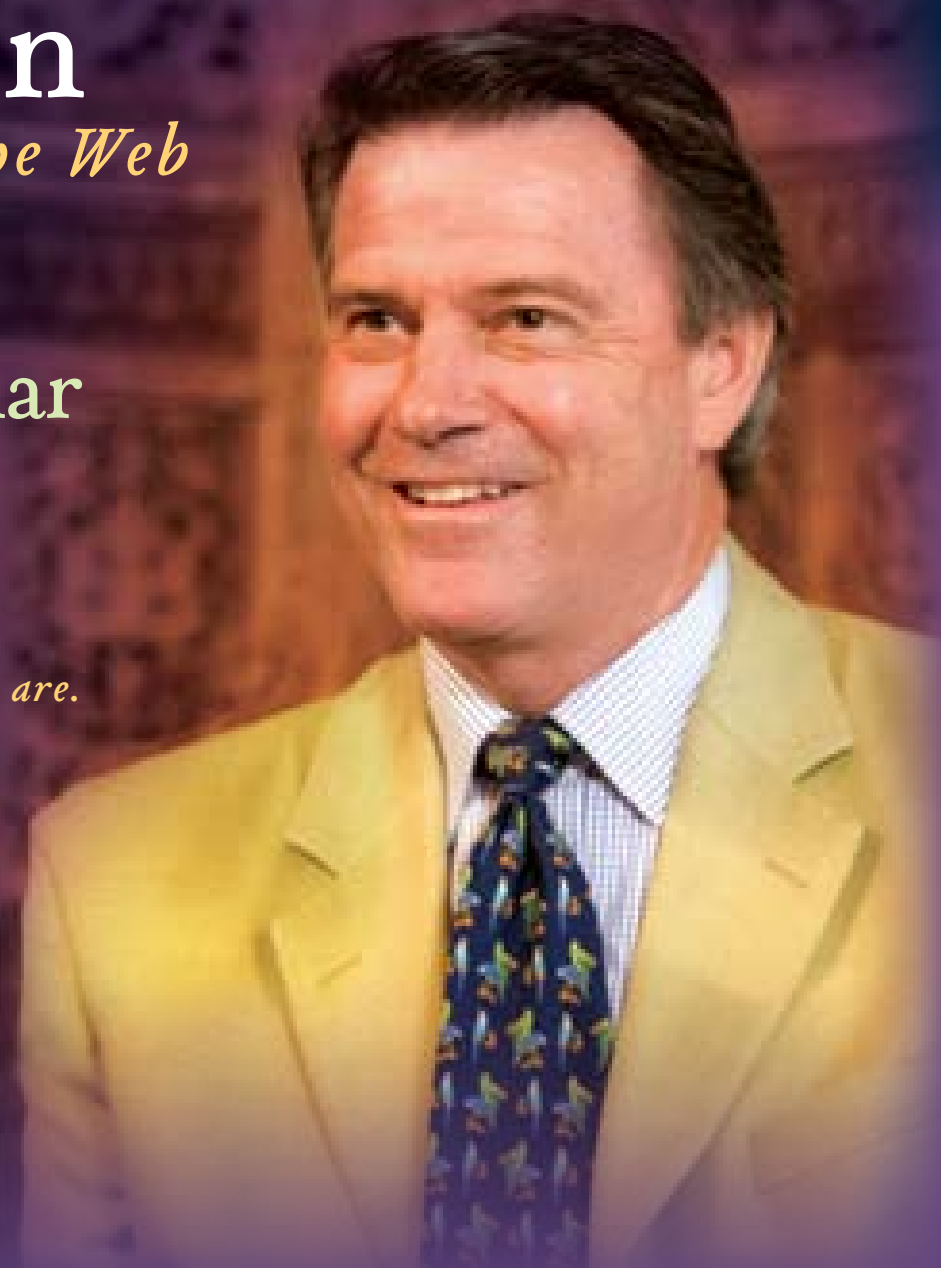

John-Roger's life is a demonstration of how to be successful in the physical world while living a life dedicated to Spirit.

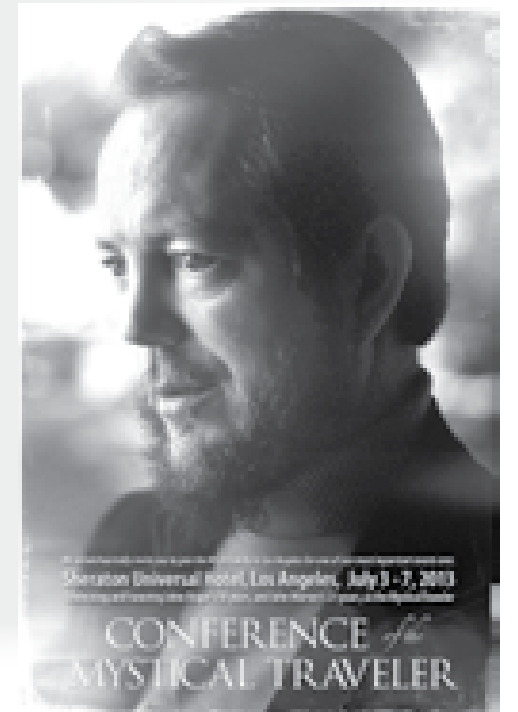

# WHEN THE MYSTICAL TRAVELER WORKS WITH YOU

BY JOHN-ROGER, DSS

*From a John-Roger seminar from 1972*

It's not the physical body that does this. It is the Mystical Traveler consciousness that can extend into the physical realm, by using my consciousness. And it allows me to extend back up through it and to the Godhead, and bring back the awarenesses.

**I WANT TO REMIND** you that I don't have to do these seminars. I come and talk to you because I have a very personal love for you—a very personal spiritual love. I can only give you that spiritual love when you allow it. If you sit and think, "He doesn't love me," then I can't do it. I have to stand on the edge of your thought and wait for you to say, "Maybe he does," and you feel a little urging that says, "Yeah. Yeah. Keep going. Keep going." It's not the physical body that does this. It is the Mystical Traveler consciousness that can extend into the physical realm, by using my consciousness. And it allows me to extend back up through it and to the Godhead, and bring back the awarenesses. It is a consciousness that was performing so accurately and so lovingly that it also received the Preceptor consciousness—which will appear again in 25,000 years if it appears again.

There have been times when we have had to move past the Mystical Traveler and into the Preceptor consciousness that comes right out of the center of the ocean of love and mercy, and transform a person's life, because they could be of more service in fulfilling the Divine plan by doing this. This isn't done often.

The Mystical Traveler doesn't work the way you want it to. It works the way it's going to work. That was one of the biggest lessons that I learned from 1963 up to the end of 1964, and even into 1965, before I realized that this physical body was not the Mystical Traveler. It was interesting to look in the mirror and think, "I have complete conscious con-



trol of all levels." And it was my ego speaking. This force would throw me to the floor physically and say, "My beloved, this is an instrument that we are using to bring forward this higher Light at this time. Will you hold still and allow us to flow." And I would say, "Well, yes, sure."

When I say, "I love you," that is not coming from a physical body. That is the Mystical Traveler consciousness that is coming through at this time, right now. And this is the time when healings take place, if people have the wit to open their consciousness and say, "Do what can be done." This is the time when the Holy Spirit steps forward and touches to you. But if you are still training yourself, like a basic self, then we still love you, but we must pass for just now. But we stand by.

It's a real shock to a person to find out that the Mystical Traveler consciousness has removed

itself from you and you are placed within a magnetic force field. That means you walk out the days of your life hit and miss, hit and miss, hit and miss. And there is great joy to find out that there are these energy forces being brought forward on the planet, and that they are your heritage. Like I said, I don't have to be here physically to do these seminars. I'd have to send a tape though, or a representative, who would allow this consciousness to flow through—because you have a right to it. Don't forget that.

The Mystical Traveler's school is an esoteric school. Physically, it's not taking place. Of course we love each other here in the physical world, and I could put my arms around the whole group and take you home and treat you royally, and you'd have all sorts of wonderful things. But I don't have a big enough house. The house for me is the whole world.

When I kid with you, often that is not a personality kidding with you. That is the consciousness of spirit reaching in and breaking things loose right in front of you. Many have the wit to see it and know it, and often many feel it, and many stand up and say, "I'd like to tell you about the healings that are impossible that have been taking place." If you straighten somebody's s-shaped back overnight they're going to be in such pain that they are not going to be able to stand it—but it could be done. But isn't it more loving, and more gracious and more humanistic and God-like to do it for their highest good, even if they don't know what it is until they look back? And then in hindsight, which often times seems to be 20/20 vision, we say, "Oh, thank God." So don't get hung up on the physical form.

Long before you've asked, the help is already there. At that moment you find out what divine love is. Then the Mystical Traveler says, "Come let's go. We are preparing the place for you."

A lot of people think the seminars only go on once a week, and others think they go on at night, but others are finding out that John-Roger is working with you 26 hours a day. While you are driving your car down the road I can have you in soul consciousness traveling. The first few times it's difficult, but later on you get more and more used to it. Then later on we start taking more and more of your consciousness and bringing it along. Some days you feel like, "Gee I could just put myself right down and drop off to sleep." Sometimes when we are doing this we are getting too close to your physical consciousness. That's the day you feel spaced out. Instead of bitching, why don't you say thanks, and on that day do methodical, routine things. Do your filing or clean the toilet bowl—something that doesn't take too much thought.

You'll hear the Mystical Traveler say, "Come with me my beloved and we will go." Some hear it and they say "WHOOPEE", and they block the whole action. I've been in seminars or meetings where this Mystical Traveler spirit or Holy Spirit will hit them and it will knock them right out of their seat on the floor, and they will start going yelling, "Alleluia," "Amen," and raving. We say take that person out of here, they are an affront to their own consciousness. The Holy Spirit is dignified. There is nothing that it cannot do.

Your limitation prevents it from working. If you don't think it can work, it won't work with you. It's interesting,

because when you say, "I love you John-Roger," I know it isn't my physical form. Well, once in a while it is. That makes me feel good because I would like to think that Spirit chose something that was pretty nice. I was up in Berkeley doing a seminar and one girl said, "I just think you are handsome." I just tripped for the next five people. Then I realized, "Oh, golly, I'm already in the Mystical Traveler consciousness and this is what she's seeing." And, so I pierced my little ego balloon and got back down to just doing it.

People say "I want to love," and I say, "Why do you want to love? Why don't you just do it? Why not, right now, just love?" You say, "I don't know how." Can you think of a warm feeling inside of you? If you're vegetarian, think of a nice fruit salad. If you're not, think of a nice juicy steak. If you're thirsty think of a cool glass of refreshing water. Let that feeling start going that teaches you how to love. Then shoot it right up here, and I'll send it back to you. As much as you send, I'll send back double. If you don't feel it, it is because you are expecting it to come back another way.

As you give to it, it gives back to you what you give and more. I had a man come up to me who heard about this, and he had a check for a tremendous amount of money. We could have built a great big temple. He handed it to me and said, "I can't wait to see that come back double." I said, "Look with both eyes cause here it comes," and I handed it back. That's not that way that it's done. The love must be given freely. When you give love to me so that I can give it to other people, then it must be given to me to give according to that person's ability to handle it. Sometimes the only way that they can handle it is for me to pick on them a little bit. Sometimes I hug them. Sometimes I pat them on the back. Sometimes I tell them, "Dummy." They're finding out that everything that goes on has both an outer expression and an inner one that goes very, very deep. Sometimes that outer one is just to hold you steady while the soul stirs and gains its strength. And in that strength you start to find out who you are. I can tell you who you are, but until you find out for yourself, it doesn't work. And when you find out for yourself, then you'll know who I am—because I am you.

# The Ordinarity and Blessings of Grief

*When we are grieving, there's a beauty and a grace to be appreciated. It can be hauntingly beautiful. So it's important to give ourselves the space to have the experience without demanding that we should be feeling a different way.*

Grief is an ordinary human response to a sense of loss, such as the death of a loved one. We can feel wounded, hurt and in pain when someone we love transitions. Rather than trying to get rid of those feelings, it's better to find a way to appreciate the grieving and the essence of grieving as experiences provided to you for your learning, upliftment and growth. Remember, every situation and circumstance is designed by God to bring out the best in us.

When we're upset and hurt, it may be hard to smile and laugh. But we still can because the eternal joy is always present and can move through the sorrow. So as your joy returns and naturally comes forth, just allow that to be. Don't judge your process.

When we lose someone, we are often shown our judgments and attachments. So it's important to look at your relationships, including the one with whoever has passed on, and what we want to create within ourselves. As we allow ourselves to grieve naturally, there's a healing of

the wound or place where the attachment had been. The deeper the involvement, the deeper the attachment and perhaps the greater the grieving experience.

When we are grieving, there's a beauty and a grace to be appreciated. It can be hauntingly beautiful. So it's important to give ourselves the space to have the experience without demanding that we should be feeling a different way. Even if you make rules about how you should feel, it is what it is and you will feel what you feel. I don't have rules for how anyone should feel about the loss of a loved one. Perhaps others do. They may expect you to be different than the way you are as you grieve. I don't, and I suggest you don't put such expectations on yourself.

It's important to take responsibility for all of our feelings, knowing that everything we feel at some level we have created, promoted and allowed. Nobody else controls our feelings or thoughts. We create them with what we focus upon and what we allow in our choices.

## A Personal Experience with Loss and Grieving

When I was in my early twenties, a friend of mine from childhood died in a car accident. I remember thinking, "That could have been me." At the time I didn't quite understand why I thought that. I wasn't supposed to be with him at the time. He was actually delivering something as a part of his job. But he had invited me to come visit. We were living in the same vicinity, and I had an understanding that I was somehow tied into his death experience.

Until the funeral, I hadn't cried or experienced anything really emotional about his passing although I was certainly affected by it. When I got to the funeral, I realized something had built up inside of me. I was aware that I'd loved him more than I'd ever experienced. I remember thinking, "What a beautiful person he was." Then there was the sense of missing him and the sense of loss that now existed. At the same time, I had this powerful experience of his presence right then and there. There were a couple of ways that I got it.

One time was while his father was giving a eulogy and talking about how he would get into mischief. My friend wasn't a troublesome kind of person. He was just somebody mischievous, adventurous and willing to cross lines. Right at the moment when his dad was talking, a door toward the back of the church flew open and then slammed shut. I just knew somehow that was a sign that spiritually my friend had somehow come in or was leaving.

The combination of that moment along with everything else got to me. Within a few seconds, I was sobbing. I remember thinking, "Men don't do this." I felt self-conscious and like I was in some way being weak. I actually got up and moved to a corner in the church so I could go through my process more privately, which was very important for me in my learning and healing.

As a result of choosing to allow myself to cry, I did the grieving. The grief showed up and happened within seconds as this very intense process. I'm very glad that I could not control my grief. I tried to stuff it, but I couldn't. I don't ever remember sobbing like that before that moment. It was a deep uncontrollable, emotional release.

What showed up afterwards, after I had gone through the sobbing, was a celebration of my friend's life. I knew a joy along with an experience that he was alive. I knew very clearly that wherever he was, it was really good. So I was happy, in fact, happier right in that moment than I'd been in a long time. I couldn't remember being so happy and clear.

What I learned from that experience, which is the truth of the process for me, is that when we experience the loss there is a grieving. The process of grief is an ordinary process in our human experience in this world. It is our experiencing the reality of missing someone and having that sense of loss on a personal level. So it's important to allow ourselves to move through that process however it works for us.

For a long time, that experience of profound sadness confounded me. I wondered what it was that came over me. It didn't quite add up to me that it was all about missing or appreciating my friend. I eventually understood, as I do now, that something cathartic took place. It was very beautiful in a way so that I wanted to have that again. Not necessarily because of somebody dying or having a major loss in my life, but because something had happened to me that was spiritual and beautiful. I had a change of consciousness for which I felt grateful. It was a great blessing.

When we experience losses at a deep level, we're in for a cathartic change that will serve us. When we have a loss, there's something about that that represents an attachment. We need to clear the attachment and heal from it so that we celebrate the transition. For me with the loss of my friend, I experienced the clearing in a matter of moments. Others may take years to do that. I wouldn't rush the process but instead allow for the ways and timing of the Lord.



I would encourage anybody to have the willingness to confront the grief and allow for whatever that is to take place. By embracing whatever has occurred, you don't have anything to be concerned about. It's going to be fine because it's all good. What's called for is to acknowledge whatever it is you're experiencing and let your consciousness take you through the process. Don't put something like an expectation on your experience. Don't say, "I should grieve this way or I should grieve that way." Let your own consciousness determine what works best for you by allowing your process to occur naturally while looking for the good and the blessings in the experience.

Not necessarily because of somebody dying or having a major loss in my life, but because something had happened to me that was spiritual and beautiful. I had a change of consciousness for which I felt grateful. It was a great blessing.*

# The Ordinariness and Blessings of Grief

## Jesus and Grieving

In the story of Jesus' death, he let his disciples know what was going to happen and that the time of his death was near. When he came up to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Mount of Olives area, he asked his disciples to come with him. He brought Peter, James and John with him when his suffering was so severe it brought him to the point of death.

Maybe that's a way of letting us know the depth of the suffering. Not that any of us has a real conscious knowing of what death is all about. But Jesus's story represents something that haunts our consciousness, at least at a distance, and perhaps closely --- the idea that death is something that's unknown but often preceded by a process that we interpret as suffering.

At the point of death, those around the one who goes through the transition we know as death may also be suffering and grieving. Part of the message Jesus gave his disciples that night was that although it was their time to enter into grief, their grief would be turned to joy. All of what comes from the Father is turned to good. Nothing is wasted. All things have purpose, even at the lowest level we may find ourselves.

When he was at his darkest hour, Jesus asked the three disciples he brought with him to stay awake, to stay with him, and to watch. The way I look at that is that was the Lord saying, "Here is a time when I can use you. Here's a time when you have the opportunity to support me. We are in this together. Death is not something that separates us."

During the Last Supper, Jesus told his disciples, "I call you friends, and I call you my servants as though I'm the master. But if I'm to deliver to you what is coming from the Father, then you must become one like me. You must become my friends." Friends are people who, if nothing else, love and care

and share. So it was an opportunity for the disciples to offer their loving and caring and sharing.

Also in the story at Gethsemane, Jesus asked for the cup to be taken from him, a cup that is often referred to as a bitter one because what was to be done was considered unpleasant. For whatever reason, there are processes in this world that come in forms that are unpleasant. But those times don't last.

Our grieving and suffering won't last. The promise that was given is everlasting life and everlasting joy, but not in terms of this world. It's not here that it's delivered. But it is here that it's chosen. This is the place that we choose into it. This is where joy is at hand. Jesus said, "The Kingdom is at hand." When we reach out to it and make it something that we behold, then we save ourselves. Choosing back is our salvation.

Jesus had asked, "Oh Father, if this cup can be taken, please take it." He then said, "Father, Your will and not mine." So the wisdom was present that the way that was going to be best was according to the Father.

Jesus's process was of accepting what had to be done, going through the pain and suffering and knowing its form. It's obvious that Jesus had the ability and experience to know what was coming and to choose into it nonetheless. Part of his message was that he knew what was coming and he chose it anyway, trusting the Lord's will.

As you look into who you are as a soul, you can realize that everything of this world is temporal. But things of the spirit are everlasting. We are learning that as we choose into what Christ has delivered, we choose into the everlasting and to make that our way. It's important to realize that it's a process that shifts and changes so that we go through joy and we go through sorrow and pain. And we go through the healing and the blessings.

The essential message, what was left with us in terms of what Jesus did from that point forward, is about love. What remained was the deep abiding love for everything. The way it was demonstrated was through giving it all up to God and embracing it nobly. That's not a requirement. So you can choose to go kicking and screaming, if that's the way you want to go. But you'll go, nonetheless. So you might as well choose into it with loving and faith in the divine will.

## Finding the Blessings in Grief

It is your destiny to be blessed, even in situations where there is great pain and suffering, such as the loss of a loved one. I have assisted a lot of people through their experiences of loss and grief. My initial response is to extend myself in any way I can that's comforting, nurturing, and consoling. I find that the first move is to express empathy and understanding if I can.

Times of loss are often completely bewildering for those involved directly. They are often in shock or very deep disturbance. They may be stunned, numb or perhaps enraged. All of those reactions I consider ordinary, human responses. So I'm not trying in any way to make reactions wrong. I don't find a purpose in taking that approach. I encourage people to experience and be aware of their feelings and to move into acknowledgement of the Lord's will. I ask them, "What are you feeling? What are you thinking?"

They may be thinking, "This is terrible. It's awful. I don't deserve it. What kind of God would do such a thing? It's unfair. It's the worst thing I could imagine that could happen to me in my life." If that's what you're thinking, I encourage you to come through that acknowledgement process as long as it takes. It could take a lifetime, so that a person could die eighty years later still grieving and upset in some way with what happened long ago. Rather than make that wrong or question why they would still be grieving, I move into the acknowledgment of the perfection in God's creation. I encourage them to consider, "What would you want?" And often they say things, "I want my child back" or "I want my loved one back." That's understandable. So I encourage them to acknowledge and move through their desire towards acceptance.

Sometimes I'll ask, "How long have you been feeling this?" I invite them to consider if there's another way they would like to feel instead. Often they respond about wanting the pain and suffering to go away. They wonder if that's possible. Of course, that's possible.

I'll ask, "Would you be willing to do your part to take some responsibility for what's necessary to relieve that pain?" As they consider what they're willing to do, I may also ask, "Would you be willing to make it okay at some level that whatever happened to you or your loved one, the grieving part is yours?"

There could be something that they need to do, as their responsibility to change how they relate to that event. I encourage them to find something valuable in what has occurred. When they do, they often come and tell me, "You should let the people you love know you love them. You should be willing to spend more time in caring actions and less time in things that don't matter."

The things that don't matter are often those that people remember with regret. They may say something like, "I wish I would have told my child I love them more" or "I wish I'd done more fun things with them and had not been so critical and condemning of their expression." These regrets are often at the root of someone's suffering. So I'll ask, "Is there anything you can do about what already happened?"



Eventually we realize there is nothing we can do about the past. What's done is done. What can we do now? We can accept and make it okay at some level that those things happened because those are the things that are at the core of the suffering.

Whatever happened or didn't happen to you or your loved one is inside of you. So let that go. Release it and forgive yourself. Forgiveness is another great key for overcoming our sadness and grief.

Our spiritual nature is forgiveness. It's one of the great blessings that I consider comes directly from God to all. But not everybody is willing to accept the forgiveness.

Forgiveness is the way for self-healing. Would you like to heal the hurt? That's a question I get to as soon as I find that someone is ready to heal.

Are you ready to heal? If you are, would you be willing to forgive? If you're not willing to forgive but you want to heal yourself, then consider that the way to your healing is through your forgiveness. And particularly in the forgiveness of yourself.

The things that people hold onto as judgments and blame about their role in a loved one's death are truly out of their control. Often I'll ask if they could in some way have stopped what happened. Usually they find that they could not have done anything different. When they have that realization, it's an amazing one. They may say, "There was nothing that I could have done. Even if I felt that I could have, God had a hold of them before they died."

If it felt like they could have stopped the death, then I go through with them what they remembered. I find over and over that the opportunity to stop the death, the choice to prevent the transition, was actually not available to them. Something happened that was beyond their control which stopped them from preventing the death. They couldn't do anything about it. God was in control. When you have that awareness and know that truth, it's an amazing relief.

## Grief and the Traveler

None of us have been put here on earth to control others. A key to moving into freedom is letting go of attachments to others' behaviors or our expectations of what they should do or not do. It's valuable to look at the roles or expectations we have assigned to others which are not ours to assign, including when someone should leave this world.

Take responsibility for requesting and communicating what you want or expect from others. You always have the opportunity to choose greater freedom by giving others the freedom to choose without judgment from you. This is acceptance and caring for others. As you give this freedom to others, you also take this freedom for yourself.

When we look at death, we may have many ideas about it. Perhaps we've had some experiences that we identify with what it is. Because death is something that is yet to happen, we can't know everything about it.

Death is one of the inevitable occurrences in all our lives. Even though billions of people have done it, it's still a great mystery. In most societies, it's often a very uncomfortable subject to discuss. Death is often associated with grief and pain and something that people do all kinds of things to avoid. Yet as human beings, it's part of our experience that we all must and will do.

Death is also something that is part of the process of soul transcendence. Soul transcendence isn't complete before the physical death. Knowing death as an inevitability, is there an advantage for us to prepare? Can we even prepare? If so, what can we do to prepare? We look to answers in the spirit. And each of us has the experience with spirit inside.

If we are going to look into what takes place in the death experience, there's advantage to being able to look away from the world and away from those things that focus us out into the world. Spiritual exercises are a process of going to the place where we live that's beyond and away from this world. When we do spiritual exercises, as much as we can, we leave the world behind.

In MSIA, we look to who we are as beyond death. One of the great messages of Jesus the Christ is as a wayshower of overcoming the things of this world and to know that death is a form of illusion. While death is a great mystery, it's also a great initiation which means a great beginning. If you consider that who you truly are is beyond death, then you have a great initiation in front of you. It isn't a matter of just surviving in the world. There's a great preparation that we can do for the worlds to come.

We can come into a knowing of what's beyond death before we face it. The advantage would be obvious. If we know what we're facing, we'll better know how to handle it. And if it represents a form of test, we want to make the best choice possible.

The Traveler stands as a consciousness that transcends death and penetrates the veil that goes with the human body. It doesn't matter what you call that consciousness. It just is. The Traveler comes in as a consciousness that's here in the human form, subject to the limitations of being human. You can also look upon the Traveler as the consciousness that transcends all the limitations, including death. There's a place within you that knows that truth.

When you're loving whoever or whatever is present as much as you can, then you will eventually overcome whatever difficulties or challenges you're

facing. There's no condition that can stop loving. Loving is a fundamental truth. Loving knows no bounds or barriers. Love is never stopped. Love is present always.

Your soul is always loving and knows that your life purpose involves overcoming death. To the soul it's all one life --- a life of freedom and loving that transcends this world. So remember the loving as you experience the grief. Sadness and sorrow will not last, but love and joy will endure always.

# Bringing J-R to Russia

One day I was looking through some publications at the Lenin Library in Moscow. (The Lenin Library was the Soviet equivalent of the Library of Congress in Washington DC.) As I was leaving the library, I was stopped with "Your Ph.D. has to do with exact sciences. Why were you reading about St. Francis of Assisi? That's religious matter!" I was detained and not allowed to leave.

I was born in Moscow, the capital of Russia, the largest country in the world. Russia is twice as large as the United States. It spreads over 10 time zones. When I lived there, Russia was one of the 15 republics of the Soviet Union, or the USSR (the Union of the Soviet Socialist Republics). In Moscow, I grew up, got happily married, had a daughter, pursued a scientific career, and received a Ph.D. in science. I became an associate professor. My scientific research stirred such interest that I was offered all the financing to expand my research as I saw fit. All in all, my life in Russia was rich in loving, friendships, poetry, arts, beauty, and travels to many exotic places in USSR.

However, the Soviet Union was a totalitarian state. Anyone with or without a reason could be arrested and sent to prison or concentration camp. "Everything was forbidden, except for what was obligatory." Among the obligatory was militant atheism. Perhaps this example will give you a glimpse at what it was like. One day I was looking through some publications at the Lenin Library in Moscow. (The Lenin Library was the Soviet equivalent of the Library of Congress in Washington DC.) As I was leaving the library, I was stopped with "Your Ph.D. has to do with exact sciences. Why were you reading about St. Francis of Assisi? That's religious matter!" I was detained and not allowed to leave. Fortunately, a top scientific authority interceded and I was let go.

In time, living under the totalitarian regime had become unbearably suffocating for me. So I made a drastic decision to leave my native country.

At the time, Russia was behind the Iron Curtain. So nobody could leave the country without permission of the Soviet authorities. My struggle to get the permission took almost seven years. Finally, in February of 1975, my family and I were allowed to leave. We went to Western Europe and applied for American visas. Still, it was only several months later when we boarded a majestic Pan American plane to fly to New York that I first felt safe from the long tentacles of KGB—the Soviet secret police. In June 1975 we landed in New York, and then proceeded to Philadelphia.



## Bringing J-R to Russia

Once settled, I enlisted in the "English for Foreign Students" program at the University of Pennsylvania. A student there introduced me to Mario Morresi, and Mario in turn introduced me to MSIA. My English then was only good enough to read my scientific articles, which were mostly scientific symbols and formulas. So when I came to my first taped J-R seminar, by the time I made sense of a few words that I understood, the seminar was over. But I knew I was in the right place. Soon Fay Whitemountain told me about discourses, and I took to them like a duck to water. I was fortunate to have a lot of help from Larry Hamblen, a lawyer and MSIA minister, who volunteered to explain to me all the idioms in the discourses. It was such fun!

In September of 1975, J-R came to Philadelphia. I remember meeting him for the first time like it was yesterday. Right then and there it became my impossible dream to bring J-R, the Traveler, to Russia. Why impossible? Because Russia was quite isolated from the world and because militant atheism was strictly enforced.

How could I approach bringing J-R to Russia? First, I decided to smuggle J-R's books into Russia. But how? Being behind the Iron Curtain meant that all lines of communication with the outside world were totally controlled by the Soviet regime.

The opportunity presented itself when an Irishman in Philadelphia, who was keenly interested in the history of Russian ballet, asked me to connect him with someone in Moscow who could send him the materials that he wanted. I did. Now he was about to send some books to his new friend in Moscow. I immediately asked him to insert amongst the thick volumes he was sending, J-R's books, Inner Worlds of Meditation and The Sound Current. He agreed.

Logically, there was no way that J-R's books would escape relentless Soviet censorship because anything related to Spirit was ruthlessly censored out. Yet, I had great faith and to my delight, the books did get delivered to my former coauthor, professor of Moscow University, Basil Nalimov. Nalimov was a well-known mathematician and a remarkable man. He survived over 20 years of GULAG—Stalin's concentration camps. It turned out that at the time he was very interested in altered states of consciousness and had reviewed world literature on the subject. He wrote back that J-R's book on meditation was the best that he had ever come across.

The next step to implementing my dream came to me in 1980 when I listened to J-R's seminar, "Who are the False Teachers and Prophets?" In it J-R says that people asked him, "J-R, you have been all over the world, how come you have never been to Russia?" And J-R replies, "Professor has not invited me yet." For others, that sounded like one of J-R's jokes. But I experienced a huge surge of energy with it. I took it as a message that in order to enter the USSR, J-R needed a written invitation from within the country. And I was the one to get it. I needed to get in touch with Professor Nalimov to request it.

In September of 1975, J-R came to Philadelphia. I remember meeting him for the first time like it was yesterday. Right then and there it became my impossible dream to bring J-R, the Traveler, to Russia. Why impossible? Because Russia was quite isolated from the world and because militant atheism was strictly enforced.

It is hard to imagine today, but at that time, in order to speak on the phone with Moscow one had to call an AT&T operator and when the operator would manage to get a connection, they would call back. The process took a whole week and two MSIA ministers, Wendy Garthwaite and me. On the phone I let Professor Nalimov know—in a coded way—that J-R needed a written invitation. The professor got the message and J-R received the written invitation.

The time to go to Russia had not come yet. As my next step toward realizing my dream, I translated most of the first discourse into Russian and sent it to J-R as a gift. J-R wrote, "It's a wonderful translation!" I was looking ahead to the time after J-R visited Russia and returned to the USA. Discourses would help the people in Russia to maintain the connection with the Traveler.

Still Russia remained inaccessible for a number of years. Although Josef Stalin, the bloody dictator who ruled the entire Soviet Union for 30 years and who isolated it from the world, died in 1953, the isolation continued unabated. Stalin's militant atheism kept ruling the land.

In 1985, Mikhail Gorbachev, a new type of leader, came to power in the USSR, and he initiated many reforms. In 1988 Gorbachev ended the 70-year isolation of the country and invited foreigners into the Soviet Union. (For those interested: see an insightful book about Gorbachev by Gail Sheehy, *The Man Who Changed the World: The Lives of Mikhail Gorbachev*.)

J-R decided that he and John Morton would take 90 MSIAers on the first Russian trip. 92 people! That took me by surprise. I could not imagine how it would work. When I lived in Russia, every foreigner allowed into the country was followed every step watched.

The trip was announced and the preparation started. I was going to assist. Still I had to pay for the trip in full and I didn't have the money. John Morton suggested that I ask people to contribute to pay for my trip. It was extremely difficult for me to ask for money. It felt deeply humiliating for me, a former associate professor. I cried a lot. When I stopped crying and moved into action, I realized that I had no clue of what karma each person was dealing with in regard to money, in regard to Russia, and in regard to other factors. I learned to drop any expectations and move to freedom of spirit. Now inside of me I had the freedom for anyone to respond however they would. People's responses differed widely from, "I'm not paying for people's vacations" to "I'm happy to contribute. I myself would never go to Russia. Thank you for your courage to do that." One time a person in a wheelchair who dealt with a devastating disease asked me, "May I give you \$5? I want to be part of this trip." I was deeply touched.

Most contributions were rather small, which meant that I needed to ask for money from many people. I wondered why. The answer came one day when I opened somebody's envelope with a check and

suddenly I saw many hands holding up and supporting our trip. Oh, that's why it was so valuable to involve many people. That was building our support.

Each participant had to fill out a questionnaire in order to receive a Russian visa. As I did, a strong fear came over me, "What if the Soviets detain me?" You see, according to the Soviet law every former USSR citizen becomes a Soviet subject once he or she enters USSR, even if the person had become a citizen of another country. Of course, by that time I was an American citizen but it was a terrifying prospect to be detained and deprived of freedom in Russia. I told J-R about my concern. He suggested that I contact the U.S. State Department in Washington DC and the American Embassy in Moscow, and follow their instructions. I did.

Our trip was sponsored by the IIWP, the Institute for Individual and World Peace. They told me that there was a glitch in getting the Russian visas. I was asked to call my friends in the Soviet Union and ask them to do whatever they could to help us get the visas. I had no clue how any of my friends could influence the Soviet bureaucratic machine. Still, I made a few calls. At this time, MSIA had one more minister who came from Russia, Nelly Tsvina. Nelly did not go on the Russian trip, but she received a similar call from the IIWP and she made many calls to her friends in the USSR. Within a couple of days, all the visas came through—all the Russian visas except mine.

Before going to Russia, we did some interesting work in Germany. Here is a bit of history to set the stage. After being defeated in World War II, Germany was divided into East and West. West Germany was controlled by the Allies-- the USA, Great Britain, and France. The East was controlled by the Soviets. Berlin, the capital of Germany, was also divided into East and West. The tricky point was that Berlin was vulnerably located inside Soviet-occupied East Germany. West Berlin was supplied by the West through three corridors.

In 1948, the Soviets shut the corridors feeding West Berlin. Washington responded with the first massive airlift in history. Allied airplanes delivered food, coal and other supplies for two million West Berliners for about a year, until Stalin lifted the blockade.

The contrast between the prosperous West Berlin and the oppressed East Berlin caused East Berliners to flee to the west. The Soviets responded by surrounding West Berlin with a long, thick and tall concrete wall. They added several barbed-wire fences, etc. At first the wall seemed outrageous, ugly, and incongruent, but with time, it took on a strange permanence in people's minds.

When J-R suggested to our group that the wall would fall soon, many found it hard to believe. J-R specifically suggested that each of us spend time—individually—with the wall. He asked us to use in our creative imagination to place into the wall something that would in time destroy it. Some people placed imaginary worms. I put into the wall fast-multiplying concrete-crumbling microbes. I had such fun with that process that I kept walking along the wall way past the time when everyone had left. When I felt complete, it was time to find my way back to the hotel.

I was fluent in German so I just asked locals for directions to the hotel where we stayed. On the way back to the hotel I chatted with a few Berliners. Once they learned that I was an American, born and raised in Russia, they would ask me question after question about German-Russian relations. WWII was still fresh in the memory of the Germans, as it was in the memory of the Russians.

The next day after we visited Berlin Wall John Morton did a seminar for the group. He told us that we were about to enter the areas of heavy negativity. John explained that it was of paramount importance that we keep joy and peace in our hearts. That would be our best protection from negativity.

The very next day we got a taste of what John was talking about. As our bus passed through "Checkpoint Charlie" and entered East Berlin, we were struck by the sharp contrast between the thriving West Berlin and the drab East Berlin. The psychic power in East Berlin was so heavy and oppressive that our people started feeling sleepy. They were being knocked unconscious by the heavy negativity. I had set a strong intention to stay conscious throughout. After all, I lived under the totalitarian regime. I knew what it was like. Still, at one point, I found it very difficult to stay conscious. I chanted my initiatory tone with the whole power of my Soul. Inwardly, I was holding on to my tone as if it was my only access to breath, to oxygen. At that moment, I glimpsed out the window—we were passing by the Soviet Embassy in East Berlin. Fortunately, soon we were back at our hotel in West Berlin.

The time to fly to Russia was quickly approaching but my visa still hadn't arrived. John Morton told me that he had already been in touch with Chuck Millar, an MSIA minister in San Francisco. John asked Chuck to get my Russian visa at the Soviet Consulate in San Francisco and hand-deliver it to a pilot who was flying to Frankfurt, Germany. From there, my visa would be delivered to West Berlin. John asked me if I would be willing to pick up my visa at the airport in West Berlin. You bet!

I came to the airport and the visa was not there. Six planes came from Frankfurt to Berlin and my visa still had not arrived. While I was waiting for my visa at the airport, the German man whom John gave me as my contact shared some of his life story. I shared with him a bit about my life. It was a heart-to-heart exchange and we even dropped a few tears over his life under Hitler and mine under Stalin. Meanwhile, the day ended and no more planes were coming from Frankfurt to Berlin. and my new friend's shift was over. Before he went home, he told the officer who would take his place about me and my visa.

Next morning when I came to the freight section of the airport where I was to pick up my visa, it was empty. I kept shouting in English and in German, "Is there anyone around?" No response. Finally, a man appeared. He was running toward me with a large envelope, shouting joyously, "Your visa, your visa is here!" and he gave me a beautiful hug.

On August 1, 1988 we flew from Berlin to Moscow.

On August 1, 1988, J-R, the Traveler, entered Russia. My impossible dream became reality.

John-Roger, John Morton, plus 90 other MSIAers spent time in five Soviet Republics: Russia, Ukraine, Georgia, Azerbaijan and Armenia. But that is a whole other story...

I raise my glass—with vodka, of course—to the health and happiness of everyone who went on the first Russian trip and to everyone who supported it.

## INITIATION

If you are just starting the Soul Awareness Discourses, Discourse #1 explains initiation into the Sound Current. You may choose to study the Discourses with the intention to be initiated on this path, or to simply read them as information. If you do choose to study toward initiation, the Traveler works with you more closely, and you may notice a greater spiritual awareness in your own consciousness as this work goes on.

If you are studying toward initiation, you need to write and mail a letter to the Traveler that this is your intention. If you have written and mailed your intention to the Traveler, you can apply for initiation when you have completed Discourse 24.

## THE MSIA MINISTRY

The MSIA ministry is for initiates of the Traveler who are called inwardly to serve the spirit of their hearts.

Service may be in any form, from volunteering for the Church to assisting people in need or organizations that serve those people, and anything in between. The only requirement is that the ministry is active and done regularly.

MSIA ministers may perform services, like marriages, that clergy of other denominations are authorized to do as long as they comply with the laws of the locality in which they serve.

## WRITING TO J-R & JOHN

Sometimes people reading Discourses, especially those studying toward initiation, want to write to John Morton or John-Roger. Writing often helps you let go of a troubling situation and open more to the Traveler's assistance inwardly.

As soon as you write to John Morton or John-Roger, they get the message on the spiritual levels, and they do what Spirit allows. Then, to let go of the situation in your consciousness, you burn or mail your letter. Whether you burn or mail what you wrote, you may find that you get your answers on the inner levels, sometimes very quickly. You may also experience greater calm, clarity, or peace, which can help you go through whatever challenges you face.

We suggest that you place the situation in the Light, ask for clarification during s.e.'s, dreams, etc., and then look for the answers within you. Often reading a Discourse or listening to an MSIA tape (either at home or at a seminar) will provide keys to assist you in handling your situation. You can also refer to any of the numerous books by J-R and John to find information that relates to what you are dealing with. These two have shared so much with us over the years, and we encourage you to send your letters via e-mail, using these addresses:

There simply may be no need for a physical reply, or there may be no answer available to you at the time you write.

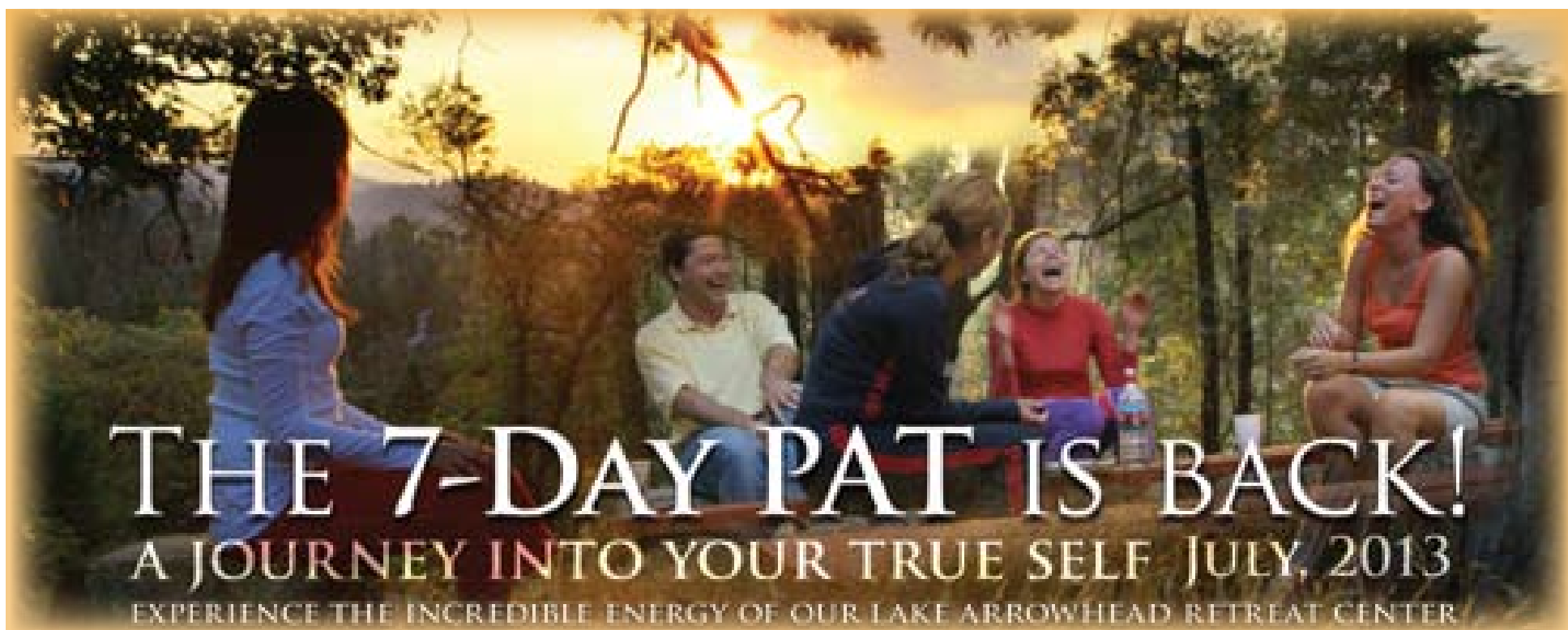

# THE MYSTICAL TRAVELER IS ONE WHO KNOWS

-PART 1 OF A JOHN-ROGER INTERVIEW

J-R: I'm working in other realms of Light consciousness with people who are scientifically called "asleep."

IN: Which is what?

J-R: Which is spiritual awakening in the other dimensions. The more we're able to traverse these levels of consciousness, the more real the other dimensions become. It's a trick, in one sense of the word, because you might ask if anybody could do it. Everybody IS doing it--not CAN they do it. They are!

INNERVISIONS: *You describe the consciousness under which you work as the Mystical Traveler Consciousness. Could you give us a definition of what that is and how it works?*

J-R: That's four years of answers right there, but let me see what I can do in "25 words or less." The vocabulary approach to that which we call the Mystical Traveler is that as soon as we define the word "Mystical," we're halfway there. "Traveler" is one who moves, who travels physically, for instance. For the word "Mystical," we could substitute words like "Spiritual Traveler" or "Light Traveler" and we'd be saying the same thing.

To speak in terms of Christ or God isn't popular with many segments of society because it's been so institutionalized through "churchianity." Yet that concept is precisely what we are working with. People get hung up rapidly on words. In fact, some people won't let you in the door unless you have a college degree. They want to know what it is you're working with, so we give them this term, which happens to be very difficult to define.

The word "mystic" has classically meant "one who knows." The Mystical Traveler is one who knows what that consciousness is and where it's going. It is utilized and anchored through my body, but it is not necessarily the body. It is a reference point here on the planet for that. It's an energy source. The body is for other people's consciousnesses. The Mystical Traveler Consciousness needs no reference point. It is truth—a pure absolute truth. And truth is not dependent on anything. It just is.

The difficulty I have down in this mundane level is to get the vocabulary words to match that essence of truth as much as they possibly can; and, believe me, that's a full-time job, because as soon as you open your mouth, you've inherited a lot of errors immediately. For example, the German people might not understand English; so there are errors there and we always have that gap in communication. But the Traveler Consciousness communicates in a force field called Spirit or Soul. There are very few errors in the spiritual communication in Spirit. But when we talk about the physical communication in Spirit, YOU have to check it out. YOU have to decide. It becomes beholden upon the other person to validate that experience.

IN: *Does the experience of the communication take place on levels other than direct physical communication between you and whomever else you might be in contact with?*

J-R: Oh, sure. I've been working consciously with people for, say, 10 or 15 years, and I may not see them until maybe a year from now. So it's not dependent upon the physical body to work with them, but there must be a body on every level that this Traveler Consciousness works through, and this is the physical. But it is less than one tenth of one per cent here in the physical.

IN: *When you say that you anchor the consciousness here, does that mean that there's a focus for this consciousness other than a physical body? I mean, I know when I am here that my focus is primarily my body and head. But if the consciousness wasn't within your body, is there a place where it knows itself?*

J-R: It knows itself in truth, or we would say, "God." It knows itself in God. I could forget a lot of things on this planet, but there is one thing I have never been able to forget, and it's that I hold this consciousness of the Mystical Traveler. I never forget that. At night while we're supposedly sleeping, I don't. I know that.

IN: *What are you doing?*

J-R: I'm working in other realms of Light consciousness with people who are scientifically called "asleep."

IN: *Which is what?*

J-R: Which is spiritual awakening in the other dimensions. The more we're able to traverse these levels of consciousness, the more real the other dimensions become. It's a trick, in one sense of the word, because you might ask if anybody could do it. Everybody IS doing it--not CAN they do it. They are! But they would say they had a dream or they were asleep. In this level, the monitors of our consciousness--the mind, the emotions, and the body--are quieted; and in this quietness we lose realization here, but we open to the body on the next level, which we might call the astral, causal, mental, or etheric body. By focusing our attention there, we become aware of that existence, and we can function consciously while there. Now, the big difficulty—and there's always a catch—is how do you get the information back in this physical body to know that you've had these experiences? And the answer to that is ... practice, practice, practice.

IN: *Practice what?*

J-R: Spiritual exercises that reach what are called "out of body" experiences, so that they don't become accidental or haphazard in their approach, but rather become a methodology where you can say, "If I do these things—a, b, c, d—then e, f, g follow, not only as a natural course, but also as a form of energy."

IN: *How can we get more of a grasp on what you mean by "other levels of consciousness" and "other bodies," if we haven't directly experienced them?*

J-R: Well, if you haven't directly experienced it, there is no way that you can know it. But you can fantasize it, imagine it, mock it up, intellectually discuss it, run the presumption of existence—but you don't KNOW until you've had the experience.

IN: *It's really hard to aspire towards something that one hasn't had enough experience with. It's a hell of a thing to make a commitment to something you don't know anything about.*

J-R: That's true, and I wouldn't advise someone to make that commitment based upon someone else's experience. But make the commitment based upon your level of ex-

perience and experimentation, right here where you are. For example, if you said to me, "John-Roger, there's a flying saucer outside in the parking lot," I'd probably say, "Okay, that's fine." That's your level of experience, but it doesn't match mine. If somebody else came in and said, "There's a strange object outside, but I don't know whether it's a flying saucer, flying teacup, or just a fork," I would then get up and go look physically to validate it for myself. Once I saw it, if nobody else saw it, I couldn't care less. I have seen something that I have called this, and that validates its existence. Labeling it "inner vision" or "outer vision" would depend on how many people see it. If a million see it and 50 million don't, the 50 million--being the majority--would call the rest of them crazy and lock them up. I'm not sure they are crazy. This brings up the question, "Are there flying saucers?" And I say, people are seeing something, whatever term you want to call it. People ask, "Does it exist?" And it's like who's to say what that level is? For those who have been in it, you're darn right it exists. And for those who haven't, you're darn right it doesn't.

IN: *So, in other words, validate your own experience.*

J-R: Absolutely.

J-R: Well, if you haven't directly experienced it, there is no way that you can know it. But you can fantasize it, imagine it, mock it up, intellectually discuss it, run the presumption of existence—but you don't KNOW until you've had the experience.

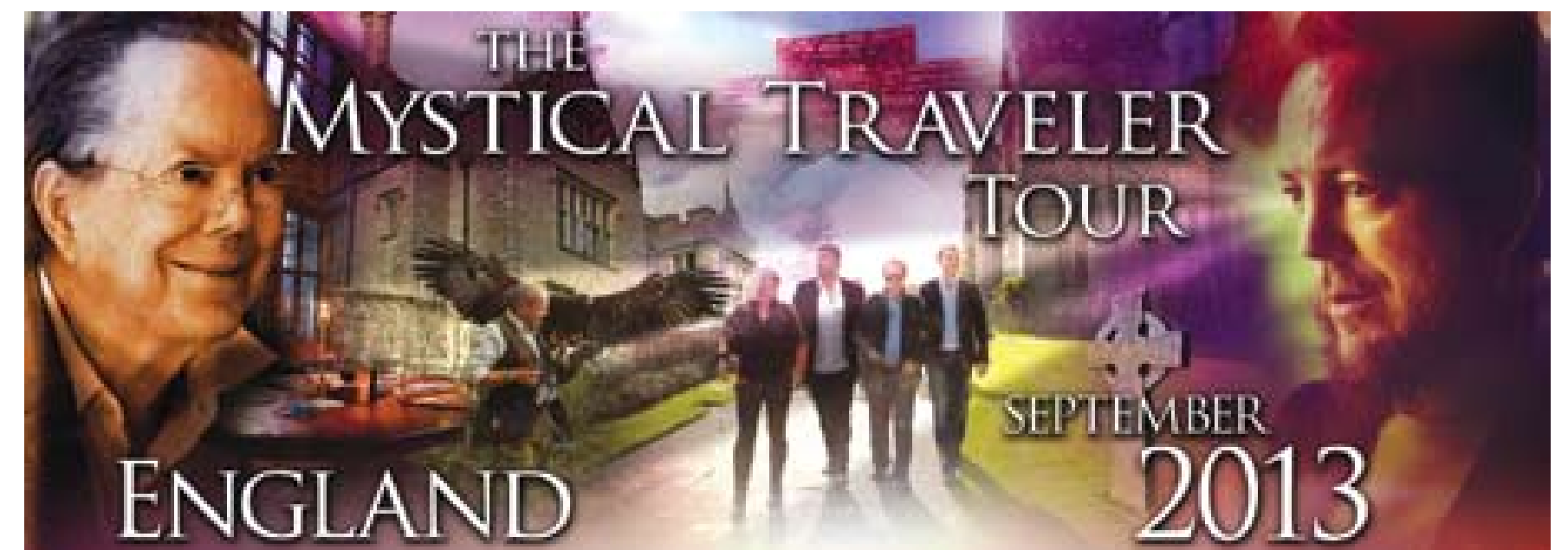
