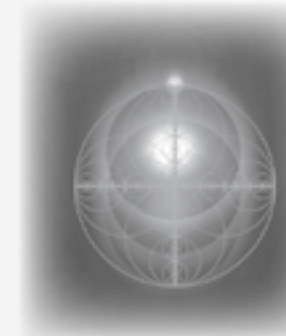

INNER VISION & OUTER SIGHT

I haven't found anything yet, even in the most disastrous, terrible situation, that in it I couldn't find out how to switch that to an advantage. Did I have to go way out? Oh, yes! But, lo and behold, that is the way the situation turned out! When I thought it was too far out to even consider the idea, that was the idea that turned everything around.



INNER VISION & OUTER SIGHT

Have you found out that a lot of your vision difficulties are emotionally based inside of you? When you start to confront the difficulties, do you find the emotions come churning up like steamrollers? That's the good news and the bad news. The good news is that it is out. The bad news may be, "Guess who put it there?" And if you put it there once, guess how easy it will be to do it again. It's so easy. When you say "I should" or "I can't" or "I won't" or somehow label anything against yourself, your body starts responding internally to produce those results for you.

If you can just see what you are really looking at and not be responsible for what you think you should see, there's a good chance that everything around you will improve.

There is always a hitch that seems to make that statement not true. And it's this: why can't I say, "I'm a millionaire," and have my consciousness start responding so that I'd become a millionaire. Because you have to take those positive actions that produce the millions.

The negativity works differently. This planet is referred to as the negative planet only because there is another type of higher consciousness that is referred to as heaven. So the heaven and hell syndrome can be present right here based on your attitude. The physical body is negative; the imagination is negative; the emotions are negative; the mind is negative and the unconscious is negative. The soul is positive. So to counterbalance one negative, you have to do five positives. In fact, you need to do five positive expressions on each of the five levels and then you have created one positive result against the negative. If you do just one positive thought that is insufficient. You have to do 24 more positives to create a movement toward change. If you get to 24 (out of 25) and say "This isn't working", you have to start over at 1.

Now, what if it isn't working? Instead, you might want to say "I haven't noticed the change." The word change is put into your consciousness. By saying it this way you are reinforcing the change. The last couple of words you put out of your mouth go back and record inside of you.

If you say to a little kid, when he picks up a precious dish, "Don't drop that!" the dish almost invariably drops to the floor. What could you say? How about "Hold it tight." This many sound silly and ridiculous, but the words you speak start lining up the response. Of course there may be a prior condition to the moment of holding it tight. When the child shows up, you can put the dish where the child can't get to it. That is also a posi-

tive direction. Then he can play freely. And you can be free, instead of watching him all the time to make sure that he does what is necessary and proper. When you can go to the prior condition of your event, you'll usually find the cause and the cure.

During the *EYECLASSES* training you dealt with memory patterns. This can provide information of the conditions prior to the event of limiting your vision and using glasses. These conditions may be patterns of emotional trauma—which is the case 9 times out of 10. And a lot of these patterns go way back. Medical professionals, ophthalmologists and eye doctors, are finding out that physiological or anatomical discrepancies are controllable and can be changed by the frequency of the thinking and the content of the feeling. What that is really saying is "mind over matter." If you watch the patterns of your thoughts and emotions, you can start changing.

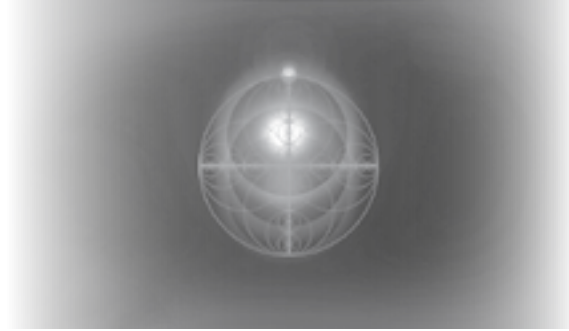
If someone is talking to you, it's nice to say, "I see, I see ..." It will reaffirm clear seeing. It doesn't mean you understand it; all it is saying is that you are perceptive to what is going on. Affirming the seeing starts change. It will begin to awaken what has been asleep, what has been retired. The affirmation starts to wake you up; it shakes you, focuses you upon it, and you'll start dropping back into it. If that part of you that is perceptive has been asleep, you'll start to feel sleepy. That just follows, like the sun and the evening, then the sun, then the evening. Pretty soon you can't tell if the sun came up first or went down first before it came up. And it doesn't make any difference because if you want to see at night, you use a flashlight. In the daylight, you use the sun. You can see in either light or dark if you adapt by your attitude. The time you say "I can't" or "I won't" or anything like that, you run your own creativity against yourself, and what you get is what you deserve because you're the one who made it.

We have some statements or guidelines:

1. Use everything to your advantage.
2. Take care of yourself so you can take care of others.
3. Don't hurt yourself and don't hurt others.

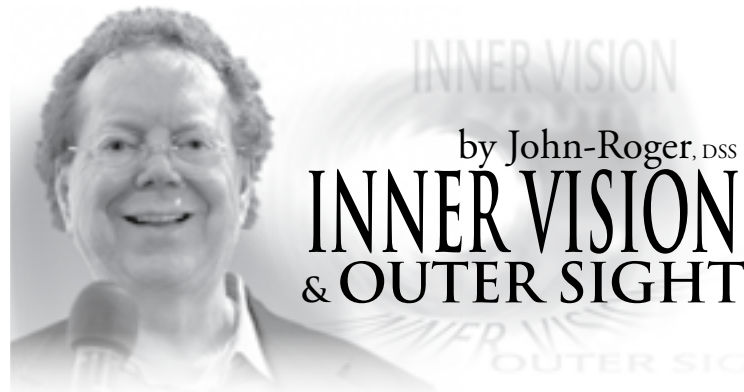
The big key is to use everything to your advantage. If you do that wherever you go, then that will be your set—mentally, emotionally, physiologically. You might say, "Does using a situation to my advantage mean I take away from you?" No, that's why we add the statement, Don't hurt yourself and don't hurt others. It sets you up to be good for yourself and others whether you want to be or not. The nice thing about that is if somebody comes knocking on your door, you don't have to run and hide. You open the door and say, "Come in," because you are free and open in your consciousness. The result is that you are not doing anything against yourself or anybody else, so whoever wants to look, can look. There may be some who will try to make you wrong. If you have done something that isn't to your advantage, correct it and move it to your

She didn't wear glasses, either. That was twenty-some years ago and I followed the family. None of them wear glasses—he doesn't, she doesn't, the kids don't. And what a nice family they are to be around. They're just real people who have their ups and their downs. When they are up, that's good, when they are down, it's a rough time for them, and they are working to get up. Most people go down and focus on the down so long that when

they go up, they still are looking down. What you have to do is to continue to change your focus to whatever is present, and to just see it as it is, not as you think it should be. And the interesting thing is that beauty is in the eyes of the beholder. So whatever you want to see, you can just make it come out that way. You have to know that.

When you become actively involved in the process of awakening to what is so in you life, you can become transformed. You can drop a lot of years off your face and appear so much younger and more vibrantly alive.

Whether I am with you or away from you has nothing to do with you. But if I am with you and then I leave you, you may think it's against you. In reality, it's just that I have other things I have to do. You could take my actions and twist them against you. You could say, "You don't love me, you're against me." And who would want to see that? Nobody. So you shut down your field of vision so you don't have to see. Who wants to see being perceived as a fool or something like that? Nobody. So you close down so you don't see it. First of all, you close down inside and get rigid and start having "no feelings." Then you walk around not living your life in terms of the excitement that's available to you as a person. When you reverse the patterns and decide to see, those energy fields that been asleep start coming alive. They may have been loaded up with all sorts of negativity that now must be released. As they surface, they are saying, "You did this."

I would suspect that if you are really going to keep developing to see in the most clear way possible, you may still have to deal with issues, not necessarily understanding issues, just energy release issues that will come up. They may come flooding up so forcefully, you'll feel like you are drowning or choking. You may experience feelings of fear, anxiety or hatred. And interspersed with those will be calm and loving and joy, but those positive feelings may not be as present at first as some of the other stuff. The good news about that is, guess where all the negativity is going? Away from you. Hopefully, you're just saying, "Out!" and let it go.

As you are observing your energy patterns, you may want to pay attention to your body language. If you find yourself sitting in what we call a closed body position, with arms crossed over your chest, you might want to check out why you are doing that. Are you shutting off energy and blocking yourself from seeing and experiencing? Or are you comforting yourself and not really blocking off all that much energy? When we speak of energy that flows through the body, just to cross your arms over your chest can be very comfortable—because you

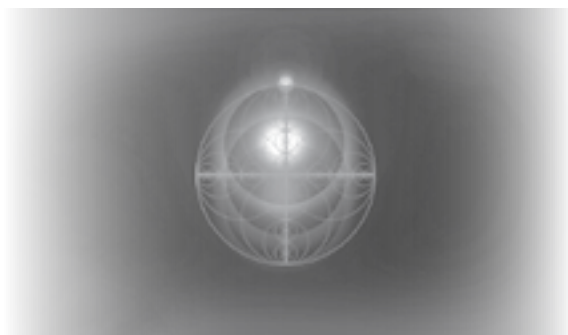
If you can't see now, your penchant for honesty says, "Oh, I have to be honest, I can't see now, I can't." You could say, "I'm going to claim that I can see. I'm going to claim, as a real step of faith and belief, that I am going to see. That's going to be the carrot in front of me—I can see."

Whatever your limitations and inhibitions are, look at them very closely, because, in truth, who you are is a conscious, spiritual, loving person. You don't have any limitations. That isn't a license to hurt anybody. You have no limitations. And if you're not going to hurt yourself, you can't hurt somebody else, for the simple reason that we are all the same person. We've all breathed the same air and I don't know how many times. But if we are made up of that air and those molecules then we've got each other mixed together very much. Moses breathed the air we breathe. So did Jesus and Buddha and all the other saints and sages from every religion and creed. We have part of their essence working within us, too. The bad news is that we may also have too much of our own negativity working.

There is an old statement that I used to hear: love is blind. I saw one of my friends getting married and he sure seemed blind. ("Nobody would marry her!") He was marrying her and he had good vision! So what was he seeing? He was seeing what was behind what was apparently there. He was seeing a fantastic mother, a fantastic wife, a fantastic partner. They went away, came back about 8 months later, and she was pregnant. She was absolutely transformed. Here she was, really big with baby, and she had put on extra weight. By every measurement possible she didn't measure up to anything. And she was absolutely gorgeous. And I caught what he saw. One of my friends looked at me and said, "What is it?" I said, "Well, look at her." He sat back and just watched her, then leaned over and said, "There is something that is real attractive about her." He started giving a little space. The more he looked, the more he saw her inner beauty.

She had the baby, and together they looked like a picture of the Madonna and a Christ child. it was a totally amazing thing that she was transforming our stupidity right in front of us by doing nothing except being who she was and doing what she did.

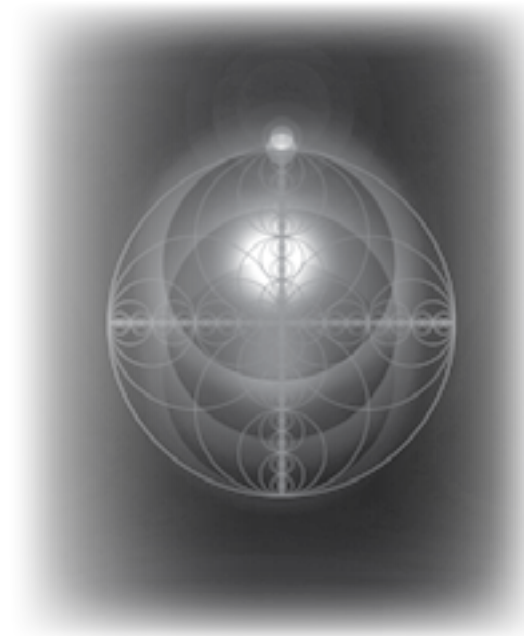


are comforting yourself. Then you have to ask yourself the question, "What am I doing inside of me right now that needs comforting?" Maybe it's really simple. Maybe the air conditioning is on an it's cold in the room. That's physiological, that makes sense. That's comforting you.

Maybe it's emotional: "I really feel a lot of disturbance to my stomach and chest because of some work we've been doing and I'm just comforting myself because it feels like I've been hurt or something." If that's so, then uncross your hands. You don't want to comfort that part of you because it's working against the great you. So don't comfort it. By comforting it, you are just going to keep it there and let it quiet down and keep it comfortable. It will quiet down and then you will feel okay. But guess what? You didn't deal with it. If there is really a fundamentally good reason for sitting with arms crossed, that is not going to do anything bad to you. I just want you to understand that. Make sure your motives inside and the intention behind crossing your hands are clear.

One key in everything you do should be to get you more freedom inside of yourself, not necessarily out in the world, but inside of yourself. It is inside that you really live. The inner environment is almost 98% of your beingness.

You spend more time rehearsing and talking and going over your problems than it might take to solve them. Do yourself a favor and don't rehearse your problems. It doesn't serve you to go over them and over them and over them. Once is enough. The bad thing about rehearsing is that whoever you talk to, you talk about your problems. You rehearse your act in front of them. I suppose the best thing to do is to just let your problem go and keep com-



ing back to the present. You may make mistakes doing that because it is new to you. I understand your wanting to do old stuff because you do it really well. Even talking about a negative problem you can come off looking good because you've got it down. When you go for a new expression, you are going to stumble and falter, and then you've got to deal with maybe looking bad. All you have to do to deal with that is just tell somebody, "Yes, I stumbled and fell." And all you're saying to them is, "I'm smarter now than I was when I stumbled and fell because I recognized it and I am correcting it." That is a real statement of advancement, and you can use it all the time.

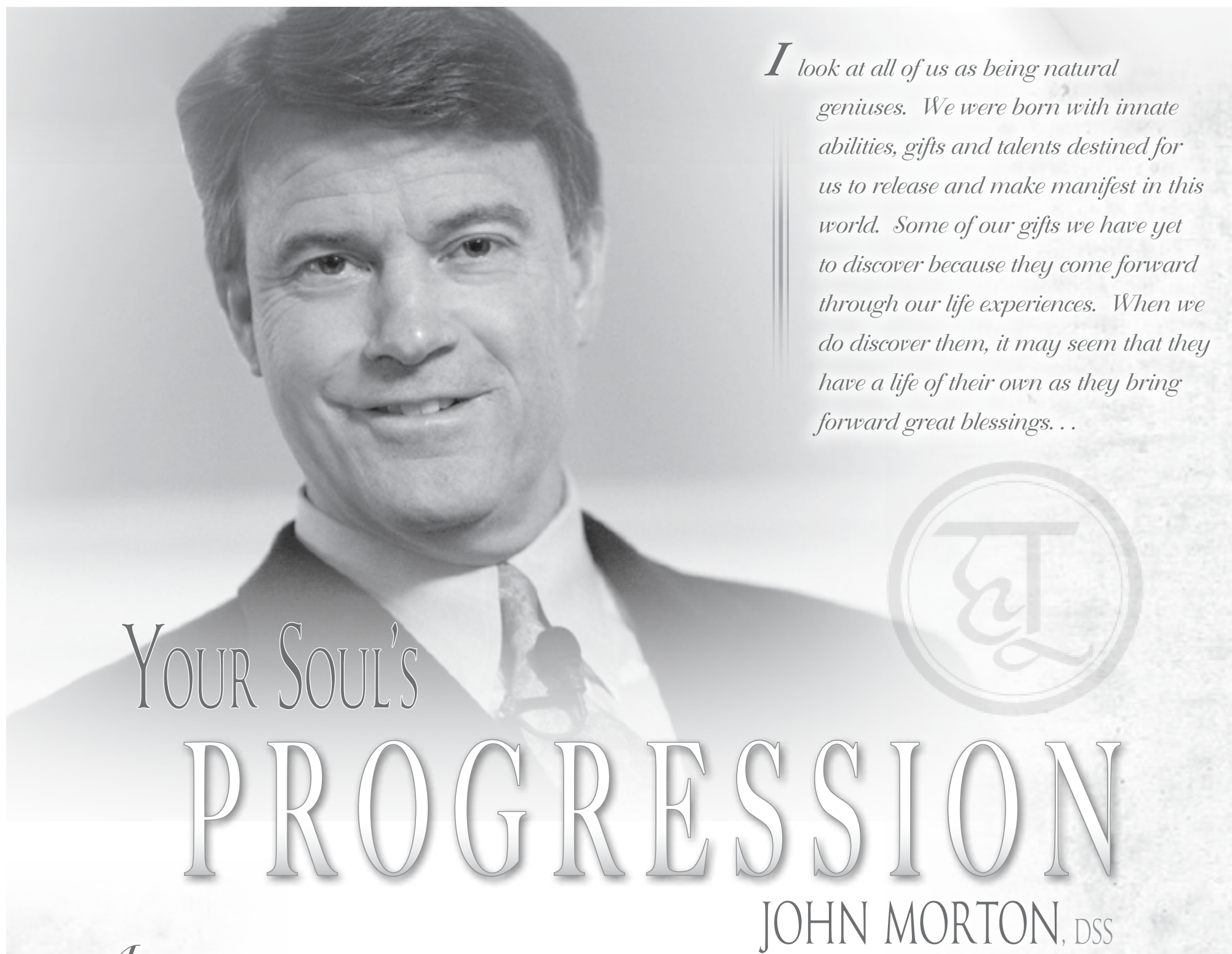

I consider myself blessed to be one of those who discovered my life purpose, and I've been trying to keep up with it ever since. It has led me to do all kinds of things that are fulfilling and nurturing as well as confounding and challenging. If you think that discovering your life purpose takes the difficulties and challenges away, that's certainly not how it has been in my case. If anything, the challenges may intensify. However, I look at what we're doing as it comes in line directly with one of the ground rules that John-Roger has identified, "Use everything for your upliftment, learning and growth."

Consider everything really means *everything*. There's no exception in using everything. Every moment of every day, every circumstance, interaction, feeling and thought can be used for our upliftment. So use them all

to gain. When we're engaged in that way, amazing things happen. Our life is illuminated in the brilliance of who we are.

It may not always feel uplifting in each moment, so I don't want to mislead you that it's always easy. I'm not always clear in what I'm doing. I just find that when I give myself a chance to be aware, then I realize I have a choice to love every experience as of God and for the greater good coming forward. I can try to deny it. I can run from it. I can make excuses. I can attempt to avoid it. I can make any number of choices, but by far the one that always works is to embrace each experience in the perfection of God's will. The best choice is to use everything for what it brings up as higher awareness, as an intention towards manifestation of the greater good.

At times, we may run into our fears, doubts, and self-judg-

With increased awareness of the goodness always present, you can realize there are no destinations. There's no place to go. There's nothing we have to do. Yet, we are here. So we might as well make ourselves useful in whatever way that may become.

ments. We may feel resistant and find ourselves holding back. We may then encounter others who can become our teachers, perhaps in the forms of those who test us about whether we're really committed and certain enough about what we're doing to continue. For those of us who do find the way to be true to what that intention is by loving it all, great things can happen. We find our gifts and our value in life. It is fulfilling to us, and we find fulfillment from within rather than being dependent on the results in the world. If you're expecting that when you find your life purpose the world will love you and agree with you, I haven't found that to be the case. Instead, I have found that having this connection inside, this awareness of who we are as a soul and as one with God is the key to upliftment. Souls who incarnate in this world do so in the perfection of God's will. I know of no exception to that. At birth, there's an embodiment of the consciousness of the Soul intact. We come into this world a living, breathing being with the individualized God aspect, that element of the divine that is necessary to be a human life and fulfill the human existence. We have all of what is necessary for the Soul to fulfill itself so that the negativity and the experience of the worlds of illusion eventually complete and return back to the nothingness from which they came.



My point of view is we could use a lot more peace and quiet in this world. We could use a lot more joy and happiness. What that allows for is, "Don't worry." Don't be concerned about others in a way where you delay, become bothered or depressed, or you're in some way impeding your own progress. Move back on track to your peace and joy which is always present within.



The material existence, no matter how dark, disturbing, or negative, serves the Soul, and brings experiences that enlighten, illuminate and liberate the Soul from the necessity of this existence. What is the necessity of this existence? To enlighten and fulfill the realization of the Soul. Why does the Soul come in here for that? Is there something lacking about the Soul? The Soul comes in for a reflective experience of itself. The Soul is extremely patient and willing to endure eternally until whatever is needed to be completed for the highest good is finished. One of the primary messages in this movement of spiritual inner awareness is endure and to endure until the end. What end is that? When God verifies, when God confirms. How would we know that? God does it. So give it to God. God determines that moment.

The human existence allows for repetition. It allows for re-embodiment. From a human perspective we can look at that as something dysfunctional. You might ask, "What's the matter with those people? Why don't they just get it in a lifetime and be done with it? Why do they have to keep repeating?"

My recommendation, and obviously it's been here in the wisdom pool that's with us in this world, is don't judge. Just consider that there's perfection in all that takes place. So whatever people do, there's a perfection. It fits in God's grand plan. If you look upon it and from where you are in your consciousness realize, "That's not for me. I don't see that as in line with what my life is here to realize and experience," that's your wit. And if it isn't your wit, you'll soon find out.

We're all designed to come into a realization of who we are, and this world is designed to re-

fect it to us as much as we can handle. If we resist, if we reject, that just emphasizes endurance. Maybe it will be a little longer; maybe it will be a little later. Why? Because you may not be choosing what's available to you now. You will choose eventually, so there's no rush. There's no urgency or "have to." That sort of thinking can create a kind of consciousness that shows up in greed, avarice and lust and trying to differentiate between experiences that are "better" and "worse." Don't indulge in any negative process as that does not serve your learning and growth. When we wake up to the present opportunity, we naturally realize to move on to what does serve learning and growth and what works for us without judgment of our experiences.

With increased awareness of the goodness always present, you can realize there are no destinations. There's no place to go. There's nothing we have to do. Yet, we are here. So we might as well make ourselves useful in whatever way that may become. Maybe the reality is this world could use a little more quiet. We can find the quiet that's within us and offer that up. If someone judges us or comes against us because we're too quiet or they don't like our quiet ways, we can just find some more quiet until the Lord moves us to do something better.

My point of view is we could use a lot more peace and quiet in this world. We could use a lot more joy and happiness. What that allows for is, "Don't worry." Don't be concerned about others in a way where you delay, become bothered or depressed, or you're in some way impeding your own progress. Move back on track to your peace and joy which is always present within.

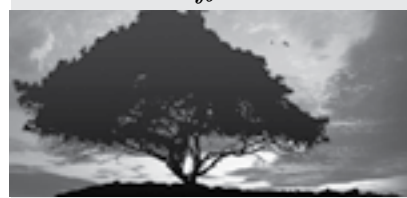

HEARTFELT & HEARTREACH

Taking Care of Each Other

Nearly three years ago, the Heartfelt Foundation celebrated its 30th anniversary with a gala event and was honored at MSIA's 2009 Conference of Heartfelt Service. The New Day Herald recently caught up with tireless Executive Director Patti Rayner to find out what's been happening and what's in store for this wonderful organization.

THE HEARTFELT FOUNDATION

Since 1979, Heartfelt has made a tremendous impact in the Los Angeles community by supporting disadvantaged families, children, seniors, the homeless and other underserved populations in various ways. Besides working directly with families and individuals in crisis, the Heartfelt Foundation collaborates with a number of social agencies and other non-profits city-wide to help meet their specific needs.

According to a 2009 NDH article, thanks to Heartfelt, "...more than 50,000 individuals have helped nourish and nurture nearly half a million men, women, children, families and seniors in need." Heartfelt has been twice nominated for the President's National Service Award and has received the Outstanding Volunteer Support Group award from the County of Los Angeles, along with countless plaques, awards and honors from around the U.S.

At its height, Heartfelt sponsored monthly service projects in LA, involving thousands of recipients and many hundreds of volunteers drawn from within and outside of MSIA, in addition to projects organized in many other communities across the U.S. and around the globe. Heartfelt LA's annual Holiday Party—providing food, entertainment, donated toys and gifts and a visit from Santa Claus—is its traditional flagship event, occurring every December since the first year. (See the Heartfelt sidebar for an amazing recap of the latest Christmas project.)

While Heartfelt still plays a vital role in serving the local community, the organization has taken a short break from sponsoring other volunteer-driven service projects.

"In recent years, our focus has shifted inward, to establish several HeartReach programs that serve the MSIA family of ministers, initiates and Discourse subscribers," explains Patti. "However, now that we have a working system in place, and volunteer Boards to sustain it, it is my heart-desire and intention to re-energize the Heartfelt Foundation's outreach activities to the poorest of the poor in this country, and touch them with the Traveler's energy and loving.

We have many hundreds of terrific donors and

volunteers eager to be of service to the community. Heartfelt has a responsibility toward them as well."

Patti says her "ears are always open" for opportunities where Heartfelt can serve those with the greatest need.

"At any given time, we have 3,000-5,000 kids on tap needing food or other resources. We served around 1,500 people in the Westchester area for our Holiday Service Project, and recently had the chance to support 50 single mothers in the military who returned home from serving in Iraq. And there are constantly families coming to us directly or being referred by other agencies with overflowing client bases.

"When Heartfelt first started, John-Roger told me, 'Patti...if they come to us...we help them.'"

And that's exactly what Heartfelt has done for 32 years and counting.

HEARTREACH CARING FOR OUR OWN

HeartReach is a program under Heartfelt that was created in 1996 as a way to support and take care of our spiritual family members in crisis, originally inspired by a request for assistance from a much-loved MSIA minister with AIDS who had no resources or support available to him.

Says Patti, "This program is the embodiment of the consciousness of John-Roger to take care of our own in this church, all the way from childhood through illness, the aging process and death. Whatever serious challenge you are dealing with, support is here to help you through it...this always means spiritual support, and often it can mean short-term, temporary material support as well. It is so important in our Church that we know and experience that we are never alone, and that we are our brother and sister's keeper and will be there for one another."

Under the MSIA Board, but with its own independent HeartReach working Board and worldwide volunteer network, HeartReach has assisted many MSIA members experiencing family emergencies, medical issues and other critical challenging situations. Through local representatives in dozens of lo-

cations, a "Guardian Angel" can quickly pull together and coordinate a team of "Ministering Angels" to help stabilize the situation of ill and dying people with doctor's visits, medicines, grocery shopping, prayer communion, occasional short-term expenses, companionship and holding the Light.

HeartReach's newest programs—ElderReach, Circle of Light and Union of Prayer Communion—are designed to meet specific areas of need throughout the cycle of life. Described in more details below, each of these pilot programs is flourishing after being anchored in the Los Angeles area, and they are now poised to expand nationally.

UNION OF PRAYER COMMUNION

"Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him... and the prayer of faith will save the sick and the Lord will raise him up." – James 5:14-15

The Union of Prayer Communion provides an organized way to share the gift of prayer communion with each other, family and friends. While only ordained MSIA ministers can give prayer communion, anyone is welcome to receive the blessings. Regular monthly gatherings in Los Angeles's pilot program have been extremely successful, and the program has started to branch out to other communities.

"It seems like more and more people outside of MSIA are somehow finding out about this beautiful way to receive the Light of Spirit," says Patti. "We've had people just show up, as well as many of the assistants from the various classes who are volunteering in the building during that hour and want to partake of the Grace that is available."

ELDERREACH

"As the beloved forerunners of our church age and become homebound, they often experience isolation and loneliness," says Patti. "ElderReach was formed to put a stronger structure in place for the MSIA population as it ages. After all, these are the Ones filled with wisdom who prepared the way for

ANOTHER HEARTFELT "LOAVES & FISHES" TALE

When it comes to Heartfelt service projects, miracles of plenty seem to be a regular occurrence. Here is the latest account from Patti Rayner, as communicated in an email to the Travelers and Presidency following the 2011 Holiday Service Project:

The Heartfelt Christmas Service Project on Saturday, December 17, was an amazing success and I thank you for your Light and grace. We served 1,000 or more children and their families that day, at our new location in Westchester—the Elks Lodge.

There was Santa, toys, food, games, activities, ponies, petting zoo, goodies, entertainment and an abundance of joy, loving and fun. Our 120 volunteers served selflessly and gave their hearts to the children. We had such an overwhelming gift of toys this year, especially with USM students contributing more than 800 teddy bears and stuffed animals, that we were able to give every child two toys! But the most amazing miracle occurred after the project.

When we unloaded the toys at the building after the project, everyone looked in awe at one another because there appeared to be the same number of bags that we had loaded up the day before! In fact there were so many toys back from the project that on Sunday I made calls to agencies and single families, and determined there was a desperate need for toys.

So yesterday, from 11 am to 10 pm, droves of agencies and single families came to the building and left with truckloads (literally) of toys for their Christmas parties and those they served. One group called at the last minute as Toys for Tots had just cancelled their promise of toys for a party Wednesday and they needed 500 toys. They were able to get them from us...as did the Los Angeles County Probation Department needing 100 toys, an agency in Santa Monica needing 50 toys, two agencies in East LA needing 700 toys between them, several poor families with nothing, an agency in Thousand Oaks needing 100 toys, and two nursing homes with 100 residents each that wanted stuffed animals.

WHERE DID THE TOYS COME FROM???? I've never seen anything like this—and there are still several hundred small toys left!!! I deeply wanted to share the Christmas miracles, blessings and grace that have been extended so generously to Heartfelt and those we all serve.

of community as we become more engaged and involved with each other at such precious moments. It is truly a blessing. And it's available to everyone in this Church."

ElderReach places teams of two to assist and embrace our church elders who feel cut off from the community, making a minimum of two calls or visits per month. The outcome of this attention is sometimes nothing short of miraculous.

"It's remarkable how much these calls and visits improve their quality of life. Most of the time, they perk up so much from receiving attention that they become completely different people. We've seen shutdown, depressed, bedridden seniors virtually come back to life, get back on their feet and turn into vibrant social butterflies!

"And the volunteers often experience such blessings and Grace by connecting with these souls who have so much to share about their long lives. It's a beautiful process to behold."

CIRCLE OF LIGHT

The growing Circle of Light program was established as a silent, spiritual ministry for those who are in the transition process. Specially trained volunteer MSIA ministers essentially anchor the Light 24 hours a day in 3-hour shifts by the bedside of dying ministers, initiates and Discourse subscribers.

"When we first started this program several years ago, we weren't sure what to expect since it was an area that we as a church hadn't dealt with before, in the way of instruction. But the outcome has been phenomenal, with many unforeseen experiences of Spirit's presence and the overwhelming Light and grace of the Traveler that assists the transition," explains Patti.

"At the last moments of life, sometimes there can be a little stress and confusion as we work to disengage. We, as initiates, may even forget our Traveler's spiritual promise—that they hold the keys to the highest realms of Light and will be with us to the end and beyond. With the support of the Circle of Light, the pathway into Spirit is so greatly illuminated, that at the end there is the possibility of no dropping of the consciousness, just a soul slipping easily into the arms of God in full awareness. Those participating are given transcendent glimpses of all the spiritual dimensions...it's an amazing, powerful experience for both the giver and receiver as the Traveler manifests.

"What's more, there has been a tremendous and special benefit to the MSIA family at large. Something special happens when one of our own makes the transition surrounded by a Circle of Light. There is a coalescence

of community as we become more engaged and involved with each other at such precious moments. It is truly a blessing. And it's available to everyone in this Church."

The Circle of Light Program is currently in place in several cities besides Los Angeles, including Santa Barbara, San Diego and Napa, CA; Portland, OR; Santa Fe, NM; Miami, FL; Philadelphia, PA; and Sydney and Brisbane, Australia. Ministers in Austin, TX will soon host a training workshop, and requests have come in from as far away as London and other places around the world.

"The most important contribution with the Circle of Light might be the calm that is created. That's the truth. Why is the Light calm? Because it's relaxed. Well, why is it relaxed? Because something very beautiful and magnificent is going on the other side and the awareness of that is calm and clear."

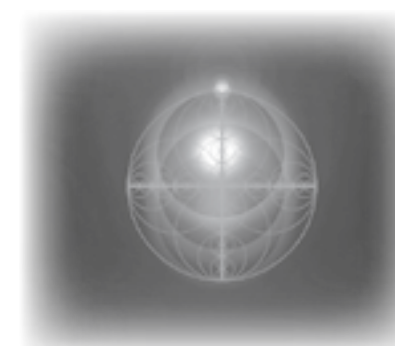

The Transformational Power of Ministry and Max

An Interview with Kevin Masterson and his Dog

NDH: How did you get involved in visiting the elderly?

Kevin: I've always tried to do some sort of ministry. I worked with disturbed children for a while, and then six or seven years ago I heard Dannion Brinkley talk (he's an author who writes about spirituality and near-death experiences). I had an exchange with him where he suggested that I do hospice work.

NDH: We're going to see Jean in a little while. How did you find her?

Kevin: I found Jean through Roze Room Hospice where I was doing volunteer work. When I first started visiting Jean about two years ago, the hospice I worked with gave me a choice of who to visit. The chaplain took me around and introduced me to the patients. There was one lady who was about 97 and had a boyfriend, and was really active. Then they took me into another room that was very dark, and the woman in there was incontinent, with glassy eyes, almost catatonic. I thought that would be the hardest one, but that would be the most rewarding one to choose. That was Jean.

NDH: And that's when you started bringing your dog, Max?

Kevin: It turned out that she had just had to give her dog up, so she was very depressed. So I brought Max. She was bedridden, and Max would jump up on the bed and lick her and just sit with her for an hour. Little by little she came around. We started visiting her in March of 2010. By September or October I thought that she should be ready to make her transition soon, because the people who are admitted to hospice are supposed to have about six months to live.

But instead she was moved from hospice into long-term care because she just wasn't ready to die yet. One day it was really funny—a social worker came to see Jean just before Max and I arrived to visit. Jean wouldn't talk to the social worker anymore. She excused herself and said she had to go because Max had come to see her.

After Jean was moved from hospice, it took a couple of months for me to find her, and then we started to visit again. When we arrived, for a second she didn't know who I was but as soon as she saw Max she remembered him. One of the nurses at the long-term care facil-

ity told me that Jean is now one of the most upbeat and positive people there. She gets out, goes to the community room, and is very social. She repeats herself a lot, and forgets things, but she is so grateful that we come. When we leave she always grabs my hand and tells me how grateful she is that we visit.

NDH: Do you always take Max with you?

Kevin: I've had other hospice patients that I visit, and I've always taken Max. It's a great icebreaker. He's so natural at it. I don't know of anyone else who takes their pet. But it works great with people with dementia, because it gives them something to focus on and establish a connection with. The social workers were amazed by the changes in Jean after I started visiting with Max. When she sees him her eyes start to focus and she comes present. She also responds to humans differently when Max is around.

Max really enjoys it too. He knows it's his job and he'll get depressed if we don't go to visit for a while. One woman that we visit was too fragile to take Max's weight

I recently had the opportunity to visit with MSIA Minister Kevin Masterson, who has been visiting elderly people in nursing homes with his Pomeranian, Max. We talked for a while in his apartment and then visited Jean, who has changed remarkably since Kevin began his visits. It was fun to walk down a hallway of people in wheelchairs, and see their faces brighten up as they saw Max trot down the hall. Jean held Max on her lap as she sat in her wheelchair, petted and cared for Max, and talked almost nonstop either to or about him. She was clearly enthralled by the loving attention and by her ability to give.

on her lap, and he seemed really confused, as though he wasn't able to do his job. I try to go about once a week as long as I have time.

NDH: Seeing you with Jean, it seems like you're having a lot of fun.

Kevin: I took a ministry class at Prana where we discussed what our ministry was. I'll never forget how Laren Bright looked at me at one point and said, "You know, your ministry can be fun." I always try to use that as a guideline. I remember visiting a woman named Helen in the hospital, a very funny, wealthy woman who would always say really off-the-wall things. The hospital chaplain came to visit us, very serious and eager to help. She told us earnestly about how she was there to offer support, and asked us if there was anything we needed. Helen said, "Come in and sit down. You missed all the excitement because I just took my top off." The chaplain caught the spirit there and ended up asking to stay there with us as Helen ministered to her.

There's another woman that I visit regularly, named Madeleine. She tends to get depressed and always has the TV on because she's lonely. Recently she was watching some pretty negative news and talk shows while I was with her. She commented on how horrible the world is and was depressed and somewhat confused. I changed the channel and found "I Love Lucy". We sat and laughed for an hour. She became focused and was really uplifted when we left. I am going to make "Lucy therapy" part of our visits with her.

It's a simple ministry, and you can bring so much joy to people. With some people it's just a matter of getting them outdoors, taking them to lunch or something. Even a simple compliment about how nice they look works wonders because then they don't feel so inconsequential. They feel like they have something to contribute, that someone still sees them. It's not the quantity of time you spend with them, but the quality. Just those little moments of connection make a huge difference.

I remember sitting with a few women in a long-term care facility. One woman who thanked me for visiting, saying, "It's so nice to have a young man like you come to visit—usually people like you don't want to talk to old ladies like us." I said, "Why would I not want to talk to you? You have so much wisdom." People like that need to feel like they still have something to give. And I really do learn a lot from them as well.

NDH: Do you find that you've been changed by this ministry?

Kevin: Yes, I have much more appreciation for my health for one thing. It gives me so much gratitude for so many things. I've had periods where I wasn't working and was struggling. I had a friend with AIDS that I was assisting. I was with him until he drew his last breath. I didn't have money to give, but I could give of myself. It opened my heart up so much. It's the hardest thing I've ever done, and it's also the best thing I've ever done. The amount of love to give is unlimited even if the material things are limited, and it made me see what I was capable of.

Especially now with the economic situation, some people don't have money to give. But you can always give of yourself. Sometimes I'll feel stuck in my life and I know that I need to do more service, and after I start to serve, things start moving again. J-R says "the willingness to do creates the ability to do." Just being willing to be of service seems to open my spirit up more.

INITIATION

If you are just starting the Soul Awareness Discourses, Discourse #1 explains initiation into the Sound Current. You may choose to study the Discourses with the intention to be initiated on this path, or to simply read them as information. If you do choose to study toward initiation, the Traveler works with you more closely, and you may notice a greater spiritual awareness in your own consciousness as this work goes on.

If you are studying toward initiation, you need to write and mail a letter to the Traveler that this is your intention. If you have written and mailed your intention to the Traveler, you can apply for initiation when you have completed Discourse 24.

THE MSIA MINISTRY

The MSIA ministry is for initiates of the Traveler who are called inwardly to serve the spirit of their hearts.

Service may be in any form, from volunteering for the Church to assisting people in need or organizations that serve those people, and anything in between. The only requirement is that the ministry is active and done regularly.

MSIA ministers may perform services, like marriages, that clergy of other denominations are authorized to do as long as they comply with the laws of the locality in which they serve.

WRITING TO J-R & JOHN

Sometimes people reading Discourses, especially those studying toward initiation, want to write to John Morton or John-Roger. Writing often helps you let go of a troubling situation and open more to the Traveler's assistance inwardly.

As soon as you write to John Morton or John-Roger, they get the message on the spiritual levels, and they do what Spirit allows. Then, to let go of the situation in your consciousness, you burn or mail your letter. Whether you burn or mail what you wrote, you may find that you get your answers on the inner levels, sometimes very quickly. You may also experience greater calm, clarity, or peace, which can help you go through whatever challenges you face.

We suggest that you place the situation in the Light, ask for clarification during s.e.s, dreams, etc., and then look for the answers within you. Often reading a Discourse or listening to an MSIA tape (either at home or at a seminar) will provide keys to assist you in handling your situation. You can also refer to any of the numerous books by J-R and John to find information that relates to what you are dealing with. These two have shared so much with us over the years, and we encourage you to send your letters via e-mail, using these addresses:

If you live in the United States and if you send your letter to J-R or John in hard copy via the mail, you need to include a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) if you want a reply from either of them.

This does not imply that your concern is not important or that you are being ignored. There simply may be no need for a physical reply, or there may be no answer available to you at the time you write.

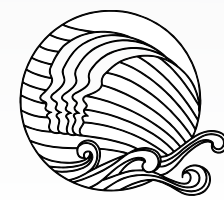

The Purple Rose by Rama Fox

As we know, throughout the ages there have been countless icons and symbols found on ancient ruins, tablets and writings. So when J-R mentioned the Purple Rose, I thought he was merely conjuring a special, lovely and figurative symbol for us in MSIA.

In the fall of 1969,

while living in Miami, Florida, I came into a very young MSIA. A dozen or so of us got together weekly and listened to cassette tapes lovingly sent to us by Ruben Perez, who taped J-R's Santa Barbara talks. In early 1970, J-R made his first trip to work with the Miami MSIA family. And we certainly had become a family, many of us to this day still remaining very close and living now in Los Angeles.

As I recall, it was during that first visit that I heard J-R casually mention the "Purple Rose" in connection to MSIA. He didn't elaborate about it, as it was included in other information – and I didn't have the awareness to ask for clarification. Actually, back then, if we'd questioned him about every new thing he brought up that we didn't understand, he'd never have gotten through a single seminar. We were relative babies and he was spoon-feeding us timeless wisdoms.

Back then quite a few of us were seeing the purple light flashes he often spoke of as one of the ways the Mystical Traveler made Its presence known – even when J-R wasn't physically present. Also, on a relatively frequent basis when in his physical presence, many of us saw a vast purple aura radiating from him, and also when we were with him in our dreams. So a purple rose seemed an ideal symbol. Because of this, various renditions of purple roses were abundant in the creations of MSIA artists, from tooled leather handbags to oil paintings.

A while later, when a historical building was purchased in Los Angeles for MSIA offices and residencies, it seemed perfectly fitting that it be called "PRANA: The Purple Rose Ashram of the New Age." Although the name was later changed to Peace Awareness Labyrinth and Gardens, it's still lovingly referred to as "Prana" – which also means the 'Breath of Life' in Sanskrit.

Fast forward to 1982. During a meditation, without any clue something extraordinary was about to occur, I was suddenly awestruck to see the actual Purple Rose suspended in space before me! It was no figurative symbol. I instantly knew it was

the Purple Rose about which J-R had spoken.

Even though it is far beyond my ability to do it justice, I'll do my very limited best to share what I saw. Perhaps as you read this, the Preceptor will aid your greater self into recognition and resonance with what we all somewhere within us already know.

As anyone who's had a Direct Experience of Reality knows, there's nothing else like it. It is supremely Supra-Natural – completely eclipsing everyday life. There's no question whatsoever what it is. Its divinity is instantly and entirely clear. During this kind of experience, one is in a state of KNOWING ... transcendent of mental conjuring or intellectual deduction and reasoning.

It was as if my eyes were suddenly opened into a new dimension. There, suspended before me, I saw an unimaginably vivid, enormous and breathtakingly beautiful "rose" made of Living Purple Light – in which all shades of purple exist, from the deepest to magenta and ultra-violet. It was a continuously moving, radiant, mystical and beyond-exquisite flower-like manifestation. To some who might see it, they may liken it to a gigantic and eternal living lotus.

It appeared to me to be constructed of an infinite number of somewhat elongated “petals” or ellipses consisting of flowing, living purple light. Each petal/ellipse appeared joined together at one end, connected into a single, central core. As each petal came toward the central core, its color became absorbed into diamond white brilliance. Each petal’s perimeter appeared to consist of ultra vivid purple light – some of the perimeters flowing clockwise and others flowing counter-clockwise, like an infinity sign would do if its outside edges were moving. (Perhaps if you chose to trace one in the air will make this more clear.) Where the infinity sign comes together in the center is at the core.

It was crystal clear to me that each petal was/is an entire universe. And there was a constant “opening and unfolding” of the petals out of the core, as well as the petals, themselves, moving. The movement was/is many things ... including Life, Itself, and all that goes on in each universe. Where all the petals met (the core) is “where” Infinity/The Eternal Now/All Oneness/All Being is undiluted. It appeared to me that the central core is “where” one moves in and out of any given universe. And deep within that infinite “center” is the “seat” of the Preceptor ... The Light of All Universes. As you most likely can imagine, I was transfixed and spellbound.

Again, try as I may, my words cannot even slightly begin to do this justice. And this is not The Whole – it is a living aspect of The Whole. How I know this is not clear to me. And, as extraordinary as it was/is ... it’s my impression that consciously seeing this is not a prerequisite to J-R taking us to God.

I have no idea why I saw it. Perhaps it was because I was to one day share this with you ... and J-R will take it from there.

Eventually, after that one sighting, I only thought about the true Purple Rose on occasion because I didn’t really know what to do with the awareness. So (for me) it rested for years, more or less in the wings of my consciousness.

I did note with interest that, reportedly, going past the emitted light wave-length of purple, colors move into the invisible. Something that might be of interest is that in the last few years I discovered in a lighting store strings of LED Christmas lights which emit a purple light energetically reminiscent of some of the light emitted from the Purple Rose. I’ve subsequently seen these lights on display in various venues. Needless to say, I had to buy and put them on my Christmas tree. Many a night when I have my tree up, I gaze at those lights ... as Spirit stirs my soul.

And, as if that were not enough, something else was given to me recently that gave me chills, moved my heart and brought me to tears. It’s said things come to us when we’re ready – so we (you who are reading this and I, being allowed to write it) are, apparently, ready. An email arrived in my computer with a link to video images from the Hubble Telescope – into “the ultra-deep field” of this universe. What is shown is, for me, beyond mind-boggling. It is transportive.

The scientists who brought this viewing about were fascinated by a very small speck in the universe near the Big Dipper that appeared to be completely empty – devoid of stars, planets, galaxies ... anything. From their perspective in the totality of space, this seeming emptiness appeared to be no bigger than a grain of sand held away from the body at arm’s length. (To more readily grasp how small that appeared to them, you may choose to hold your arm out, pretending to hold a grain of sand in your fingers – and imagine it up in the night sky.)

In 1996, they took an enormously significant and costly risk of utilizing their allotted time with Hubble to focus into what could have turned out to be nothing.

Over the course of 10 full days slowly appeared photons of light that had traveled for over 13 Billion years before touching Hubble ... revealing 3,000 more galaxies - each with hundreds of billions of stars! It was considered by some at the time to be the most profound and humbling images seen in human history.

Then, again, in 2004, they decided to view another “empty” sliver near the Constellation Orion. Slowly, in 11 days (and Hubble’s 400 complete orbits around earth) was revealed over 10,000 more galaxies (not just stars)! This became known as “the ultra-deep field” – an image representing the farthest science has ever seen into the universe.

From when Universe was calculated to be only 500 million years old, photons of Light from these galaxies took billions of years to reach Hubble (our eyeglass, so to speak). Reportedly, these galaxies, while standing still, are racing away from us ... sometimes faster than the speed of light. It’s currently estimated that there are over 100 billion galaxies in the universe ... each with hundreds of billions of stars.

Astronomers suspect this ultra deep field view to be the edge of the universe ... expanding ... growing. Which, of course, begs the questions, “What’s beyond the edge of the universe ... and what is it growing into?” It is reported that scientists have no idea what makes up 95% of the universe.

As I observed what unfolded before me while watching the video, I consciously experienced J-R, as Preceptor, showing me a minuscule slice of the unimaginable vastness – beholding the wonder and beauty of God’s physical body, just in this universe, alone. I recall hearing from deep within me, “Oh, My God ... I am looking deeply into a tiny part of myself. It’s all beautiful ... in the greater reality there is nothing (no thing) that is not beautiful. The perception of non-beauty is an illusion ... a reflection of how/what I do not yet know how to love.”

And this is only the physical level ... not all the other levels are visibly present. And only this universe. Astronomers are now acknowledging they are aware there are more than just one universe. Some even speculate there may be an infinite number of universes.

Again the Purple Rose jumped into center stage of my awareness. This time as a kind of far-vision. Universes, constantly moving, united in the white light core. My experience was of being shown what I’m not able at this time to wrap my mind around ... expansive, awakening ... and blissful. And even if I was somehow able, there’s no way I could put it into words.

J-R’s book, The Path to Mastership, shares this: “When you start to experience bliss, you know you have tapped into the Soul level energy.” It also states, “Buddha said, ‘I am the Light of Asia.’ Christ said, ‘I am the Light of the world.’ The Traveler says, ‘I am the Light of the Universe.’ And the Preceptor says, ‘I am the Light of all universes.’ This is not a spiritual promise. It is reality now. It is present now. . . .”

One of the many astonishing things I am being shown is that our beloved Preceptor (who reportedly only embodies every 25,000 years – and is with us now) is for the first time on this planet (as far as we know) allowing us to actually view a tiny part of the edge of this universe. Utilizing Hubble as one method to do this, it seems to me that our Preceptor is bringing this opportunity to all souls embodied here – some of us getting to see it (and recognize what it is) before others get to see it ... as “time” unfolds. What a miracle. What a blessing. What wonderment.

That I am allowed to share this so openly adds to my awareness that something very special is happening. In the past few years many of us have witnessed a “change” in J-R. At times, looking into his eyes has been like looking into infinity – endlessly deep. Vast. Still. Full of loving and light.

A couple of years ago I started to think that perhaps what many of us were commenting about seeing, which seemed ‘different’ about J-R, was actually the Preceptor ... oh, so subtly manifesting physically. For whatever reason, our Beloved Preceptor is giving us a gift – an infinitesimal glimpse of The Whole. In no way can I understand this – much less explain it. I just know it and see it.

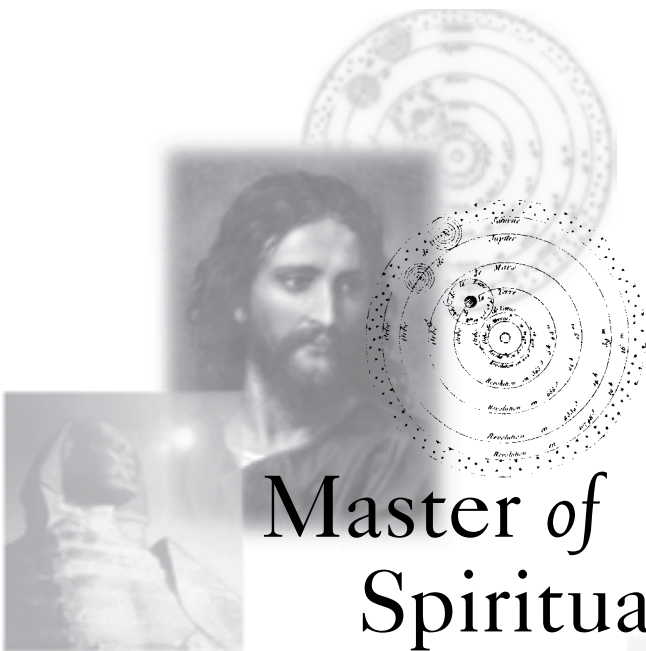

The Master's Program

Year One: Creating Through Grace

During year one, Creating Through Grace, students gain greater awareness of how they live their lives—physically, emotionally, and mentally—and of how they can bring these levels into greater alignment and cooperation with their spiritual intention. In doing this, students can increase their singleness of purpose so that, regardless of outer circumstances, they can experience God as their partner, and grace can be extended to them in greater ways.

The student has the opportunity to take the teachings to deeper levels of awareness, where simple changes can become invaluable lessons for living an ordinary life. The Doctor of Spiritual Science (DSS) program aims to assist students in moving to new levels of expansiveness and awareness.
