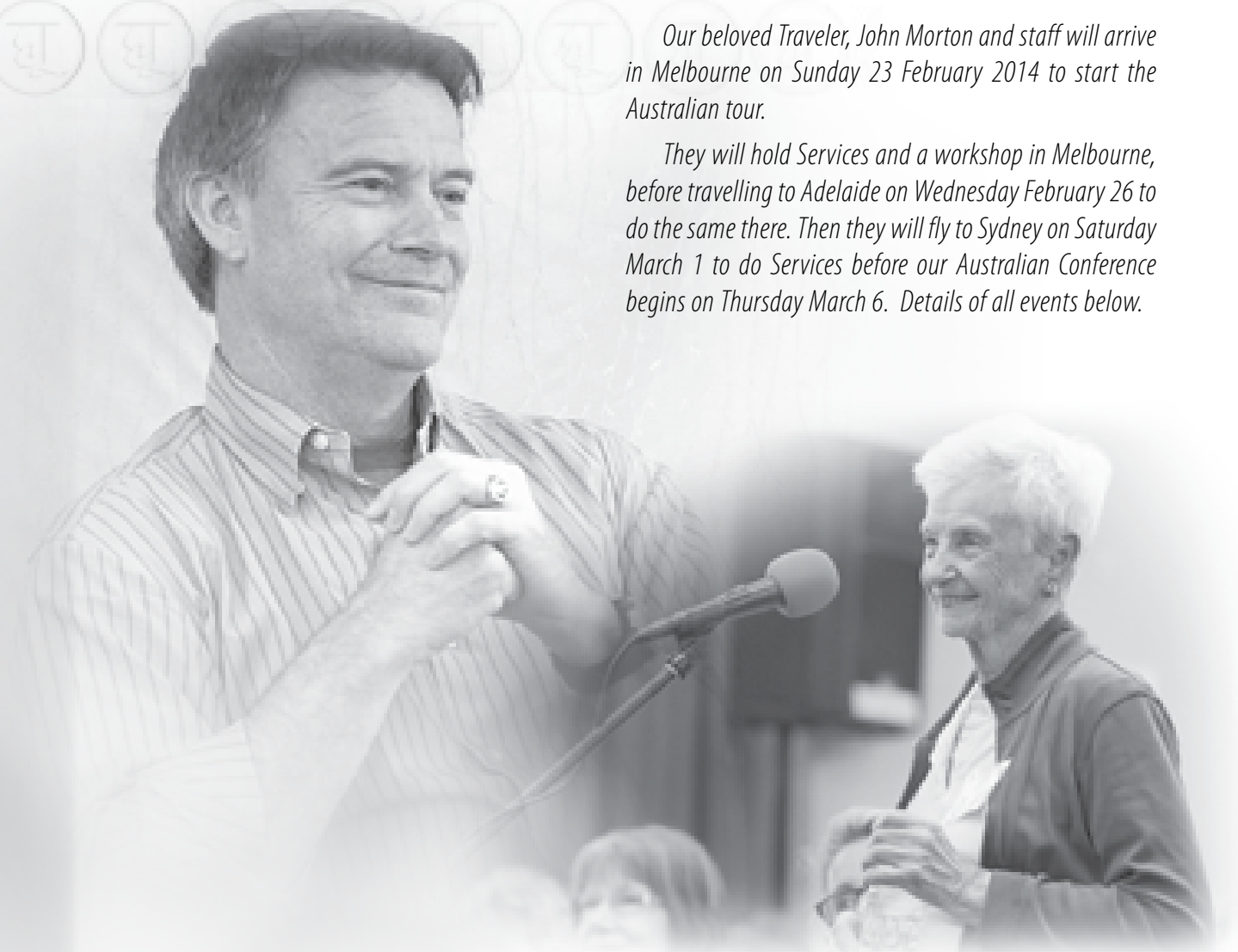

# Your Ultimate Safe Harbor

## One of the keys to your relationship with the Traveler

is that you do your part. It's there for you as your responsibility. When you consider Soul Transcendence, look at the meaning in how your life translates itself in this world. In effect, could you essentially do whatever and the Traveler would still engage you in what is Soul Transcendence?

At one level, the answer is "yes" because the Traveler applies to you unconditionally. In your life expression, that's taking place in a perfection. There's nothing outside of that

perfection. That alone is like the ultimate safe harbor, meaning wherever you go, God is. That's a complete statement. So whatever you're looking at, whatever you're dealing with, God is. And you're always in safe harbor with the Traveler.

We may not consciously understand whatever we're dealing with, but we don't need to understand. It isn't necessary. And yet the perfection remains intact. Even when we don't understand, there's nothing wrong



or outside of God. It's all still fine because it's all in God's creation.

From a higher view, we would say, "No matter what happens, you're going to make it." So what's the big drama? That's an excellent question. Why do we worry? Why do we ever doubt? Why be afraid if we know how the story ends?

In MSIA we teach that we know how it ends, which is of course not an ending. It's more a fulfillment of how things work. It's a completion, and it comes to an amazing completion. Put the knowing that you will endure into what you're working with so you trust regardless.

Trust is something more than acceptance. Acceptance is a neutral position. Acceptance is not for and not against. It's neutral by surrendering to whatever is present as a way of acknowledging what is taking place. The first opportunity is not about doing anything with whatever is going on. Just be aware of what is present. That's acceptance.

Trust is when you are engaging yourself. Trust is more about wanting to cooperate. Trust is choosing, "I want to do my part for my Soul Transcendence."

We often are introduced to acceptance, the first law of Spirit, but we don't necessarily remember there are other spiritual laws. All of the spiritual laws are important to how we function in the Spirit. Cooperation is the second law. So consider, how do you cooperate? How do you engage your trust in cooperation?

Learn how to cooperate with what is taking place. How do you do that? Through your awareness, and through your awareness of what already is. With that awareness you apply what you know based on where your intention is directed. Ask yourself, what is my direction? What is my purpose?

## Paying Attention

If you're sailing in a boat, consider what you are doing in that boat. Are you going somewhere? Is

there a destination? Are you there just for the ride? Are you there just because you're not somewhere else? Are you adrift? Maybe there's a strong wind and your boat may capsize. If you capsized, then there's something to notice about what's going on. Maybe God just said, "Game over!"

You may say, "God, that's not fair!" Yet, it is fair. You won't be sailing that day because God has something else in mind for you. You may ask, "Oh, God, did you have to resort to this? Before I got in the boat, couldn't you have put up a little sign? A warning like, 'We won't be sailing today.' And then I just wouldn't have bothered. I wouldn't have gotten in the boat."

Often there is a sign, but you didn't notice or read the sign. Maybe you were so excited and enthusiastic about what a wonderful day it was, that you didn't realize the weather could change. Even when things seem so good at first, it's important to pay attention and read the signs along the way. In this world, things change. So it's important to keep checking things out.

By continuing to check it out, that's part of how we stay out of harm's way. We watch, we look, and we listen. When we're young, that's what we do when we're learning to cross the street. So watch, look and listen because maybe you can hear something coming even though you can't see it yet. Keep working with the signs. Keep paying attention. That's a key to doing your part in your Soul Transcendence.

In MSIA, we teach that you survive no matter what. What's essential in looking at Soul Transcendence is that you're not your physical body. In fact, you're not a number of bodies that are psychic and material. You're not those. So whatever happens to those bodies, who you are goes on intact. Your soul survives one hundred percent intact. Who you truly are isn't somehow compromised or depleted by what goes on in this world. So what does that mean? That translates to, "Don't worry." It's going to work out. You will survive.

# Your Ultimate Safe Harbor

What if you're being told that you're going to die? That you have a certain amount of time to live? What's on your schedule? Would you like to change your schedule in terms of the world?

That's a relative fact of life. It relates to this world. Don't ignore the signs about your life in this world and how you conduct it. Is your life cooperating with this level? Are you a master at how to cooperate and get along with this level such that the end result of your life is that you manifest a contribution?

Bring in the Spirit with you in this level so that Spirit translates from what's above to below. That is how what is unmanifest translates into the manifest. The goodness of the Spirit replenishes the level.

I like to point out that God "plenished" this level which means it was created fully with a creator with unlimited supply for keeping it full and increasingly good. So how is it replenished? Whatever you take out of this level, return it with something equal or of greater value. In MSIA terms we say, "Leave this place better than you found it." Let that be spoken at your wake or as your epitaph. Maybe it's an epilogue or a soliloquy. That would be good too.

## Intentionality and Direction

Our lives work off of intentionality. When I was in college, proceeding along the way to having a Masters in Counseling, one of the assignments was to declare my specialty. I was asked to define if I am a "this or that." There was "this" therapy and "that" therapy. Or I could create my own, if I dared, knowing someone would likely be looking over my shoulder questioning how I was allowed to do that. In any case, I came up with Spiritual Counseling. So I went to my advisor and said, "I'd like to do Spiritual Counseling." And he said, "What are you talking about?" which was a good question.

My basic rationale was it seemed that in my generation, at least, there was a greater disenchantment with things that are conventional such as religions. From my experience, more and more people that I checked in with or listened to were telling me they were raised Catholic or Jewish or whatever, but they weren't really prescribing to their religion. I heard them say, "I don't have that faith. It's not my thing. I'm not following that. I just did it because my parents made me." Yet, they still had questions about God, and they didn't know how to work out some of those questions. They had a few "whys and what's," but nobody to check in with.

I thought it would be good if a counselor could come from a neutral place and talk about that is-

sue, the God issue, without having to attribute it to a particular kind of faith. My advisor sat back and thought about that and then said, "It's kind of like working as a Chaplain. Are you thinking about being a Chaplain?"

I said, "No," because I thought Chaplains worked for the government, the military or something like that. My dad was in the military, and I knew I didn't want to do that. The advisor said, "If you're not a Chaplain, I don't know how you would apply your area of specialty."

So I didn't pursue spiritual counseling. Instead, I kind of specialized in career counseling. When I would work with people as a career counselor, I would ask them, "What's in your heart?" That's really what it boiled down to -- discovering the work they loved. Working in career counseling was good because it helped me with finding this career, the career of my heart of hearts. So if you want to do a work of love, then find out what's in your heart that you love to do.

Often people are disconnected from what's in their heart of hearts to do. They've resigned themselves to believing that there's no such thing. They see work as drudgery or a burden. That's how they believe you get along in this world, that there's no reality to loving to work. The reality is that you can love what you do. And if in the process of that, you realize your gifts, and your attunement, then all the better. That's an application of being conscious and aware of how you have been gifted and where your talents are.

For example, if your talents lie in, "I can put up with the smell of garbage like nobody else!" that's a great gift. If you think about it, that might be worth a lot of money to have somebody deal with the garbage so the rest of us don't, especially if someone does it really well. They handle it so we don't have to smell it because it makes us sick. Yet for them, they love it. In the perfection of this world, there are peculiarities such that what is one person's poison is somebody else's medicine.

If you're doing something that is disturbing for you, you have a responsibility to take a look at that. Is it a self-imposed disturbance? Or is it really that your make up such as you are, what you were born with as a body-born condition, is counter to certain things? You weren't really meant for certain things?

Here's another example --- if you're a fish, then you belong in the water. If you're out of the water, you're not going to do well. You're going to suffer. A fish may say, "But I want to be like everybody else." Yet, the fish is still a fish. So it needs to be in

the water. You may need to test the water to find what's true in your heart of hearts.

## Cooperating Here and Now

One of the measurements of cooperating fully is the experience of knowing you're in the right place at the right time, right here, right now. There's nowhere else you would rather be. You know you are meant to be right here, right now. That's synchronicity. Those are moments where we are in complete cooperation.

How did you get to that moment of synchronicity? Because you chose it. You may feel you lucked into it, but that's a statement reflecting your lack of awareness. You didn't luck into it. You chose into it. You just didn't observe how you chose into it. Even if something feels natural, easy and there's no resistance, somehow, somehow you chose into it.

If someone with a very loud voice said, "Stand there! Don't move!" And you went, "Okay," and then the whole ceiling caved in and the only place it didn't come down was right where you were standing, you might wonder who delivered that message. Somebody warned you who knows you, loves you and protects you. And you chose back. You paid attention. Yet, that protectiveness isn't invoked unless it's called forward for your highest good.

For example, you wouldn't call the fire department right now unless there was a fire. Why? Be-

cause the fire department is about coming out when there's a fire. You wouldn't call them and say, "We just wanted to see if you would come." That's a false alarm. If an hour later, you call them again and say, "We just wanted to see if you would come again. Just because you came an hour ago doesn't mean you'd come an hour later." That's another false alarm. We call the fire department when there is a fire. It's a choice to be in cooperation. Our purpose in life is like that. We work in cooperation with what is. In Soul Transcendence, we cooperate with this level of this world, paying attention to the signs of the Traveler in our heart.

## The Light of the Traveler

In MSIA, we encourage you not to come into the face of somebody who's been spending time in the shadows and darkness and blast them with your light just to show them how bright you are. There's something off in that approach. You're misusing your gifts. Your natural gifts and talents are not for showing off at the expense of someone else.

People sometimes ask the Traveler, "If you're so high and mighty, why don't you do this or that?" referring to some manner of showing off. The Traveler is not about showing off. The Traveler has this amazing independence. So the body on this level is amazingly independent in this level from the body in the next level and the body in the next level. All those bodies are fully functioning in their levels. Yet, what it is spiritual is fully connected throughout the levels. The Traveler is in all the levels, and it doesn't function in contradiction. The Traveler functions in integrity.

We are all Travelers and Travelers in the making. It's in our destiny. It's something on the way forward. Some people may ask, "Did you just tell me I'm the Traveler? If so, would you mind getting out of the way so I can be the Traveler?"

Sometimes people approach the Traveler more or less like that, some with a little more rudeness than others. That's fine. My point of view is if you take the position, that's a graduation. And I'm for graduation. There's no argument about serving the Traveler. As a Traveler, there's no resistance like, "Get out of here, this is my hill." From my view I say, "Go ahead and see if you can do it. It's not my idea. It's up to the Spirit."

When people ask how I became the Traveler, what I tell them is that I became very close to John-Roger. Not because I was trying to take over his position, but because I wanted to get close to him and be involved in what he was doing. That's what I knew was true. I knew I was not going to try to do exactly what John-Roger did. I knew I was not going to do something such that he would have to leave. Serving as the Traveler was and is about cooperation with how the Traveler functions. And it applies everywhere and to everything.

When you're onto being in such cooperation with the Spirit, there's a kind of amazing compassion towards yourself. Empathy is one of the spiritual laws. In terms of the law of empathy, consider how it applies to the Traveler and all of your fellow Travelers. It applies with this amazing understanding. You realize, "I understand what's going on. I understand these conditions. They work. They serve."

Do the conditions serve at the highest level? It's important to check. Since things are in motion, we can direct ourselves in relation to the motion so that a manifestation comes that puts in a higher order. So have the wit to be open and be attuned to that higher order. If you want life to be better, work on your empathy and compassion. The last frontier is having compassion towards yourself in relation to all of Creation. That's the ultimate compassion.

What I ask people practically is, "Do you stand by what is true for you? Do you support yourself? Do you honor you? When nobody else would honor you, do you still honor you?" If they're going to put you before the firing squad because you're the most despicable thing in Creation, and then they shout, "Ready. Aim. Fire!" will you stand up there and honor yourself?

Having compassion for yourself is not about what people think or do in relation to how they perceive you. That's where you find out how you're doing with the God of opinion, including your own. You might say, "I agree with them. I've had a despicable life. I should be put out of my misery. They're doing me a favor. They're doing the whole planet a favor." No, that sounds like your ego is doing the talking. That's not the voice of who you truly are. Your true self has compassion for you regardless of what you've done or created. That's the light of the Traveler in your heart.

## Facing the God of All

If you feel you aren't worthy of God, that you're too small or not as good as God, then stand up. Face God on equal terms, as a co-creator and one who also owns the sun, the moon and the stars. With that claiming goes great responsibility. But it's simple too. Facing God is loving all of the Creation as God does. If there's a primary message in MSIA, that's it. And I translate it right into the Commandment, "Love the Lord, thy God, with all thy body, mind and spirit."

Who is this Lord, my God? The Lord of Creation. The Lord of it all. The Lord doesn't disown anything. The Lord of Creation doesn't say, "Oops, I'm sorry. I made a mistake there. I reject that." That's the voice of a small lord. I encourage you to get a bigger one, the greatest one, the Lord of all of the Creation.

It takes tremendous consciousness and awareness to stay up with all the Creation. When it doesn't feel or look good, or you don't particularly like something on a personal level, have compassion so you don't go against it. Don't damn or spite it regardless of your personal opinion or view. That's not your place.

Your place is to love it all. Choose to accept that commission. Those are the terms for gradu-



ation. That's another key to your part in your Soul Transcendence. As you do, you'll join the Christ because that's the consciousness that overcomes this world by loving it all and letting go of whatever has taken place.

## Peace Be Still

Acceptance and cooperation makes for smooth sailing. With acceptance and cooperation, you're dealing with your ability to say, "Peace be still, and so it is." Peace involves how you accept and cooperate on your own terms. Ask yourself what you would like? I suggest you say, "All things considered, I choose peace."

When people aren't accepting the message, "Peace be still," they're allowed to do that because they are co-creators too. On this level, everybody has a kind of equal say. So if they want to have war, fighting and great conflicts, they're allowed to have that. Peace is still present, and it is your choice to attune to the peace in each moment.

Sometimes a conflict may be directed at you. Somebody may be jealous or envious of you. The way the negative power works is it's allowed to direct negativity towards you. But you don't have to take it in terms of absorption. You don't have to identify with the negativity. You can keep your terms clear and loving. Then you'll never be at war. You'll always be in the peace that is present.

Choose to know yourself in the safety and protection of the Lord our God. John-Roger has said that the secret of Soul Transcendence is to look for the good in all people and things and leave the rest to God. So look for the good. Choose to love it all regardless. And remember, no matter how the negativity may come your way, you are in the ultimate safe harbor with the Traveler.

# Flooding Grace

## It was the night of the flooding

rains in Colorado this past September and I was happily in bed when I got a call that a property I own was flooding. I jumped up, dressed and headed to the other side of town to spend 2 1/2 hours bailing water. At about 11:30pm I was just too tired to go on so I packed it in and headed home. I hadn't known about the flooding of roads, hadn't heard the news, had no idea of the deluge or devastation happening in Boulder county. It was midnight but people were out in the night as I drove through the center of Boulder, in the rain, in the power, experiencing it, awed, taking pictures, amazed. I was awed to be out in such a storm and exhilarated and astonished.

As I got to the north end of town I encountered a river of water washing over the road. It was deep but I got through. There were no cars in this part of town, no people out here, just rain and water everywhere. I said a prayer of thanks that I had gotten through but then, seemingly out of nowhere, because visibility was nonexistent and I couldn't tell what was happening, I heard a voice yell at me, "Catherine, pay attention you are in extreme danger." The water was rushing all around me, the new river was up to the hood of my truck. I didn't know how the truck could still be running. I said, "Traveler, Traveler, Traveler!!!" Then started assessing my options.

Turn around? Inwardly I heard, "too late." "Stop?" Inwardly I heard, "NO! The truck could get washed downstream from the force if you stop and don't have momentum." Then I heard, "Keep your forward momentum, keep driving at the fastest rate you can but not too fast or you will hydroplane, open the passenger window so you can escape if the truck gets washed off the road and remember your body is tired, you won't be able to swim very far." I checked what I was wearing. Should I take off my coat so it won't weigh me down if I have to swim? Where's my cell phone? I heard, "No, no time for that, keep driving, both hands on the wheel, careful, careful."

Then I said, "Lord, part these waters." And I watched two waves of water pour off my truck on either side and I could see the hood of the truck again. I drove straight through. All I could see were two walls of water on either side of me, but pouring off the truck and strangely not coming in the passenger's window.

Soon I was on high ground, safe.

The next day I knew I had to go back and start bailing the house on the other side of town again, but I had moments of fear and quite honestly, self pity, so I called a friend who lived on that side of town and asked him if he could go and check on the house. He bitched and moaned so much I hung up on him. Waves of judgement. "Okay," I said to myself, "Stop the judgements, stop the whining. Just stop it. He doesn't really want to help you and you need to gird up, surpass your fear and get back in the truck." As I drove through town, a different route this time, the devastation was immense. I bailed for awhile till I could bail no longer, grateful for my strength that I could even do it, and went back home the way of the epic journey of the night before.

This time the road was closed and blockaded with police. I saw the first river I traversed and couldn't believe I had gotten through. There were trees floating and rocks and deep water. I was too far from the second river to see it but found out two people had died that night where I had driven. Their car had been washed away. Another man's car had flipped at the first river I had traversed and he was trapped for five hours under water with a small breathing space that had kept him alive until the scuba rescuers could get to him.

I am living in Grace. I have dodged the bullet twice in the past 12 months, once from advanced cancer and a few weeks ago driving in the most devastating natural disaster in our town. The odds were against me in both cases, but Grace is living me. At moments I am aware that I AM Grace, but only, at this point in my evolvement, at moments. I pray for Grace for all of us and that the moments when we know we are Grace come gently and we can pass them on to each other.

As an aside, this past Monday I was called to work on a TV show for National Geographic and spent the day with three people who had been involved with the Columbine shooting (the shootings at Columbine High School where two killers shot 13 kids and one teacher). Two of them, the principal and a student, had both been confronted by one of the shooters. Both had been spared, miraculously. In the case of the student, a girl had been crouched behind a table with the student we were interviewing and was shot and killed point blank. Also, the principal, although he was in front of the shooter, was spared as the killer shot another teacher instead of him. The director asked these two people why they thought they hadn't been shot and they both said they didn't know, but it was God.

The interviews were intense and gut-wrenching. Present time stopped and during the times when the principal and the {now} young woman were describing their moments with the shooters, we were there in the school with them. It was all present. I could hear the screaming, the shots, feel the terror. Clearly, much still needed to be cleared even 15 years later. I asked inwardly, "What is clearing?" And heard, "You don't need to know." I called in the Traveler many times and heard, "Hold in the presence." "Hold!"

On the way home, I was shaky and nauseous so called a fellow minister for a "ministerial debriefing." She helped me clear myself and I was fine. And then I thought, "Now I know why I was spared during the flood. It was for this day of service."

I am a servant of the Lord and I am grateful. What's next Lord?



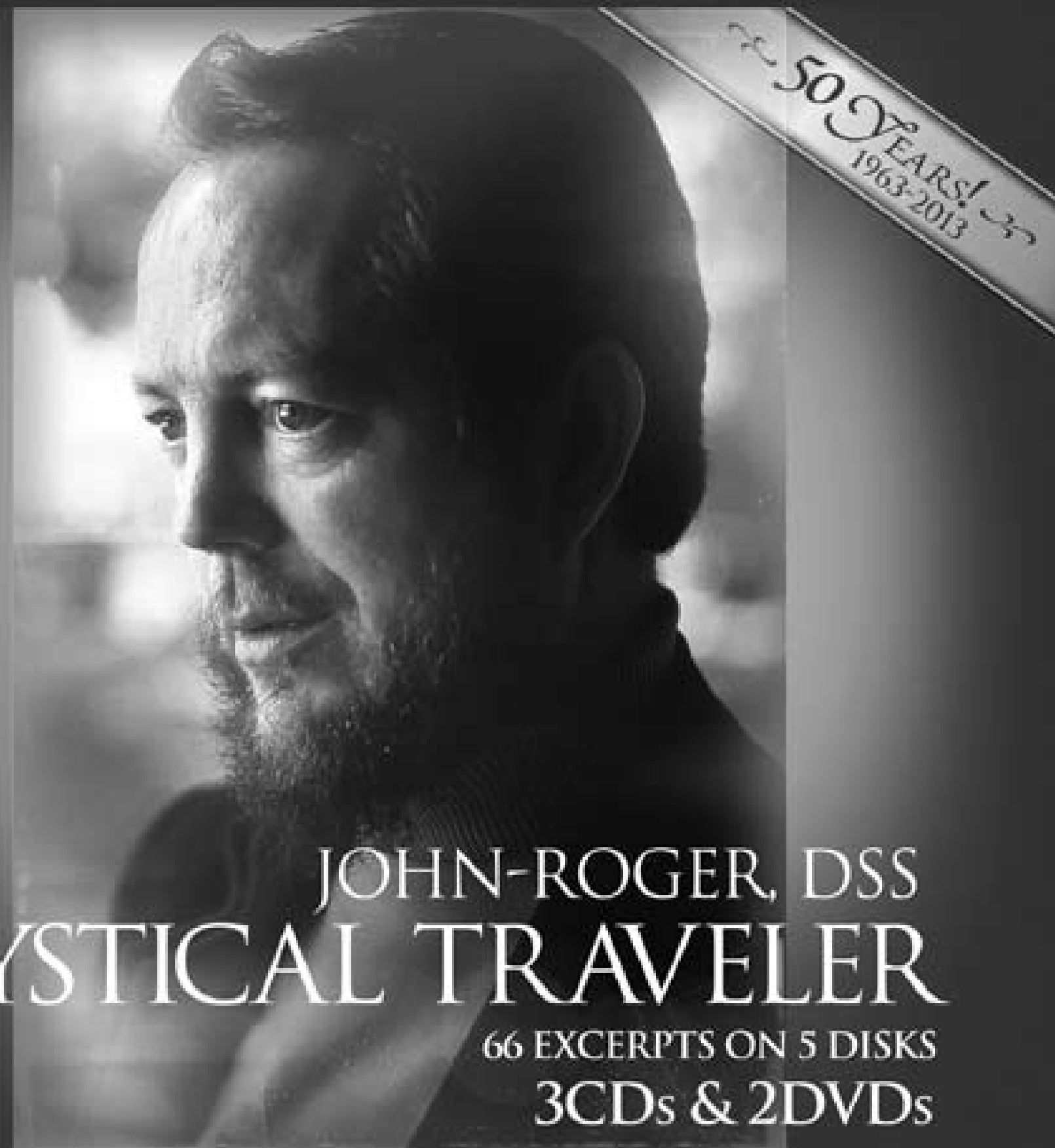

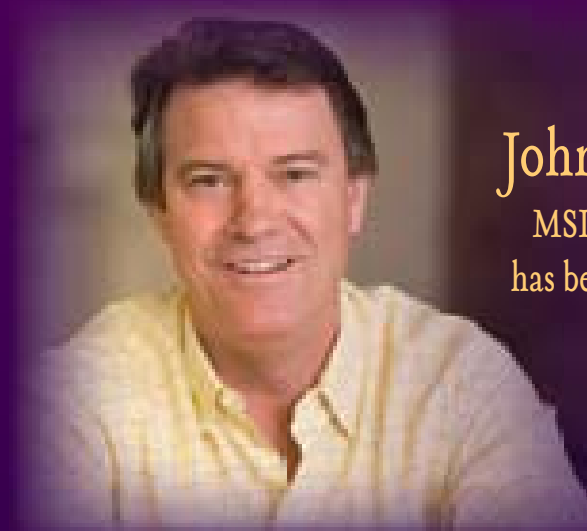

# J-R'S MYSTICAL TRAVELER MOVIE AT MAR DEL PLATA INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

**In June**, just before Conference, we were approached by friends of the famous Argentinian actress Graciela Borges, who told us they might be able to get the new film, *Mystical Traveler: The Life and Times of Dr. John-Roger* accepted in the annual Mar del Plata international film festival. The festival is one of the most prestigious in the world—and the most prestigious in Latin America—and Graciela Borges is one of Argentina's most famous actresses. If you're from the U.S. think Meryl Streep, or if you're from the U.K. think Helen Mirren, and you'll get the idea.

So Graciela and her son Juan Cruz Bordeu, along with longtime MSIA'er Kate Kirby, looked for ways to get the film shown and promoted, they talked to Jsu Garcia (who directed the film along with John-Roger), and together they got the film accepted and scheduled at the festival.

The next step was getting J-R to the festival. Jsu ran the idea by J-R but didn't get the green light until just before it started. Jsu told me, "One night I woke up in a cold sweat imagining myself at 80 years old, full of regret, wishing that I had tried harder to get J-R and the teachings out there. So I kept at it. Even if J-R indicated that he wasn't interested in going, I would keep a travel plan available in case he changed his mind. And at the last minute he said OK. All along, I was just thinking of that movie line, 'Build it and he will come.' It's been like a dream and I find it miraculous that J-R would come at the 11th hour to support the film and to spread the light to the Argentinian people."

So J-R took off with a few friends. It was bus to airport to bus to hotel, rest, bus to airport to Buenos Aires, then on to the beautiful beach resort Mar del Plata, a five hour bus ride from Buenos Aires through cow-studded fields. Sort of a combination of La Jolla and Brighton, England.

If it weren't for Graciela, none of this would have happened. And she had huge help from some very accomplished and influential people in Argentina, whose devotion to Graciela and/or J-R made it all work: her son, MSIA Minister and actor Juan Cruz Bordeu; MSIA Minister Katherine Kirby; Jose Martinez Suarez, President of the Festival, longtime friend of Graciela (and of Errol Flynn and lots of the old Hollywood stars during his film career spanning the period of 1929 to the present—a 90-year-old gentleman who has been involved in the Mar del Plata film festival since its founding by Juan Peron

in 1953); Jorge Telerman, former mayor of Buenos Aires and National Secretary of Culture; Fernando Spiner, producer of the festival who helped get the movie accepted; and Guillermo Rossi, in charge of Special Activities, who was a great help getting the technical details ironed out.

It was amazing to watch J-R in Argentina. There is an open-heartedness there that seems to enable people to "get" J-R with just the slightest contact. People would pass by him in a cafe or in front of a movie theater and ask who he is, much more often than in recent trips in the U.S. or England. That open-hearted quality seemed to give them a sensitivity that would see beyond the outer physical details and distractions, so that they could feel the light energy without any outer cues.

Our first night in Mar del Plata was the opening of the festival, and it was a huge, Felliniesque affair with crowds of fans (see the photos of Jsu, Graciela and our crew walking the red carpet, cheered by throngs of people behind barricades), paparazzi and film crews running through

Everywhere the journalists, photographers, fans and film crews followed Graciela—and us, since we were there as her guests.

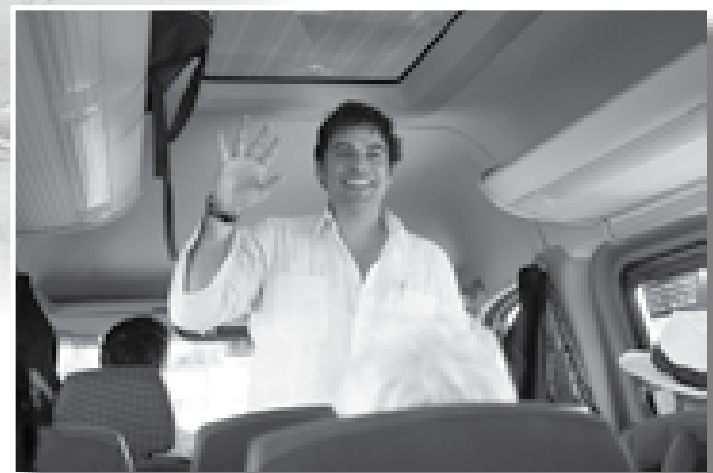
The opening included a documentary detailing the history of the festival, with old black and white footage featuring Hollywood stars visiting Argentina, such as Edward G. Robinson, Errol Flynn, Fred McMurray, Mary Pickford, etc.

The second night of the festival involved two showings of the *Mystical Traveler* movie, attended by J-R, with Q&A with Jsu, Graciela, and Juan

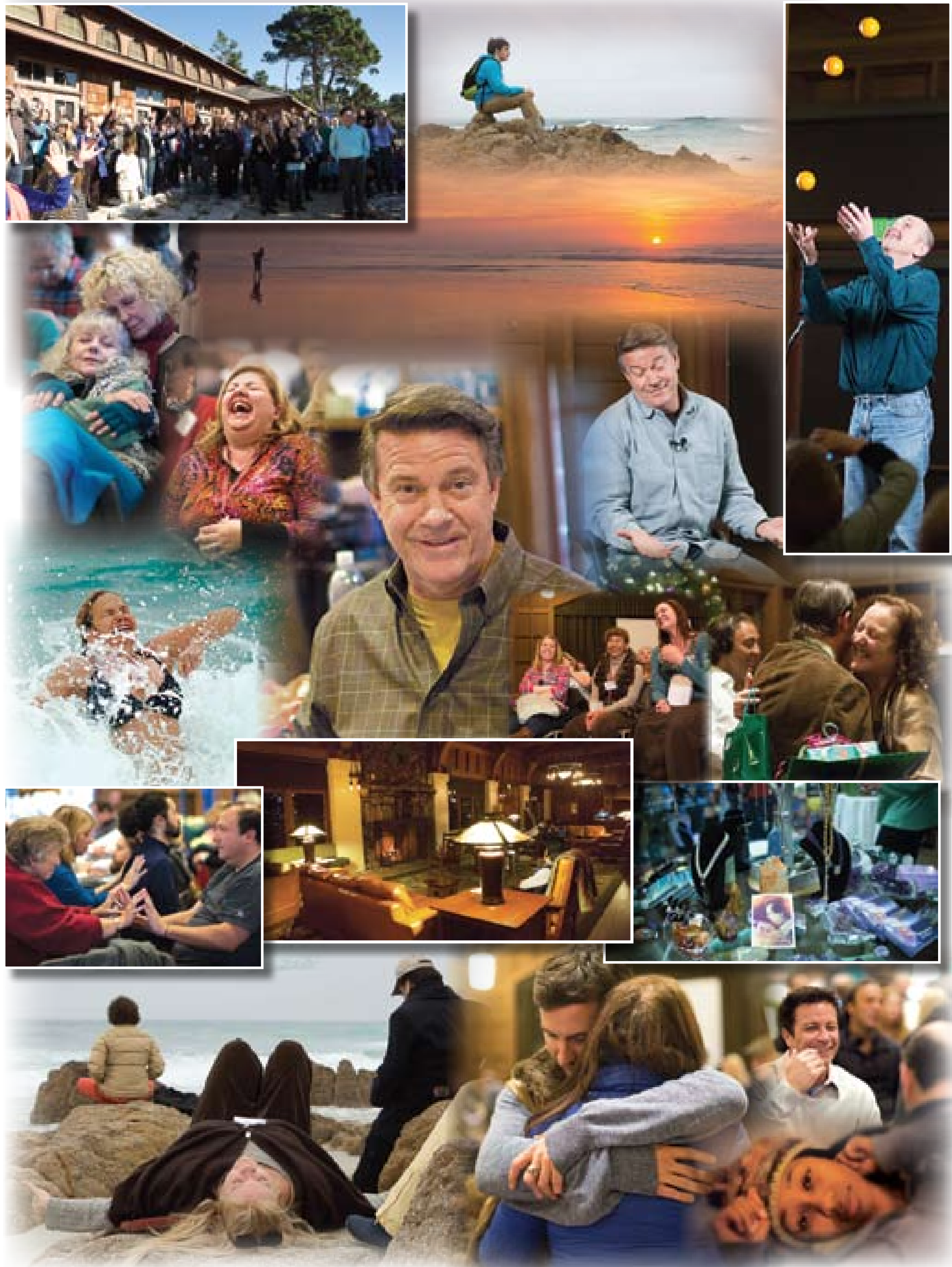

# An Invitation to the Spiritual Exercises Retreat in Norwalk CT

It is amazing to come off a retreat and feel revitalized, lifted, clear in our purpose and in direct contact with God. But then, how are we six months later when the gas bill is due, the animals make messes, our co-workers make it so difficult for us to forgive them, when our autumn comes upon us?

It could seem late to be writing about our SE retreat held last Spring, but with the changing seasons and our plans to start registration for our 6th annual SE retreat, I couldn't help reflect on what transpired in May, why I am attending next year without hesitation and, the majority of participants will also return, if past history is an indicator. I was also infinitely curious to see how Dolce looked in the fall (see pictures).

For those of you who haven't heard about the SE retreat, it is held every year at the Dolce Center in Norwalk, CT. The grounds and buildings were originally a seminary of the "The Holy Ghost Fathers" and the long-standing spiritual intention on the property is evident. Thankfully the facility has been modernized with the latest amenities, walking trails, ponds, pools and some of the best food you have ever tasted. No onion or garlic? Hassle free for these talented chefs.

This year the online participants were added and they were most welcomed. One of the best descriptions came from one of them, stating the retreat was "Like a mini Living in Grace". That is exactly what it feels like to me, and others commented that each year the energy keeps building. As mentioned, many folks

return year after year and thus the intention of the group has produced a very sacred place. SE's, sharing with the Traveler and experiencing the teachings of both J-R and John Morton set an irresistible tone.

*"Sit down, get to your holy place, go to the temple within and say, 'You and me, Lord. You and me.' Take the phone off the hook, turn the beeper off, put a sign on the door that says, 'Do not disturb, God is here."*

*Sit in spiritual exercises and experience that point of convergence where the invisible Spirit comes in and touches to your physical Spirit and you are One."*

John opened the retreat speaking about empathy and other laws of Spirit: acceptance, cooperation and enthusiasm. He reminded us that empathy includes warmth and sharing, and that we can allow it to change us. In this, he reminded us to 'Just close our eyes and think of God', of sitting down, relaxing and going in. How the hours can go by as we look upon the radiance of the Lord (I believe that was from one of the J-R excerpts).

And we don't just do all this just sitting in a training room. We have longer lunch breaks that allow us to exercise, do more SE's or hike to reflect on our relationship with God. The grounds offer inspiration for this, and I am reminded how the intention we set in SE's is very similar to how J-R describes Angels in nature on P. 849, *Fulfilling Your Spiritual Promise*:

*"Angels are non physical beings that exist on every level, hold spiritual energy, and do spiritual work on those different levels of existence. One of their jobs is to praise God continuously, which is very joyful....Angels come through the devic kingdom, the realm of the nature spirits of air, water, earth and fire."*

— John Roger, *Fulfilling Your Spiritual Promise* p. 849.

As I crossed the back property to the main pond, I recalled John reminding us of the importance of the thoughts we hold in our mind and how we can invite the Traveler to address us – and so I did. I allowed the quiet of shuffling and falling leaves (they sound like a rain at times), and the birds persistent mirth to overtake me and I was soon quiet and back in the full peace of the retreat. Just like John talked about: the forgiveness, the anointing, the opportunity for full at-one-ment...How we can have a clear, radiant, dynamic and fluid relationship with Spirit. Wow! I no longer cared that I had to wait another hour or more for the sun to reach the far side of the pond, or that I fell into the water leaning into ground that wasn't apparently there. I simply laid down on the ground and let the experience of nature, my tone and the memories of the SE retreat flood through me.

I can only conclude that the depth of MSIA and PTS events do carry us through our seasons, our trials and tribulations, our SE's good and dry, our learnings and releasings. Thoreau sums it up nearly perfectly:

*"Live each season as it passes; breathe the air, drink the drink, taste the fruit, and resign yourself to the influences of each."*

Brief History of Dolce retreat Center from their website: The official name of the institution was St. Mary's Seminary, but it was generally know as "Ferndale" because of the abundance of ferns growing on the property. Ferndale was a largely self-contained facility where the seminarians were trained to serve as missionaries under difficult conditions that would often require them to perform not only spiritual tasks but practical ones as well. Members of the community served in various capacities such as barbers, shoemakers and photographers to meet the residents' needs.

## INITIATION

If you are just starting the Soul Awareness Discourses, Discourse #1 explains initiation into the Sound Current. You may choose to study the Discourses with the intention to be initiated on this path, or to simply read them as information. If you do choose to study toward initiation, the Traveler works with you more closely, and you may notice a greater spiritual awareness in your own consciousness as this work goes on.

If you are studying toward initiation, you need to write and mail a letter to the Traveler that this is your intention. If you have written and mailed your intention to the Traveler, you can apply for initiation when you have completed Discourse 24.

## THE MSIA MINISTRY

The MSIA ministry is for initiates of the Traveler who are called inwardly to serve the spirit of their hearts.

Service may be in any form, from volunteering for the Church to assisting people in need or organizations that serve those people, and anything in between. The only requirement is that the ministry is active and done regularly.

MSIA ministers may perform services, like marriages, that clergy of other denominations are authorized to do as long as they comply with the laws of the locality in which they serve.

## WRITING TO J-R & JOHN

Sometimes people reading Discourses, especially those studying toward initiation, want to write to John Morton or John-Roger. Writing often helps you let go of a troubling situation and open more to the Traveler's assistance inwardly.

As soon as you write to John Morton or John-Roger, they get the message on the spiritual levels, and they do what Spirit allows. Then, to let go of the situation in your consciousness, you burn or mail your letter. Whether you burn or mail what you wrote, you may find that you get your answers on the inner levels, sometimes very quickly. You may also experience greater calm, clarity, or peace, which can help you go through whatever challenges you face.

We suggest that you place the situation in the Light, ask for clarification during s.e.'s, dreams, etc., and then look for the answers within you. Often reading a Discourse or listening to an MSIA tape (either at home or at a seminar) will provide keys to assist you in handling your situation. You can also refer to any of the numerous books by J-R and John to find information that relates to what you are dealing with. These two have shared so much with us over the years, and we encourage you to send your letters via e-mail, using these addresses:
