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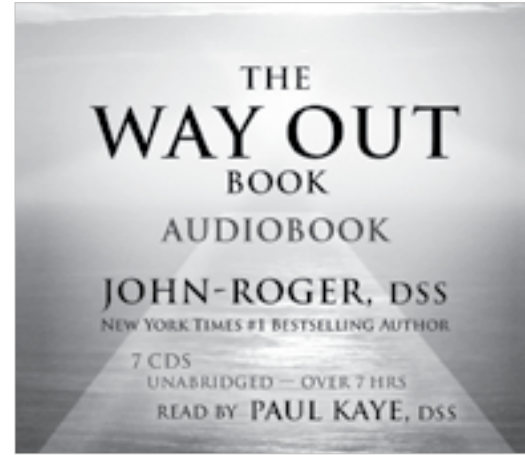

# John-Roger, DSS Awakening SOUL

When a Soul is stirred to awaken, to move on into its greater awareness, the paradoxes of life are placed before it to see if, in the expression of this part of God's kingdom, it can indeed express Godliness. And because this physical level is a composite of all levels (physical, imaginative, emotional, mental, and unconscious), we can clear things faster from this level than from any other level below the Soul.

If you find that you love God, you are separate from God. If you find God loving you, you are separate. It is when you find you are the Beloved that you become the path. You become the Light, the Truth and the Way. There is no separation; there is only the Beloved.

When a Soul is stirred to awaken, to move on into its greater awareness, the paradoxes of life are placed before it to see if, in the expression of this part of God's kingdom, it can indeed express Godliness. And because this physical level is a composite of all levels (physical, imaginative, emotional, mental, and unconscious), we can clear things faster from this level than from any other level below the Soul. So the Soul brings together the elements necessary to create a physical embodiment. The Soul can do this; the Soul, being divine, can do anything it wishes to do. It embodies onto this physical realm because it knows it can reveal itself faster from here than from any other level.

The Soul is a powerful creator. It brings forward those things for which the consciousness asks, whether in this lifetime or in another lifetime. Yet that which you have asked for often cannot be given to you here on this physical level. So you must wait until you reach the other levels to get it. If you have asked for things of a physical nature and leave this body before getting them, you may go to the astral realm, the realm closest to the physical, and get that which you asked for. And when you get it there, it can become greatly disturbing to your astral body. So you seek the purification from that. This purification is traditionally called "hell" or "purgatory," which isn't a negative process. It's the purification. It's getting rid of the last entanglements of the physical level.

God, in His perfect consciousness, has placed out certain patterns that each individualized consciousness, each Soul, must fulfill. And all humans will fulfill the patterns in their own timing. There are more

rapid ways and less rapid ways. If, indeed, you can be taught, the Soul will awaken itself on the physical level and dissolve all karmic bondage. Then you will be aware of Soul on this level and on all other levels. At that moment, you become what we call the "living free." There will not be one thing you can do that will not be perfect in the sight of God — not one thing. And you won't do anything that would not be in balance with who you are and where you are. Other people may look at you or your actions and condemn you, but what does that matter. They're condemning everybody — not just you. When I hear somebody saying something negative about me, I just look at

them, knowing that if they are talking about me, they're talking about everyone. Why should I have concern because they've singled out me? Their gossip will come back to them to be worked out at another time because that is the law.

It's nice to recognize that the Soul holds itself responsible for all its actions and creations. The consciousness may try to "get away with something" or may try to fool itself and lull itself into patterns of unawareness, but the Soul says, "These things I am. These are things for which I am responsible. These things I will fulfill right down to the last farthing." The Soul fulfills all things within itself.

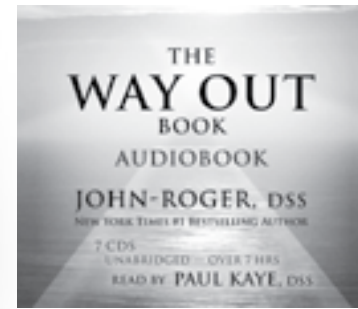

There are a lot of reasons why the Soul keeps coming back. In a way, it is a paradise here, but it is not as yet in the higher realms of Light and love. You can live here in the physical body and reside in heaven by being aware of both levels simultaneously. How do you do that? You get enough experience of this level; you develop a knowing of what this level is. Then you stop doing this, and you automatically start doing that.

To know consciously of the other side, you must shut your mouth to this side. You must not be the teacher. You must be the student.

The Soul, the essence of God within, is responsible. Ultimately, it is the author of all your actions. So pass the authorship to where it belongs. Jesus said, "Of myself I can do nothing. The Father within does all things." The Father is the God within or the Soul or whatever term you care to use. Often we call it the Light. Jesus said that he was the Light and the Truth and the Way. Buddha said that he was the Light of Asia. The Light that springs eternally is the Light of which we are speaking. It is the pure energy of Spirit.

When the Soul leaves the physical realm and starts upward, it becomes very easy to drop the imagination, very easy to drop the emotions and very easy to drop the mind. But when you get to the etheric level (the unconscious), you may look into the unconscious and see it reflect back to you the glories of the earth. Then you may enter into an identification with that glory and reincarnate. One way to break through the realm of the unconscious into Soul is to be working with one who has the keys, the knowledge and the ability to show you the illusion of the unconscious and the way through it into Soul.

When you get up very high from the earth, it looks like a paradise, a garden of Eden. I think one of the astronauts said this when he was quite high above the earth. When you get up high in your consciousness and look back, you may say, "Wow, that's paradise!" and impel yourself back again. There are a lot of reasons why the Soul keeps coming back. In a way, it is a paradise here, but it is not as yet in the higher realms of Light and love. You can live here in the physical body and reside in heaven by being aware of both levels simultaneously. How do you do that? You get enough experience of this level; you develop a knowing of what this level is. Then you stop doing this, and you automatically start doing that.

To know consciously of the other side, you must shut your mouth to this side. You must not be the teacher. You must be the student. When you explain something to someone, don't feel that they have to understand it, that they have to get it. That's cramming it down their throats, and no one is going to swallow that. You present a point of view to them and let them look at it. If they don't move on it, perhaps it wasn't for them. Perhaps they've already moved on it in another dimension. Perhaps they are yet to

experience that moving. Noninterference is so very important. It is so important to allow each consciousness, each Soul, the freedom to evolve into its own awareness in its own timing.

Before Mahatma Gandhi was released from the physical body, he knew very well that his assassination was coming. A detective said, "Let me protect you; let me go with you." Mahatma Gandhi asked what else he would bring with him. He said, "My gun." Gandhi said, "Don't come with your gun; leave your gun." The detective said, "I can't do that. I couldn't protect you without my gun." Gandhi said, "Then it isn't you who protects me; it's your gun." Force does not work. But as we just stand beside another person and support them with our love and Light, that helps. Gandhi was not going to let anybody interfere with the order of things, lest someone be shot in his name. Within his consciousness he would much rather be murdered than be the murderer. Gandhi was a great Soul and knew his Soul in consciousness.

The same awareness of Soul is ours for the taking, but we must do it. We must manifest the same teachings that have been taught all along. Love is. It is non-interfering. It is supporting. It's that which says, "Look, I may not understand everything going on, but that doesn't mean you can't do it, just because I don't understand it." Love is, "I don't know the words and the vocabulary seems strange to me, but that doesn't mean it's not valid and can't be worked." The first time I heard the dialect of an African country, I said, I certainly don't know what is being said, but the people who are communicating do." And sometimes you'll hear people talking about physics or computer sciences and say, "I can't understand a word they say, but they know." Those who are doing it understand. Maybe you don't need to understand computer programming. Maybe you need to understand yourself. And when you do this, you find out what it's like to walk with the Beloved. # FORGIVING YOURSELF: A KEY TO FORGIVENESS

*There's something about we humans on this planet that no matter what we do, we seem to find that eventually we come around to an error or a mistake. That's rather universal in this world. You've probably heard it said, "To err is human; to forgive, divine." I think that knowing our divinity and ourselves as spiritual beings in this world has a whole lot to do with what forgiveness is all about.*

Most of us perceive that we have done some form of wrongdoing or made a mistake or an error at some time in our lives. There's something about we humans on this planet that no matter what we do, we seem to find that eventually we come around to an error or a mistake. That's rather universal in this world. You've probably heard it said, "To err is human; to forgive, divine." I think that knowing our divinity and ourselves as spiritual beings in this world has a whole lot to do with what forgiveness is all about.

For the word "forgiveness," the dictionary notes two definitions. The first definition is "active pardoning someone for a mistake or wrongdoing." Let me remind you that "active pardoning" would include yourself. So make sure if you're dealing with forgiveness, you consider it an act of pardoning yourself for what is considered a mistake or wrongdoing.

What goes on in our learning and growing and in our human experience always comes back to ourself. Somehow each experience begins and ends with ourself. Whatever is in between, as far as whoever and whatever else is there, it's going to ultimately be about you. Pardoning or forgiveness always includes an opportunity to forgive yourself.

The second definition for forgiveness is "a forgiving quality." So forgiveness is a part of the action of forgiving. There are other qualities, but forgiveness is a particular quality which is the tendency to forgive offenses readily and easily.

Do you have the tendency to forgive offenses readily and easily? Consider if you also have the tendency to forgive the offenders readily and easily. Do you have that as a commitment? Do you have that as a dedication or a willingness? Or is it an accident or something you wouldn't consider doing?

I've heard the point of view that if we forgive an offender or an offense, we're actually perpetuating it in some way. I consider it's a mistake, an error in itself, to assume that to forgive or pardon an offender is like teaching them to do that again. From my point of view and my own experience, if we don't forgive, if we don't pardon, that's what perpetuates the offense. To be unforgiving is what can allow or encourage the error to occur again.

I consider that we're all here in this world learning to forgive. We're here as human beings to learn to pardon. That's a primary purpose in our life. God bless you if you haven't come around

to that yet, if you haven't realized that you're here to let go and let yourself out of the position of being the one who's judging or making sure a condemnation is carried out. You're here to learn to forgive, yourself as well as others and all that happens in this world.

John-Roger wrote the book, *Forgiveness: The Key to the Kingdom*. What is that kingdom? The kingdom of God. I see that forgiveness isn't the only key because there are other keys. However, those keys are so related to forgiveness that if you forgive, you'll be doing all the keys to the kingdom.

Imagine this --- if you are willing to forgive and forgive completely all of the offenses, all of the errors and all of the mistakes, you would have a life of freedom. You would have the keys that go with access to the kingdom. You would be releasing yourself from the limitations, conditions, and all the challenges that go on in this world.

If you've ever played a sport such as golf then you probably had an experience like me that life on the golf course can be frustrating. Life can be difficult and challenging on whatever course you happen to play or wherever that may be. Maybe it's your work, your marriage, your parents, or just your place in traffic somewhere. John-Roger said, "You must forgive yourself all things. You must have compassion for all people and the things they have done."

Now, maybe you're in disagreement already. Perhaps you're considering the idea that if you forgive yourself all things or have compassion for all people, that's a mistake. That would be encouraging offenses or more mistakes and errors. You might say, "I don't need to forgive them. I need to point out to them the error of their ways. It's my place to teach them how wrong they are or the many ways they err." That isn't your place, so let that go.

Maybe you aren't aware of any moment where you've forgiven yourself all things or where you had a moment of compassion for all people and all the things they have done. That would mean including everyone in the history of the planet, including those who lived before as well as those coming after us. In your own movement of spiritual inner awareness, you may realize you've been one of those people in the past. You could also consider that you may be one of the people up and coming, which is sometimes referred to as reincarnation or re-embodiment.

John-Roger has said that when you've forgiven all and had compassion for all then, "You've done it to the least one of these. You've done it unto me. When you've done it unto me, the divinity makes itself known and floods the system. We then see God in all beings and we see the divine in all things." That last statement is talking about the kingdom. So when we have forgiven ourself all things and we have compassion for all people and the things they have done regardless, we see God in all beings. We see the divine in all things. That's the secret of Soul Transcendence as John-Roger has defined it --- "to look for the good and divine and all people and things and leave the rest to God."

## Placing Judgments in the Light

It's important to look at our judgments, whatever they may be. We want to hold them up and cast them into the light. So let's bring light unto all judgments, particularly those which would register on the scale as the greatest judgments. Perhaps there's one judgment that you consider to be the greatest judgment. Bring that one into the light especially and remember to always ask for the highest good.

In *Forgiveness: The Key to the Kingdom*, there's the question, "Why am I here?" Maybe that's never occurred to you as a question. However, here's J-R's response, "Judgments are one of the most unhealthy things we can do on all of our levels. If we were to ask what the big reason is that we're all back here, I'd say it was because of a judgment we placed somewhere, because our judgments are all held against us, and they're held within in the place where we judged."

So if we judge physically, the judgments are held physically, and we come into this world to clear them. Yet, what do we often do instead? We do more judging. We go into more judgment.

John-Roger continues, "It's enough to make you want to say, 'Cut out my tongue before I do another judgment.'" What if it's not of your tongue? What if it's of your mind? What do you do then? You can say to yourself, "I forgive that judgment."

I realize that forgiving your judgments may not always be the first thing that comes to your mind. When you're in the midst of your judgment, you may not immediately think, "I forgive that judgment." So if you do judge, John-Roger adds, "The idea is not to beat yourself up and say, 'I shouldn't judge myself,' because that is also an action of judgment. Say instead, 'I will be kind to myself. I will be good to myself. I will have peace and harmony with myself. I am forgiving myself for judging myself.'" That's a good way to place your judgments in the light.

## Empathy and Compassion

I look at forgiveness as an aspect of the laws of spirit. John-Roger has identified that there are spiritual laws such as acceptance, cooperation, understanding, enthusiasm, and empathy. I consider that empathy relates directly to forgiveness. In the thesaurus, empathy is considered a synonym for compassion, and I find compassion relates directly to forgiveness. When we have compassion for ourselves and others and all things, we're into the forgiveness. We're present with it and perhaps in such a way that we don't really have to think about it. We don't have to think, "Well, do I have compassion?" Compassion happens naturally. Our compassion, our empathy, automatically ushers us into the forgiveness.

We don't hold judgment when we're in empathy because we realize that there but for the grace of God go I. There's something humbling about that knowing. It's an understanding that if I judge you, I'm judging myself. I'm also doing something that's unnecessary when I'm judging. I'm putting a restriction down. I'm putting an again-ness in place.

It's important to come to the realization that our mistakes, our errors, our encounters with evil if you will, whatever the negativity may be, are sufficient. It's already enough. So there's enough negativity, evil, errors, mistakes, sins, etcetera, such that we don't need to add more. When we judge, we add to the negativity automatically. If nothing else, we add to our own negativity. Adding to the negativity equates to being stupid or acting stupid because what it does is create unnecessary burdens, pain, disturbance, anguish, suffering, restrictions, etc. None of that is necessary.

Maybe you feel you can't always keep your thoughts clean, clear and upright. Perhaps you think you don't know how to steer clear of judgment. I suggest you do know how. It's in your choices. Do you choose to judge? Are

# FORGIVING YOURSELF: A KEY TO FORGIVENESS

you willing to choose not to judge? Do you choose to clear out the judgment? To dismiss it? Or do you choose to hold onto your judgment? You can always choose forgiveness, especially those times when you've judged.

Have compassion for yourself. Choose to forgive yourself for having judged. That is a key to forgiveness.

## Good for the Soul

In the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness, we encourage looking at our judgments. That's how we bring them into the light. It's like a form of confession. You've probably heard that confession is good for the soul. We practice the good for your soul part. There's goodness for you as a spiritual being as well as your humanness to acknowledge, own up, admit, and speak to those judgments.

Where there is judgment, there's also the one within who might want to hide, pretend, deny, or lie. Consider we all have a part of us who would want to deny our judgments. It's part of our human experience. However, when we look at our judgments, what often happens is that the part of us who would choose to judge seems to surface. So confessing about our judgments can often be an experience of confrontation with our humanness.

You may find that you aren't all that willing to look at your judgments, that you aren't eager to enter into confrontation with your humanness and past errors or mistakes. You may even think that there are things that God does not know and that you can hide. I consider that there is no thing that God doesn't know. So God knows, always has known, knows all the time, and doesn't forget. However, God is forgiveness. God is always forgiving. That's the God we're dealing with in the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness --- the highest God, the God that knows all, loves all, and forgives all.

If you want to move into the divine, to know yourself more fully as the spiritual being that you are, then you're going to be having a face-to-face confrontation with God. To see the face of God, it takes courage to face yourself in your entirety and in every detail. You're called upon to rise up to any judgment that you carry, knowing the process of awakening and enlightening yourself is good for your soul's learning and growth while you are in this world.

Now you may judge that you don't have the courage to confront your judgments. You may consider that you're not strong enough to confess what you really need to confess. Forgive yourself for your doubts, hesitation or trepidations. Your process of

confrontation is leading you to forgiveness. It's not an exercise about judgment or increasing your judging of yourself. It's an exercise in forgiveness and forgiving yourself especially. Our judgments stand in the way of forgiveness. Judgment keeps you from knowing and realizing the kingdom of God which is full of love, grace, joy and harmony and always available to you.

## Self-Forgiveness

It's important to look at what you're judging or expecting of yourself. It's probably going to be something in the area of Shoulda, woulda, coulda. You might be saying to yourself, "I should have done this. I could have been that. I would have been that if only. . ." Look at what didn't occur such that you judged yourself, for example, "It was this, but it wasn't this." That will be where the judgment showed up.

When you've judged, regardless of how you judged somebody or something, it always leads back to you. You're judging yourself. So have that realization which means you can skip judging the situation and just ask yourself, "What was I judging myself for or judging myself as?" If you don't know how to do that, or you're not yet aware of how you judged yourself, you can simply choose self-forgiveness saying, "I forgive myself for judging myself for \_\_\_\_\_" or "I forgive myself for judging myself as \_\_\_\_\_."

When you judge someone else "for" or "as," you're actually judging yourself in that way. This is an important point --- when you judge someone or something else, you're actually doing it to yourself. So you're actually being very efficient when you move directly into self-forgiveness. You skip how you are judging others and move right into, "I forgive myself for judging myself," however that fits and works for you.

If you feel you've messed up or erred, and you say, "I could never forgive that," you have just cursed yourself. As long as you won't forgive, it's going to hurt you or bother you. It's going to compromise you. One day, you'll have to forgive it. So why not today? Forgiveness is the great healer. I recommend a seminar from John-Roger called, Christ is Forgiveness. If you want that consciousness, the consciousness of the Christ who forgives all regardless, you can embrace the forgiveness now by starting with yourself.

We receive a blessing into the mind and the spirit when we say, "I forgive myself for judging. . ." So say it over and over and over. Minds like to judge. So have the intention to keep the mind in forgiveness. Strive to keep a consciousness and focus that your purpose in this world is to steer clear of judgment and maintain a consciousness of forgiveness.

Do your best to stay neutral and let go of judgments. I would venture that you will often find yourself humbled. Sometimes the mind just won't let go of something. So ask for help from the Lord. Go into worship and present yourself before the Lord. "Help me let this go, Lord." Keep calling on the Lord's name because the Lord needs to come forth with your invitation. There are parts of us that want to pull us away from our worship. Bodies can be attracted to things in the world, and emo-

tions can emphasize the distractions. So how do we maintain that consciousness of neutrality and forgiveness? With our devotion.

Choose to take yourself into worship and withdraw from the world. In MSIA, we call it spiritual exercise, and it is always available as your choice. Your judgments can be lifted from you, but you must choose to hold yourself before the Lord and ask to receive of the blessings of forgiveness. Then God's grace can be done.

## Eternal Vigilance

Eternal vigilance is a password for forgiveness. In the book, Passage into Spirit, eternal vigilance is defined by John-Roger as "the constant state of awareness where no harm is meant or intended for anything." So it really doesn't matter what someone does or how they may judge you. It doesn't even matter that perhaps you don't want to forgive them. You can still choose to forgive. It comes back to, "I forgive myself for judging. . ." whatever it is that you hold as the judgment, even if that includes when the person is unwilling to forgive you. You could then say, "I forgive myself for judging that person for their unwillingness to forgive."

Consider that someone unwilling to forgive you is actually reflecting to you your own unwillingness to forgive. Even if you consider that you're always willing to forgive everyone, you can acknowledge that some part of you is still learning. You can take that humble step to place forgiveness into the unconscious level, accepting that you may not yet be aware of that part of you that holds onto judgment and resists moving into forgiveness. If you're dealing with someone who finds you unforgiveable, you can choose to forgive anyway. You can choose to forgive any action that you took or that somebody else took. You can forgive it all. So if it's an action, situation, or condition, material or biological, past, present or future, you can still forgive it regardless.

You can forgive even when you don't know how to put words on it. You can simply say, "I forgive myself." If you think, "Well, I don't believe it. I think that's a lie," then you can forgive that part of you who thinks that's a lie. You can say, "I forgive myself for thinking it's a lie that I forgive myself." Just keep the forgiving going, no matter what is thrown at you. That's eternal vigilance.

"The basic thing we need to do is forgive ourselves for forgetting that we are divine," John-Roger has said. So keep choosing to bring your awareness to, "I forgive myself. I forgive my judgments. I forgive it all. I forgive." That's the consciousness of the Christ that loves all and forgives all. Forgive yourself as God forgives you. That's a key to forgiveness --- the key to the kingdom of God.



# Forgiveness Prayer

From: You Are the Blessings (Book and CD)

Dear Lord, we ask for Your blessing. We have come to You in forgiveness--- first of all, the forgiveness that You have issued to all of Your creation, that You do love regardless of what is done, regardless of the state of Your creation as it moves through all the emanations, all the forms, all the precise moments. You love unconditionally, and we come to You in this love. We come to You in Your sound, in Your silence. We simply come to You as we are, in our own acceptance, in our own unconditionality.

We have let go of the judgments. We have let go of any condemnation that would hold negativity into our presence. And we still may not know how to let go or surrender completely, for we hang on to our ignorance, our stupidity, our rigidity, and our karma, that which we have done that is unnecessary. We ask for that presence that is the Lord, the Lord of us all, by whatever name it is called, that Lord, the supreme, who is forgiveness. We bring it to that one, that we may offer it up in our humbleness, in our willingness to let go.

We find that what remains is our purity, our clarity, that which is the true glamour, that which is the brilliance, the purity, the light.

And as we are willing to forgive ourselves, we render this forgiveness unto others as the love of the Lord that You bring to us, which unburdens us and takes from us that which is disease, anguish, condemnation, that which is the wedge in our eye that would not allow us to see. So we now see clearly. We behold the Light and love that is the Holy of Holies.

And we find ourselves upright. We are whole. We are strong. We are full of the vitality, the life force that is the Spirit. And we find that it is radiating to all. We realize the simplicity of this moment, the blessings that are always present.

We accept this commission, which is the way of the Lord, the anointed one. We find that it is to love all regardless, to forgive all regardless. And we know when we have lost our way, we are to forgive, we are to accept.

In this presence, we realize the contributions that you are always making. Every experience teaches. Every moment offers an opportunity to gain, to grow, to move past that which binds.

We breathe this in, that it is radiated to every part of our being. And we breathe it out, that it is going freely to all. And again we ask that You place into us this consciousness that is awake, that we may always know it. And again realizing our humanity, that we are bound to forget and to lose track of our divinity and the divinity in all, we accept Your forgiveness. And we understand that as we bring this forgiveness within, it creates the greater capacity to go out.

And so we do.

# FIVE YEARS OF GROWTH IN MSIA

Muriel Engle  
Traces the Roots  
of the Movement  
from Santa Barbara  
to the World

I had been given a sign, and the clue was “the Praying Hands on a golden disc on a golden chain.”*

You asked me to tell you something of myself. I could tell you that somehow, somehow, I have been blessedly guided, pushed, directed and protected through some of the most harrowing and some of the most sublime experiences this planet has to offer. But no more dramatic adventure could have unfolded for me than the privilege of sharing in the early development of the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness. I do believe that somewhere in the archives there should be a record of how it all started. Jack Reed's contribution in the first issue of the Movement Newspaper was terrific and now I shall add to it.

Two years prior to Aug. of 1967, when I first met John-Roger in the physical, it had been predicted by a well known Sensitive [a term used to describe psychics, channelers, etc.—Ed.] that I would, within that time, meet a young man who would be a great and lasting influence in my sojourn here and with whom I would work closely. No elaboration was given at that time; I was to abide quietly and be patient, for this meeting was to precede important changes in my life. Patience has never been my forte, but I did keep this counsel to myself. If it were to be such an important milestone, I was reluctant to permit any opportunity for a “set-up.” However, I had been given a sign, and the clue was “the Praying Hands on a golden disc on a golden chain.”

In the meantime, my assignment was the development of the Educational Opportunity Program on the UCSB campus — recruiting and sustaining a larger minority enrollment on a campus which

was almost entirely white middle-class. I had been a counselor and an administrative assistant, doing a variety of things here since 1956. In this particular project, I needed all the help I could get against difficult odds. One young man who came forward was Robert Waterman, a student then. And another beautiful soul, also a student at that time and for whom I've thanked God many times, was Jack Reed.

The relationship between Robert, Jack and me developed in several areas of concern; assisting me in the EOP, but we also spent an increasing amount of time together off-campus. Jack now and then mentioned a friend of his he thought we ought to meet, who did “structure-function Light readings.” I wasn't sure what that was and his references seemed vague to me; at that time I was coping with other demands more pressing, so my responses weren't more than “uh-huh”, until just before the Spring 1967 quarter drew to a close. Jack seriously, then, bid for an assist in sponsoring a lecture by John-Roger in Santa Barbara; so we dug in, hacked out some publicity, got the use of a little temple downtown, and Lo! it came to pass that early August of 1967, we did indeed sponsor such a program. Little did we reckon then such far-reaching consequences.

That evening was full of surprises. I must honestly report that John-Roger's poise and his own contained awareness left me with the first impression of aloofness. With his opening flash of wit (I didn't know Daniel, then — one of his basic selves) initially, my mental comment was, “Oho!

he's clever but there is arrogance here.” In about two seconds flat, I was bargaining with the “Powers-That-Be” to “please let me retract that judgment.” when I heard him say, “I'm going to present some techniques of expanding your consciousness which will enable you to recognize and understand certain personality traits and characteristics in others; but more important, this will help you see yourself more clearly. I ask only that you keep an open mind; if it works for you, use it. If you have better methods, please share them with me. But if you ever hear me say, ‘this is the only way,’ please ask me to sit down.”

This was simply said. This was not arrogance; the inner was humble, the outer detached. I sat forward. I was not going to miss one word of what this young man had to say.

I learned much I had never heard before. A whole new dimension opened up. During the discourse, this amazing teacher demonstrated his principles as he went along. I knew many of the people there and was further persuaded, by the accuracy of his quick spot analyses, that this was no ordinary presentation. Because some are shy and because I sat in the first row, I volunteered first. He was honest but not unkind. His method of handling the vocabulary to fit each one's understanding has always impressed me. He told me I would experience a change of consciousness about the first of the year. I listened but had to admit I didn't understand.

“Would you understand better if I said you would take another initiation around the first of the year?” This time I understood the words but could not then comprehend their import. “And it looks like this will represent some extensive travel.” At that time I was planning a combination business and pleasure vacation which would entail about a six-week tour of the United States, but how the two might fit together was quite obscure to me.

My son Marshall was the last volunteer and before he sat down, J-R asked his name. Now “Marshall” is not an unusual appellation and I wondered at J-R's obvious surprise as I overheard him ask Marshall to wait after the meeting.

There is another phase, concerning this meeting, that bears on this story. I smile now and then, with just a few added years of experience, when I think of how often we are unaware of the inner operation

toward one end, while we are blissfully completing an outer action believing that is the end itself. If this sounds too cryptic, read on. Marshall, just returned from Air Force boot camp, had brought with him the aura of “hero” and the mother and grandmother influence in the home responded happily with laurels. Son had suggested that he and several of buddies might accompany us to the meeting if there were a home-cooked spaghetti dinner forthcoming, ergo mother up to her elbows in the preparation when son arrives home sans guests. What to do with all that food?

“All is not lost, Mom. You can bring everybody home as usual and it will go quickly.” “Oh, no, not as usual! This isn't my party this time and Jack has other plans for dinner. Besides I'm trying to learn to keep my mouth shut tonight, I'll practice.”

Meanwhile, back at the meeting. After seeing my personally invited guests off, I returned to the group around John-Roger just in time to hear him question Jack about the expected plans for dinner.

“The people didn't show up.”

“That's O.K. But let's go, I haven't eaten since breakfast.” After some hesitation — again - “You know the town, man, let's go.”

This was hard on Jack . . . Anna was new then and I imagine student resources were not especially affluent. He didn't want to impose. Several moments of feet shuffling as the silence grew louder, then Marshall filled that space with, “Well, Mom, you've got all that spaghetti.” See what I mean? What can you do when the Gods unravel your well-knit intentions? So we all caravanned up the hill to 1813 La Coronilla Drive.

During the warm-up preparation in our kitchen, while the five of us sat around, several important items were brought forward. Weeks before, J-R had been alerted that he would shortly meet the last member of a quatuor that worked with a certain Master and the clue was “Marshall” — written across a blue uniform. He had misinterpreted that this would represent someone in authority, such as a law enforcement officer. Instead, “Marshall” was the given name, in the Air Force blues. We saw again how subtle is the trap that can lead us to construe incorrectly. We were all silent a moment. I don't think Marshall realized at that time the full import of what we heard — that he, had, even then, been working for some time with John-Roger on the inner planes.

Amid much good humor and a little joshing, J-R observed that a good marriage was a possibility for Jack and Anna. I don't know whether this was a conscious idea for either of them at that time, but we can see now how it all turned out.

We shared so much more that evening, but what dimmed everything else by contrast for me, was John-Roger's response to my comment that I hoped the spaghetti meal I had prepared was not imbalanced in starch for someone as sensitive as he. Casually remarking, “We will now have a demonstration of what the pendulum can do to change the chemical action of whatever . . .” he opened his shirt collar and removed a golden chain over his head. Suspended for one flashing moment — you've probably





guessed, a golden disc with the Praying Hands.” I froze: I didn’t need the sound of trumpets! Every nerve in my body rang in chord as magnus (Webster classifies that as “three or more notes sounding in harmony”).

We parted about 2:00 a.m., all of us in warm rapport. Yet I was no further ahead in knowing what was meant for me by “a change of consciousness” around the first of the year, nor was any information advanced to foretell what our future association would be.

Time passed, and with growing urgency we were becoming more aware how many students were seeking better answers to inner perplexities than were usually available in outer consciousness. Robert and sometimes Jack had for several months, been bringing from 20 to 30 young people to bi-weekly, or tri-weekly: gatherings in my home to share experiences and information and to search for wisdom to meet some of their concerns. Now and then I reflected back to that unusual meeting in August. Why had it been predicted that I would be working closely with that young teacher. I was still puzzled.

Then in October, a most surprising opportunity developed swiftly and moved intrepidly to center stage in my affairs. Quickly, I will say that the change of consciousness foretold, represented an amazing experience a real whopper! If it had been, in June patterned in my soul chart, it was never in my conscious awareness at that time. The ensuing unfoldment of the small miracles of perfect timing had the enchanting quality of magic. Right on schedule, the first of the year, January 4, 1968, I made a winged departure from these shores in the notable company of a precious little person, Indra Devi. Many of you know her as the “First Lady of Yoga.” Six of us, three of whom I had never met until we boarded the flight, were India-bound: destination, Prasanthi Nilayam, the ‘Ashram of Sathya Sai Baba, the Shiva Avatar in South India. “Avatar” is Sanskrit for “the Lord comes down”. This is a soul so evolved, He can create life. No way is it possible for me to condense that experience into just a few sentences and that is not the purpose of this record but, again, it has a direct bearing on it. In my last personal interview, before leaving the Ashram, I ventured a plea for help. “I need a teacher for the young students coming to my home. I can point them to general information but we need someone who really knows where each one is, individually.” Baba watched me a moment, then nodded. “Your teacher is at hand; you will know.” That was all! There had been so much emphasis, so much careful instruction from Swami during our intensive two weeks with Him, on how to realize and claim the God within, I thought that was what He referred to and I was a little disappointed. We really did need a teacher — now! I had been consciously on this path just a few years, but long enough to know that the most progress I’d made was certain recognition that I wasn’t the adequate teacher. Again, the delicate trap of misinterpretation.

The week following my return home from India, I attended a prophecy class in the area of Covina. On February 2009 Jack was there, Robert was included.

My directional antenna has a spoke or two missing; consequently, I got lost and was just a breath late. The teacher who was conducting the meeting, in her gracious way, invited me to say a few words about Sai Baba when I walked in. In that sea of faces, I caught a quick wink from John-Roger Hinkins before I committed the unpardonable. I was so overflowing with a new dimension of Love and the magnificence of my experience that it was difficult to express. I made a few introductory remarks and then volunteered, “I really think He is the Christ of our time.” Well, I watched the shutters close down quickly then, and realized sadly that I had made a giant blooper, so I sat down. After the meeting, I was delighted when who but John-Roger slid into the seat beside me. “Muriel, I want to hear more about this great soul you met in India.” Philip Anthony was there that, night, too, and we met for the first time. The Santa Barbara group gathered close around us on the floor. J-R took an object that Baba had manifested to represent “Light and Joy” for me and the pendulum spun like lightning. “Do you know that this man has the Christ consciousness?”

“That’s what I said!”

“No, Love, but that’s what you should have said.” I heard Baba’s voice, then, “Your teacher is at hand; you will know.” And I did know, with surety and sudden elation that this was the One! J-R agreed, before the evening was over, to a pilot seminar; and as we planned, the others recognized, too, that this man had a special sensitivity for our needs.

On May 4, 1968, we held our first seminar in Santa Barbara in my home.

I have always thought there was a special significance in the fact that our Movement was born during Easter week in April, and the first series ended with the Christ full moon festival in June. During the first seminars, Philip and Pauli joined us, and Luba. We were surprised that others began to drive from considerable distances:

Lillimor from Camarillo, Natalie and Wanda and Joyce from Thousand Oaks, Candace Shanklin from Temple City, then Seleta and Harriett. Shortly thereafter, other seminars started in the Camarillo and Oxnard areas and then Santa Barbara was too far to come, so the great shuffle service began from here to the Mansbach’s in Thousand Oaks and for the next years there gradually grew together that nucleus of the body of the Movement that I considered my spiritual family.

Gradually, the patterns change as we grow and what is needed “for the Highest Good” comes forward. People question the name, the insignia; most of the members are never aware of the truly democratic way in which these selections were made. The group members didn’t need a name; we knew what we were doing and how we were progressing to soul travel and that level of consciousness. But in speaking to others of our activities and development, it was the “others” that seemed to need some identification. All the suggestions were listed, first for the title, then later for the symbol and each member in each of the seminars (seven at the time) had the opportunity to vote his choice. We voted for weeks, until by the pro-

cess of elimination, the chosen insignia became well known by the popular acclaim of the first few hundred members in the Movement.

Of recent importance to me was a return trip to India, in January of 1972, for a visit of almost three months with Sai Baba. This is not the quiet, sedentary, meditative Saint one usually associates with Indian heritage. Baba is a moving, vibrant, dynamic, flashing, witty, living demonstration of God-consciousness operating twenty-four hours a day. It is a very potent experience and I am still discerning what I witnessed. Of one thing I am certain: the teachings of inner awareness, even some of the examples, in Baba’s discourses were so familiar that I found myself, many times, agreeing “Yes, Yes!” with great inner elation, as I listened, grateful that I understood, as these are the wisdoms I have

been so privileged to hear at the feet of our young Master, advancing to five years now. I came to the conclusion that great teachers, great Masters, really do draw on the Great Common Consciousness in Universal Truths.

There was opportunity to converse with Baba about the MSIA this time, and about John-Roger, of whom he said, “Oh, Yes! I know him well.” He read the October and November issues of “On the Light Side” with pleasure, even sang a little from them as he read. In my personal interview, Bhagavan acknowledged that this Movement “would move through the world.” Concerning John-Roger, he spread his fingers in the gesture of big chest, saying, “Much Light, much Light”, then arcing his hand way over his head, arm fully extended, Baba repeated, “Great Soul, Great Light.” His concluding sentence, “It is for people like you, who do the work of the world, that this Avatar has come again.”

I see similarities in theory and techniques of discipline and I have witnessed the consequent purity and healing resulting. There is no alternative; we must all accept the cleansing discipline that quiets and re-centers the ego in perfect balance so we can attain the at-one-ment with the Inner Master. The most unique characteristic of association with John-Roger is his ability to see into us, and accept us anyway. Only the aspect of divinity can say, “You don’t have to change for me. I love you just the way you are.” This is the first seed of the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness; this is what melts the iceberg of separateness and then the flow really begins, when we ourselves say, “I want to change; show me how, guide me to the real Spirit.”

I ascribe wholeheartedly to the principles and philosophy of the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness and I shall finish my life in eternal thankfulness that I have been led to the Mystical Traveler. Someplace along the way, I must have done something very right to be so privileged to serve Him.

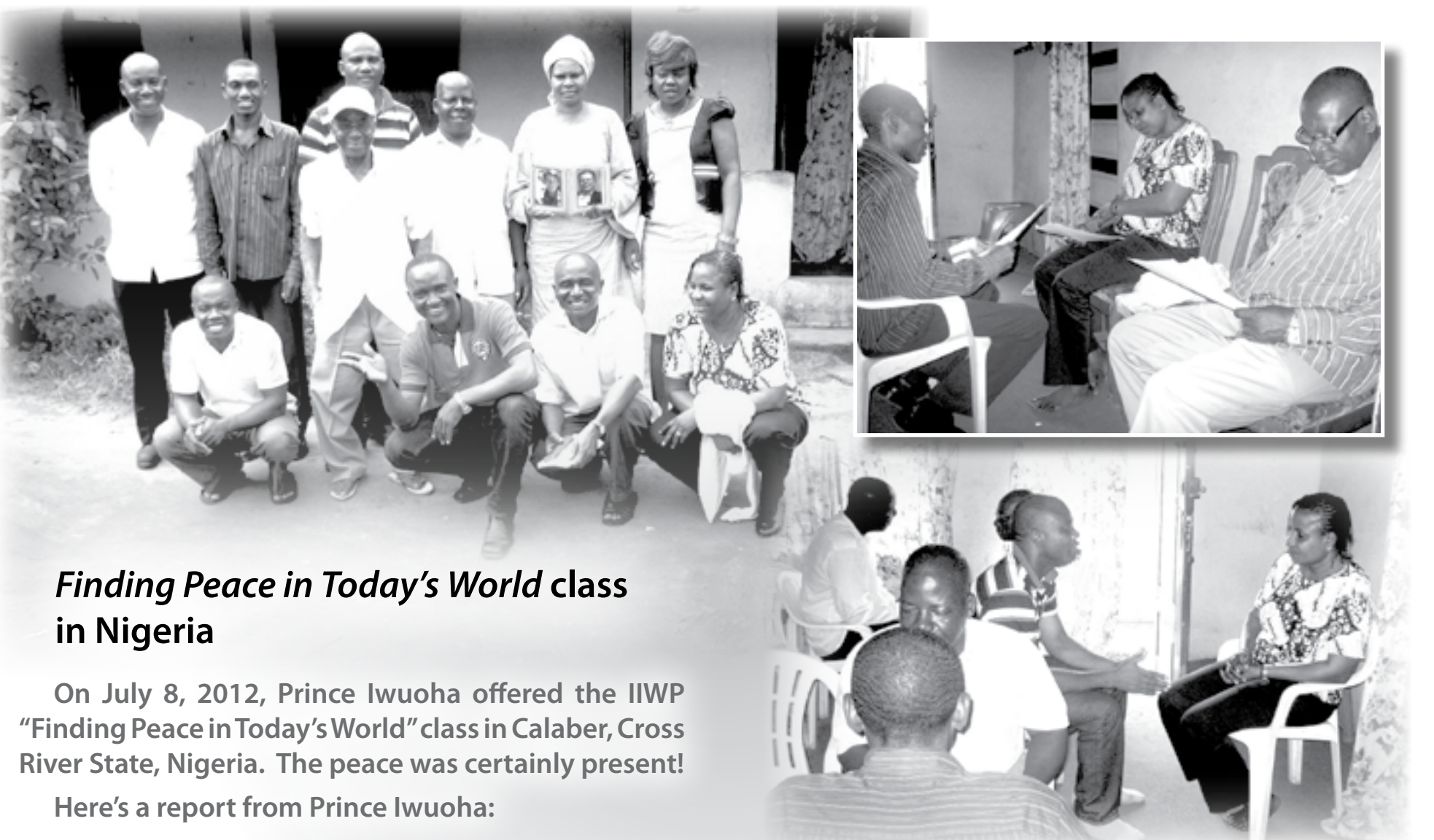

# Aida Ligeti

## – Cheerleader for the Traveler

...I was puzzled by this because discourse subscribers are not supposed to share material directly from discourses. I wrote to J-R about Aida sharing her discourses in this manner, and some of the things she shared openly with others, and J-R's response to me was something like, she can do what she says and she can handle it. That got my attention.

Aida was originally from Hungary, where she was married and had two children, and she was also a professional opera singer. During the Hungarian revolution in the 1950's both her children were killed, and later she was saved from the brink of death by a butcher who pulled her into his shop just before soldiers killed everyone who was lined up outside.

Aida also had a twin sister who remained in Hungary, while Aida and her husband wound up fleeing in the middle of the night. They eventually made their way to Australia, where they opened up a spice food company called Hoyt Food industries in Moorabbin, Victoria in 1960. You can still buy the spices from them today. Aida was a gourmet cook and had exceptional culinary skills and she really enjoyed sharing her loving through food.

To my knowledge she rarely if ever sang after leaving her home country. However I was blessed when she played a recording of her singing for me. I recall being moved to tears by the melodic quality and the loving in her voice. Even now as I recall the experience, I am deeply touched by her beauty.

Though I don't know any of the details, Aida did leave her husband and moved to Sydney. By the time I met Aida in 1979, she was working in a dress shop in near

Potts Point (Sydney) and she was very devoted to the Traveler.

In the early days of MSIA and Insight Australia, J-R and the staff would visit for two to four weeks once or twice a year to facilitate various trainings. Aida loved to cook for J-R and as soon as she knew he was coming, she would ask the Devas in her garden to bloom for him, and no matter what time of year it was, there were flowers in bloom when he arrived.

The movement has had its share of wonderful characters and Aida is certainly one of them. Each of them seems endowed with special gifts and talents, and Aida was no exception.

One day while visiting Aida in Kings Cross (Sydney), at the dress shop where she worked, I noticed she was busy copying something from her discourse and when she was done, she handed the paper to a woman who later became a minister in MSIA. I soon found out that Aida had a large following and this was not an uncommon thing for her to do. The words clearly touched the other person and they, as well as many others, became MSIA ministers.

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in this manner, and some of the things she shared openly with others, and J-R's response to me was something like, she can do what she says and she can handle it. That got my attention.

Aida brought many people into MSIA via Insight and many were touched by her loving. She had a huge heart and shared openly. When her estranged husband got sick, Aida moved to Melbourne and along with his long-time mistress, they cared for her husband until he passed. Not only did Aida befriend his mistress, she also shared some of her inheritance with her.

Aida stayed in a remote mountain area for just under 3 years, but country living did not meet the needs of such a loving, gregarious person. Aida needed to be amongst people, so she bought an elegant apartment in a retirement village in Southport on the Gold Coast and this gave her the lifestyle she so much needed.

I invite you to read about her life and the effect she had on so many and the wonderful stories related by the Australian ministerial community. And may you be touched by the loving of this precious Aussie MSIA elder.

I started out in MSIA in December 1987 and one of the people who had the biggest influence on me in my spiritual life, especially for those first two years, was Aida—the most colorful and beautiful lady with sparkling sense of humor, deep love of God and delightful personality, who truly adored J-R as much as anyone I've met.

Her small townhouse was always full of flowers from her small but abundant garden, often placed into teeny tiny vases and cups lining the shelves and top of her TV. The place was alive with devic energy. The rest of the lounge room was packed with soft toys, bears puppies and etc., including a black cat which rested on the arm of my usual Friday-night-seminar chair.

Aida was always encouraging, always funny, openly shared her stories and experiences both in MSIA and about her earlier life, especially the times during the invasion of Hungary, and her escape in Austria. How she was shot (!) and lost her

two babies - and how J-R soothed and healed a lot of her pain over this.

Yet in spite of all she'd been through, and nursing a sick husband for many years, she was the most delightful, positive, funny, original person. She dressed with patterned colorful clothes, and bought many of her outfits from a well known designer in Sydney—and they even would make special long coats in purples for her!

When the yearly MSIA tour time came around Aida was one of the most fun people to watch, especially when relating to J-R. As tour time would approach she would get so excited she'd leave her glasses in the fridge and do other spacey things that made us laugh when she shared about them. I recall once she was applying her lipstick sitting in the front row when J-R had already taken the stage. He looked at her with much love and amusement saying, "When you're ready, Aida," and everyone laughed so much. She was always a JOY.

from Judith:

Aida said that when Hungary was invaded, her father (who was connected in some way with a large bank) told her if she was in danger, to take her two little children, about five and three years of age, into the basement of the bank for safety. Aida had to do that, and apparently the bank was then bombed or shelled, and large beams or masonry fell into the basement and crushed her two children to death. Aida was with her dead children for some time before she was able to be rescued.

Another story she told me was that an armed robber entered her shop in Sydney, demanding money and threatening her life if she didn't pay up. Aida looked him in the eyes, and said "God bless you, I love you," and the thief immediately said "I will not hurt you." I'm not sure if he took the money!

Jan Coombs and I, and many others, went to lots of seminars in Aida's Manly apartment. We of-

No matter what any of us seminar participants were going through we always had time to talk it out in sharing time, as much as we wanted, with heaps of encouragement and love. She had great advice and stories. As if her seminars weren't great enough, there was the "Aida special" dessert to look forward to as well. It was a sort of cake, fruit and custard sweet, creamy, amazing yummy thing!

One day I arrived for her seminar soaking wet after a bad storm. She got me into one of her dressing gowns and dried all my clothes while the seminar was on. Just one more of many many memories of those priceless days.

She'd often tell us she was the 'cheerleader of the Traveler' and I thought it a perfect description in every way. Aida was priceless and IS priceless and is sparking up the heavens with the angels and the Traveler she so loves.

ten had up to fifteen packed into her living room, and she always provided marvelous suppers.

She was a simply amazing woman — I have never met anyone like her — flamboyant, wonderfully generous, positive, picturesque, courageous, deeply spiritual and with no bitterness about the incredible hardships and losses she had experienced. God bless you dear Aida.

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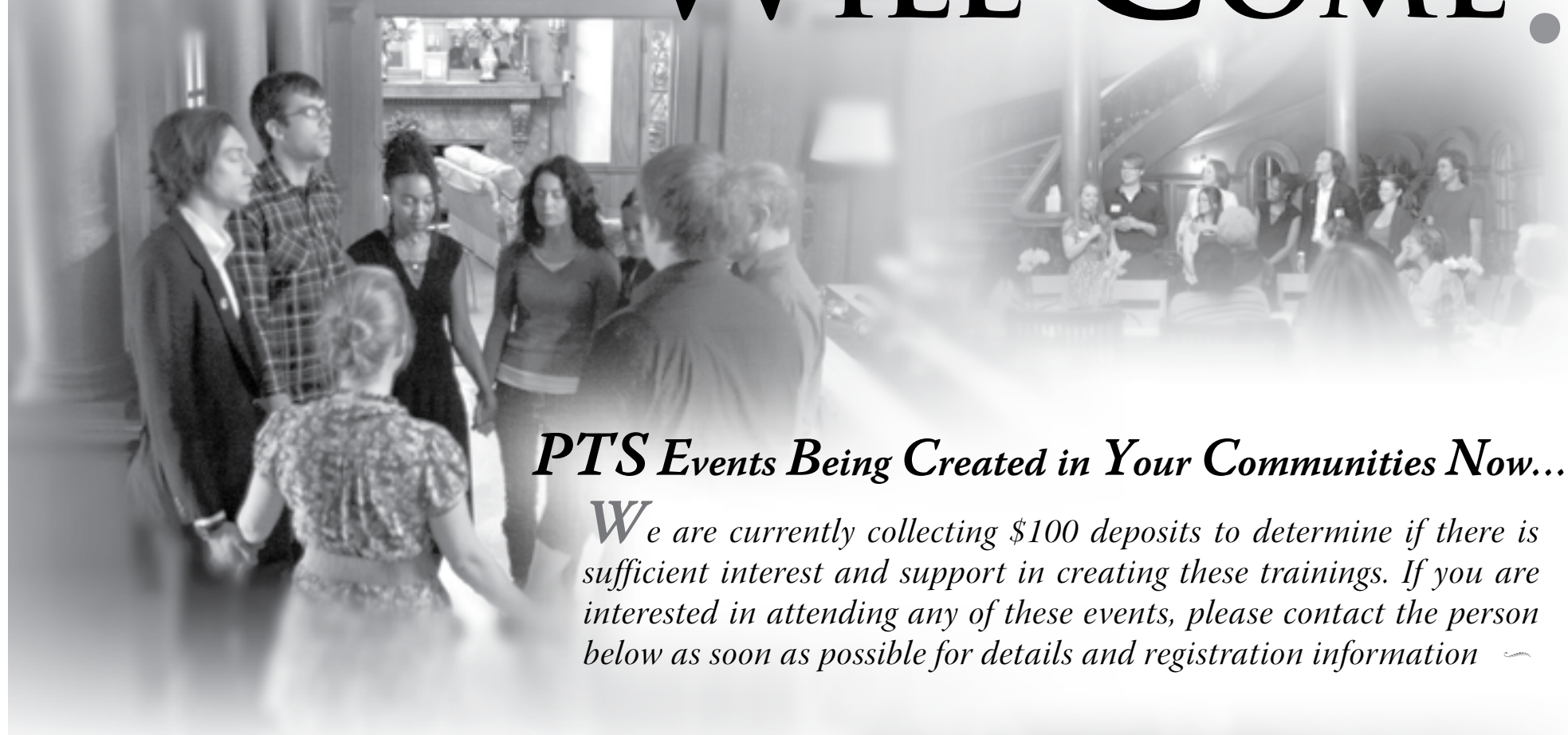



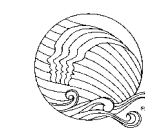

## INITIATION

If you are just starting the Soul Awareness Discourses, Discourse #1 explains initiation into the Sound Current. You may choose to study the Discourses with the intention to be initiated on this path, or to simply read them as information. If you do choose to study toward initiation, the Traveler works with you more closely, and you may notice a greater spiritual awareness in your own consciousness as this work goes on.

If you are studying toward initiation, you need to write and mail a letter to the Traveler that this is your intention. If you have written and mailed your intention to the Traveler, you can apply for initiation when you have completed Discourse 24.

## THE MSIA MINISTRY

The MSIA ministry is for initiates of the Traveler who are called inwardly to serve the spirit of their hearts.

Service may be in any form, from volunteering for the Church to assisting people in need or organizations that serve those people, and anything in between. The only requirement is that the ministry is active and done regularly.

MSIA ministers may perform services, like marriages, that clergy of other denominations are authorized to do as long as they comply with the laws of the locality in which they serve.

## WRITING TO J-R & JOHN

Sometimes people reading Discourses, especially those studying toward initiation, want to write to John Morton or John-Roger. Writing often helps you let go of a troubling situation and open more to the Traveler's assistance inwardly.

As soon as you write to John Morton or John-Roger, they get the message on the spiritual levels, and they do what Spirit allows. Then, to let go of the situation in your consciousness, you burn or mail your letter. Whether you burn or mail what you wrote, you may find that you get your answers on the inner levels, sometimes very quickly. You may also experience greater calm, clarity, or peace, which can help you go through whatever challenges you face.

We suggest that you place the situation in the Light, ask for clarification during s.e.s, dreams, etc., and then look for the answers within you. Often reading a Discourse or listening to an MSIA tape (either at home or at a seminar) will provide keys to assist you in handling your situation. You can also refer to any of the numerous books by J-R and John to find information that relates to what you are dealing with. These two have shared so much with us over the years, and we encourage you to send your letters via e-mail, using these addresses:

This does not imply that your concern is not important or that you are being ignored. There simply may be no need for a physical reply, or there may be no answer available to you at the time you write.

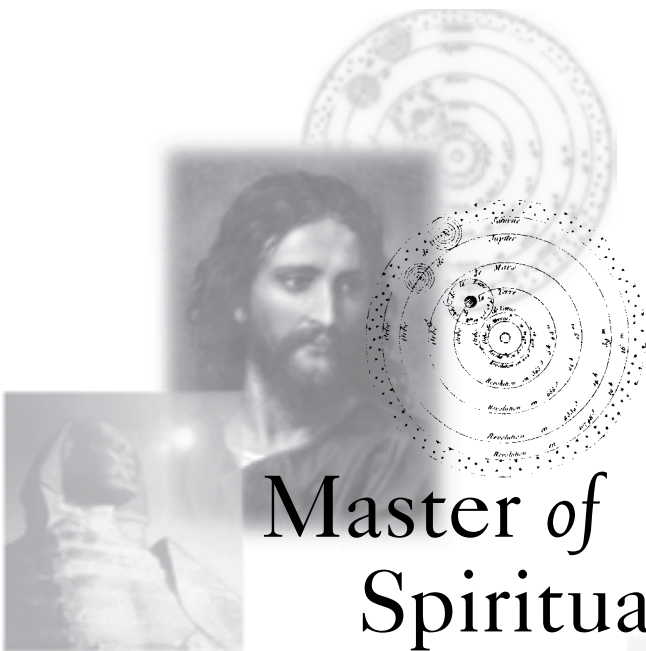

## Master of Spiritual Science

### The Master's Program

#### *Year One: Creating Through Grace*

During year one, Creating Through Grace, students gain greater awareness of how they live their lives—physically, emotionally, and mentally—and of how they can bring these levels into greater alignment and cooperation with their spiritual intention.
