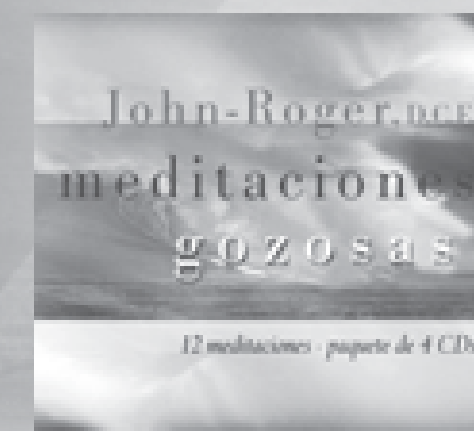

EARTHQUAKES

INSIDE AND OUTSIDE

All earth changes are positive, when looked at from a higher consciousness . . . earthquakes can be a vehicle for people to release themselves from the bondage of their negative thinking and the karma that has locked them in.

There has been some concern and some speculation about earthquakes in recent months. And because California tends to be “earthquake country,” there is often concern among Californians about earthquakes. There have been many, many predictions by various psychics about future quakes of major and minor proportions. This seems to be a good time to take a look at earthquakes and at their causes and results.

All earth changes are positive, when looked at from a higher consciousness. When you can look at it from the point of view of the evolutionary process of the planet, it ceases to appear tragic, and it becomes clear that earthquakes can be a vehicle for people to release themselves from the bondage of their negative thinking and the karma that has locked them in. Often, when the action has completed itself, people find that they are much freer to lift into new consciousnesses.

Earthquakes are funny. When you're standing on what you think is “terra firma” and, all of a sudden, “it throws up on you,” you don't have a whole lot of reference points left. The emotion that goes with that is pretty hard to place. The upset and anxiety, and sometimes terror, that accompanies the action of an earthquake, can indeed shake you up on a lot of levels... and it can shake you free of negativity and into a freer consciousness. Now the trick is not to get caught up in the disturbance but to let it go as soon as the earthquake is over. If you can choose to participate in the life stream of what is happening, you will experience an earthquake in the moment that it is happening, observe it, and not get caught in the panic of it.

Think what would happen if all the rescue and emergency people reacted in panic, instead of doing their jobs. That might be disaster. When an earthquake hits, your best approach is to do the things physically that are appropriate to do. If you don't know what that is, instructions about earthquake procedures are available from your local fire department or other public-awareness organizations. Beyond that, what you can do is move inwardly into a place of calm and Light. Focus the Light into the area where you are. Become a channel for Light energy. Become stable within yourself. Shift immediately from the “panic” of your lower consciousness into the steadiness of the higher consciousness.

The first law of Spirit is acceptance. And that is an important concept in the face of an earthquake. Since there seems to be nothing you can do about it on this

physical level, one thing you can do inwardly is move quickly into an attitude of acceptance and calm. Most earthquakes that we experience are not of major proportions, and it is more the fear of what might happen that causes the panic, rather than what is happening. And, yes, we understand that they can cause severe damage as many quakes have in the past.

There are some physical reasons for earthquakes that we can look at. One is that the earth changes its shape slightly (from round to, say, egg-shaped) and the shift causes pressures in the earth and creates a slipping motion, which creates a wave-like effect that we call an earthquake. If you can see with the higher vision, you can see an earthquake coming. It comes through the ground very much like a wave...if you were an earthquake surfer, you'd probably want to grab your board and go for it.


Beyond the physical, an earthquake can often be reflective of an etheric shift in the energies of the earth, which are manifested on the physical. The etheric or magnetic poles of the earth are in a process of shifting in order to become aligned with a newer, higher energy that is coming into being on the planet. Those changes that have taken place in the etheric must be matched by the physical changes. It can happen gradually, which is evident in the many small quakes that we have had in the last several years and still have daily in California. The crust of the earth is shifting to match the etheric shift.

There are metaphysicians that say earthquakes are caused (or contributed to) by the conscious-

ness of the people in the area where the quake occurs. Many years ago there was a religious/spiritual group in California whose leader predicted a major earthquake for the California area. I knew many people in this group, and some of them called to warn me of the quake and to ask me if I wanted to participate in their “mass exodus” to Colorado where it would be “safe.” I declined their offer to move...and their reaction was not too kind. They did, however, make the move to Colorado...and some months later there was a major earthquake in Colorado, where earthquakes were relatively rare. I wouldn't swear that their consciousness of fear created the earthquake, but I do know that putting negative energy into something can add “fuel to the fire” and help it to come about. You would be furthest ahead, when you think of earthquakes, just to place the whole action into the Light, see Light permeating the formation of the earth in your area, and lift above the fear. That is a way to be of service and to be responsible for yourself within this area.

It is also true that many of the psychics who predict earthquakes are tapping into their own inner levels of disturbance and turmoil and are projecting that out onto a more general action. There was a woman in San Francisco many years ago who predicted a major earthquake, and many people moved out of the area because of her prediction. And it happened that, very close to the time for which she had predicted the earthquake, she had a heart attack and died. She had accurately predicted an “earthquake”

but had missed that it was her personal change that she was perceiving.

Many people have earthquake dreams and become greatly concerned that it is a precognitive dream, indicating great disaster ahead. If you have an earthquake dream, you might want to consider it in a symbolic way, and look for the changes that may be about to occur in your own personal life and environment. You might want to look for changes in jobs, relationships, home, etc. Earthquake dreams are not necessarily indicative of an outer, physical earthquake.

When you look at change as an aspect of evolution, then it is positive. So you can look at the overall action of the earthquake as positive, and you can use the movement of energy to activate movement within your own energy fields. You can also use it to uplift you and “push” you into new patterns. You might experience a lot of physical things around the time of an earthquake. You might experience dizziness, nausea, rampant fear patterns, illnesses that can’t be logically explained, diarrhea, etc. That is your physical body being affected by the same energies that are affecting the earth. It’s okay. It can be a time re-evaluate and take a look at the patterns you have been stuck in and locked into. It’s a time of change.

Often an earthquake will be time of change on many, many levels: personal, relationship, career and employment, social, economic, political, religious, etc. These things are not unrelated they do not exist independently of one another. When changes are precipitated, people tend to take more serious look at themselves and their environment and become more selective of those things that are lasting and real and those things that are not.

In Chicago many years ago, there was a disaster through fire, and a large department store burned to the ground. The owner took the opportunity to “make all things new.” He rebuilt his store on the same site, but the new store was more dynamic and larger, with a reorganized administration and, consequently, was much more appealing to the consumer market.

In California, after the major earthquake of the 1800s, it was found out that the mayor of a city was involved in a lot of graft and dishonesty. The political machine was overthrown, and the city government was rebuilt on a more solid and honest basis.

In a major earthquake in the Los Angeles area in 1971, there was a feeling of camaraderie and mu-

tual support that was created between “establishment” and “hippie” that did much to heal that gap and create good feelings on all sides. People on both sides moved out of a heavy judgmental consciousness and moved into a lot more understanding and loving tolerance.

A young friend of mine, at the time of the “Los Angeles earthquake,” said, “Well, people in Los Angeles put a lot of things in motion, created a lot of karma, and then they got to eat it.” In a general way, that could be true. In the larger sense, the planetary logos, the Spirit that governs and activates the planet, perceived that time in 1971 as a good time “to shake things up” and allow the opportunity for reevaluation and change. There is nothing negative about change. And the earth is changing and evolving according to its law and its destiny. Things are on schedule, and there are no catastrophes from the higher consciousness. Every 25,000 years or so, the planet moves through a cycle of return. The great spiritual forces that were present 25,000 years ago are again present today, and the earth must shift itself to match the higher energies and frequencies of Light that are present.

Make the things that you work in, work for you. So when you find yourself in positions of radical change and great upheaval, make that work for you. If you fight it and resist it, you will cause yourself unnecessary turmoil and confusion. Go with it. Find that neutral space within that is able to flow with whatever action is present for you in any moment, and just go with it. If you don’t like what’s happening, just close your eyes for a moment and center yourself within yourself. Look deep within and find where that disturbance you perceive outside of yourself exists within yourself... and clear it from within. Then you’ll find that the outer disturbance no longer upsets you, because it no longer exists inside of you. Create a safe place for yourself where you love yourself, no matter what, and then, from that safe space, reach out to others and, by demonstration, assist them to create a safe space for themselves inside of themselves. Then that safe space can be shared. And you will find that there is only love inside of you for yourself, and outside of you for everyone else. It seems obvious that earth changes (quakes) can be perceived through attitude, even though the physical reality is in a chaotic state of change. Your change is not synonymous with evil or “end-of-days.” It can also signal a new beginning.

To all those who have been affected by Hurricane Sandy my Light and love are with you, as are the prayers of the MSIA staff.

I am looking into all this very closely.

You know you can always find me in your heart.

I am always with you, — J-R

Hi. My area is faring pretty well. However, when I woke up this morning I realized that food and water supplies may be low, and that I should get some.

In general there are many areas in lower Manhattan that were hard hit and remain without heat, power and other services. They are slowly being restored. Most ministers have been doing OK physically. Some who could use extra light are [lists names].

The other boroughs by the water—particularly Queens, Brooklyn, and Staten Island—were very hard hit. Some were devastated.

In Long Island, Nassau, and Suffolk counties there were a lot areas where homes were destroyed and remain without power, etc.

Please send Light to my niece who is there.

Many in Connecticut, Westchester and upstate New York remain without power.

New Jersey is among the hardest hit: trees downed, power out, and major flooding and devastation near shore and river areas. Ministers and families there could use extra light.

My brother and his wife and their community by the ocean need Light. They are in a devastated area. Homes and boats have been destroyed. My niece and family are OK but without power.

In general it is amazing that while there was major property destruction and power outages there were relatively few lives lost.

The NYC marathon was canceled.

Transportation still needs recovery.

A number of hospitals are down.

Our MSIA:

*Opening

Within*



In the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness,

we are opening up to the One within who knows us very intimately. We don't create or promote some hierarchy like, "Our master's better than yours," or "Our line is better than your line," or anything like that. We're just working with what it is. It's a line of the Christ that we're working through. It's an anointing of the Spirit.

Jesus the Christ is the head of MSIA and directs this Movement spiritually. It's not something that's caught up in religious institutions or beliefs. In MSIA, we embrace Mohammed, Buddha and whoever else has been a friend to the Soul and who awakens us to the Soul. There have been many people on the planet who held great spiritual powers.

In MSIA, we embrace the truth where we find it. So whoever speaks in truth is one we would listen to. Often, we end up listening to one another. We hear witnessing and testifying to God through one another. In that way, each one of us becomes a witness as a friend of God, as one who in that moment of our living truth can speak and act for God in the flesh. That's how we practice the movement of spiritual inner awareness. We each have our own divine leadership within. We are our own minister, and we can minister to one another through light and love.

In MSIA, we embrace the truth where we find it. So whoever speaks in truth is one we would listen to. Often, we end up listening to one another. We hear witnessing and testifying to God through one another. In that way, each one of us becomes a witness as a friend of God, as one who in that moment of our living truth can speak and act for God in the flesh. That's how we practice the movement of spiritual inner awareness. We each have our own divine leadership within. We are our own minister, and we can minister to one another through light and love.

It isn't necessarily that when we are anointed of God's power and blessing that we go out and do things that are well-known and bring us great popularity or anything like that. It can be that our service becomes rather quiet, perhaps silent and even mysterious. At times, very few, maybe only God, may realize that someone is anointed of this spiritual power and blessing. I look at that power and that blessing, when it takes place in the fullness of what it is, as a christening. That's a literalness of the meaning of the Christ.

I often get invited to speak from my own experience, and I do that because I'm asked. It's a primary aspect of my ministry. Spiritually, I have that willingness inside of me like a bird that knows it needs to sing. I need to express what I know about the Spirit. My life is dedicated to that. It's my first and primary dedication.

There have been various people on the planet who have taken on a spiritual mantle. By that I mean they've taken on an ability and a blessing that was divinely inspired and ordained so that they were able to impart to others a spiritual teaching. Perhaps they demonstrated spiritual gifts like healings or doing miracles of various kinds. However, it might not necessarily have looked like a ministry or that they were the ones in our midst who were doing the religious practice. They may have appeared rather ordinary, such as writers or carpenters.

It isn't necessarily that when we are anointed of God's power and blessing that we go out and do things that are well-known and bring us great popularity or anything like that. It can be that our service becomes rather quiet, perhaps silent and even mysterious. At times, very few, maybe only God, may realize that someone is anointed of this spiritual power and blessing. I look at that power and that blessing, when it takes place in the fullness of what it is, as a christening. That's a literalness of the meaning of the Christ.

Sometimes people ask, "This name MSIA, it sounds kind of like messiah. Are you trying to say this organization has something to do with the messiah?" I say, "Yes." What we're doing is about the messiah.

What is the messiah? It's something that is of the Spirit in a particular way that we become lifted and anointed in that power. The messiah is our destiny. We're all destined to become saints and to

become holy. That's really our true nature already. We're already holy. We're already sanctified because we are of God.

Somebody once said, "God doesn't make junk." That's a clear true way of expressing the movement of spiritual inner awareness. When we're dealing with what it is, the messiah or the Christ within, we're not dealing with junk. We're not dealing with waste or something that's bad or negative. We're dealing with something that's ultimately and eternally true and inherently good.

In MSIA, we don't have any issues about where you worship, how you worship or what you claim as your religion or your faith. We don't have a particular denomination that in some way is exclusive to other denominations. Our approach works so that people who are practicing as Roman Catholics, Protestants, Jews, Buddhists, or any other religion, including atheists can participate.

I remember early on when John-Roger would speak to MSIA gatherings that he would talk about the brotherhood of mankind and the fatherhood of God. We all have a relationship as human beings to our divine nature that is a very simple one. It runs across all the conditions that are in the world, including religious, geographic, cultural, gender or any other condition or circumstance. What we're doing in MSIA has a way of transcending those conditions. We are to honor each person's own conditions as best we can so that where you come from and what you're dealing with are honored.

One of the ways we honor you is when we say, "Take care of yourself so you can help take care of others." That second part, "help take care of others," is really tied to the first part. They go together. If you want to help take care of others, you need to first take care of yourself.

Our MSIA:

Opening to the Messiah Within

(Continuing)

What does pain and suffering have to do with good?

It has to do with learning. Realizing our divine nature sometimes has to do with going through certain kinds of experiences that are difficult and challenging, including that they might be painful. Yet, in every experience we will always find something we can learn and for our greater good.



We find that when we participate and practice who we are spiritually, we become more caring. In truth, we're always caring beings. It's when we lose sight of our divinity that we would step out of caring. At those times, we might forget that we're caring or how to care for others. So we put that message there as a precept. It's a guideline that means that as you live your life, make sure you take care of yourself always. Taking care of yourself has a way of allowing and giving you the ability to help take care of others.

We're also saying that if you don't take care of yourself, you really have no business even attempting to take care of somebody else. When someone who's sick or disturbed is not caring for themselves and they're attempting to care for somebody else, they tend to give whatever is disturbed or diseased over to somebody else. So it's very important for us to take care of ourselves so that we can help care for others in a manner that is for the highest good of all concerned.

It's also important that we don't hurt ourselves and we don't hurt others. You might think that when we say, "Take care of yourself so you can help take care of others," it would be understood that you wouldn't hurt yourself or others. However, I find that at times we need to be reminded about that too. We need to remember that we are not to be hurtful to ourselves or anyone else.

You might wonder, "Why do things happen where people hurt one another? Why is there suffering? If God is really good and loving, then what's going on in this world that there is pain and suffering?"

My experience is that the inherent nature of our creator is good. So all things and all of us in God's creation are good. What does pain and suffering have to do with good? It has to do with learning. Realizing our divine nature sometimes has to do with going through certain kinds of experiences that are difficult and challenging, including that they might be painful. Yet, in every experience we will always find something we can learn and for our greater good.

In this world, we as co-creators with God are allowed to create lesser good for the purpose of demonstrating how the psychic-material law of cause and effect works completely for our upliftment, learning and growth. It works reflectively such that for every action there is an equal and opposite or opposing reflecting action that demonstrates by results what has been created, promoted and allowed. When the action is of the highest good, then the highest good is the resulting action in reverse and reflection. By law, what is of higher good comes as the ultimate result. And what is of the lesser good comes as the temporary result that cannot last or endure to the end. Grace is loving God and thereby loving all of God's creation. When loving God is the intention, then it follows that in the end God's mercy and restoration of the highest good is the result. Whatever is less than good is rendered to the nothingness from which it came, and only good going to highest good remains.

There are three ground rules in MSIA that John-Roger defined, two of which I already noted:

1) Take care of yourself so you can help take care of others, and 2) Don't hurt yourself and don't hurt others. The third ground rule is, "Use everything for your upliftment, learning and growth." I add, "Because we CAN." Everything we experience can be used for our upliftment, learning and growth. It's our choice in each moment to shift our attitude to look for the greater good, the learning and how we can grow.

Even when we don't think that something could possibly be of any value, that there's nothing we could learn or gain, that's not ever true. If you think that, or someone else thinks that, you might invite yourself or them to ask, "Is there a value in this? Is there something we can learn from this?" I find the answer always is, "Yes." We can grow and shift through every experience so that we gain.

There is a sacred aspect to what we're doing here that calls upon us to render ourself nothing. So we have a discipline that I consider asks for all. It calls upon us to give up everything but not to any other form. Our discipline is not about giving up everything to me, John-Roger or MSIA the organization. It's about giving up everything to God. We say, "Let go and let God." Your commitment ends up being focused within you. Your commitment is between you and God. That's how this movement is done.

There isn't a way for any one of us to demonstrate in an outer way how we're sanctified and holy. Our sanctification is done inwardly. So our worship and our practice take place inwardly. That's where that word inner comes in. Instead of calling this movement the movement of spiritual awareness, there's the inner part that gives us direction. So we are the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness.

Not too many things having to do with MSIA are of the outer material world. We don't have great edifices. We don't have a lot of rituals. We do have some practices, but they're more or less what work to bring us together in fellowship to God. Coming together in worship works for the greater good. There is a purpose in being together as two or more who are gathered. When we do, a presence comes in that's very holy and sacred. In the process of gathering and sharing together in that holy presence, it can be very humbling to reveal ourselves. Sometimes people look upon that process as terrifying. Some folks fear revealing themselves completely of all the things they've done, thought, felt or had happen to them. Yet that can be a very healing and strengthening process. So we encourage it.

We have a PTS course that we call the Master of Spiritual Science. It's not just about a graduate level education, which it is. It's a class from our seminary, Peace Theological Seminary and College of Philosophy. Along with the formality of homework, there's a practice taught in the class of how to work with the teachings that we have. But the class is really about how we're opening ourself up to the Spiritual Master within.

I call it the Spiritual Master because eventually there's something about the Spirit that becomes singular. Great teachers have spoken about the singularity of spirit. When we make our eyes



single, the road becomes straight and narrow. When we bring ourself to God, there's one eye, not a pair of eyes. There's one reality, not a dual reality.

Although we can perceive the psychomaterial world with a sense of duality, with contrasts and opposites, the reality of Spirit is there is no opposition. In Spirit, all things are balanced and integrated in harmonious relationship. God is not opposed to itself. When we realize our true nature, we realize that we no longer have opposition. We no longer have againstness or separation.

In the Master's class, we use a process for moving through those things that we have held against ourself, the things that we practiced or conditioned ourselves as separation. The process is a reintegration with the Soul, which is that aspect of God that individualizes itself in each person.

The Soul has a being level. Like a person is a human being, the Soul is a spiritual being. When we come into a relationship with that presence of our spiritual being, our Soul, something quite magnificent goes on so that we take on our mastership. We take on the level of the master within who knows, understands, and loves all. That is the practice of the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness – to learn to love all as God loves all which we call unconditional loving.

Jesus the Christ is a great demonstration of unconditional loving. Babies are too because we come into this world in a very innocent state. Babies have a way of expressing to us that original innocence and purity. They demonstrate a powerful presence of our spiritual nature.

When we are born, we come into a body as a soul. What makes a body alive is the divine spark within it. The presence of the Soul is an individualized aspect of that divine spark. It is a great blessing to have that contact, to be in the same room with someone who's wide open to their soul the way a baby is.

God creates us in His image which is not the same thing as the divine source. A human being is not God in the fullness and absoluteness of God. A human being is an image, the way a photo, painting or reflection in a pond can be an image. The image can give us a good sense of who we are as God, but the image is not the true source that is God.

What we're working with in MSIA reflects a range of being connected to our soul. We really don't ever do it entirely in the body. What we teach is how to move out of the body consciously to that place in Spirit where we can be fully aware of ourselves as a soul. We call that Soul Awareness. We also call it Soul Travel. It is something we teach in particular that is rather unique to MSIA, not that it isn't taught elsewhere in some form. However, our focus on Soul Awareness is very direct.

How do we contact the Soul? How do we bring Soul Awareness present? Very little of it do we do in the body. For the most part we do it out of the body. That process we often refer to as Spiritual Exercise. That's the primary practice in the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness. It's an exercise that is toward the Spirit into the Soul Consciousness.

We have a particular way that we do Spiritual Exercise where we refer to the names of God that we're focusing upon. We call the names, sometimes outwardly as with the Ani Hu chant. More often, we chant the names of God inwardly because that contact, when it's done in its fullness, is an inner contact. It's an inner directed awareness to the Soul. Spiritual Exercises are a way of calling to God. In MSIA, we're learning how to do it in a very direct way.

It's not just that we learn to call to God. We also learn to pay attention when God answers. The more powerfully we can call to God, the more powerfully God can answer our calls. Some people who have been involved in MSIA for a while still don't realize that the greater part of Spiritual Exercise is listening to God's answers. So in case you need to be reminded, it's very important that you pay attention to what God is revealing to you through your Spiritual Exercise. To know more fully the truth about MSIA and the messiah within, ask God. Ask that One who lives and dwells within you, who is your personal, eternally and unconditionally loving guide. You don't need me or anyone else in a body to do that for you. Ask God to reveal it for you, to reveal the truth of your being as a soul who is one with God.

Humanitarian Aid Engineer and MSIA Minister Returns from Kyrgyzstan

Bill Bickerton has just returned from yet another trip overseas doing what he loves best – helping people out in third world countries. (Bill has been a Minister with MSIA for more than 30 years.)

This time Bill has been based in Osh, the second largest city of Kyrgyzstan in central Asia, carrying out inspections and providing supervision and technical advice for a major international aid agency, on 50 engineering projects.

These projects included provision of clean drinking water from bores or mountain springs; rehabilitation of open channel farm irrigation systems, school classrooms, medical clinics, and a bridge; reroofing of a cultural center; building school sports facilities and concrete walls to minimize flood damage to a school and medical clinic; and installing new 220 volt power grids.

Bill says that these are excellent projects that are jointly funded by the international agency, local government and the village. The work is carried out by the men and women of the village with technical support and supervision provided by the agency. This concept of course gives the villagers a sense of ownership, thus ensuring efficient expenditure of the available funds and ongoing maintenance of the project from within their own resources.

Many of the facilities that are being rehabilitated have not operated since Kyrgyzstan gained independence from Russia in 1991. For all these years the people in many villages have been drinking polluted water, simply because they did not have the funds, resources or expertise to repair broken-down systems. A broad range of illnesses have been identified as a direct result of this, and the deficiencies are most evident amongst the children.

Bill says that this is the very best and most efficient concept for providing aid and assistance. The projects are low-cost and high impact. A good example of this is the situation where an outlay of \$3,000 to \$4,000 will provide clean drinking water for hundreds and in some cases thousands of people.

The spinoff benefits are amazing, and most important of all are the improvement in health of the village kids and of course more time for children to study and do their homework.

In many villages children are the main water carriers and small girls and boys can spend as much as two or three hours a day walking long distances carrying buckets of water from a mountain spring or other water source. Of course the tendency is to drink heavily polluted farm irrigation water which is shared with animals, rather than carry water for long distances – sometimes as much as three or four (or more) kilometers every day.



These new or rehabilitated systems that have been provided pipe water from the clean water source, often six or seven kilometers away, into the village. Public access taps are provided on a 200 meter grid within the village. This means that the women and children do not have to carry water more than 100 meters.

In many cases the water is available in the village on a time schedule – say one half of the village in the morning and the other half in the afternoon. This is strictly controlled by the village leader(s) and in so doing eliminates the potential for conflict and argument. This is particularly applicable where water from a common source is shared by more than one village.

Although it is the end of summer in Kyrgyzstan many villages are in the mountains above or close to the snow line. Access to these villages is extremely difficult and the “roads” would compare with the worst anywhere in the world.

Inspections in one region took ten days to complete and in that time Bill and his group travelled 1,500 kilometres on terrible roads, in

many cases, a single lane bench clinging to the steep sides of the mountains with snow above us and a deep river ravine below.

Bill said that accommodation in these locations is “not real flash” but he always has his swag and plenty of muesli bars with him.

He has worked in this business for many years in many different countries including the border areas of East Timor, Kandahar, Herat and Mazar-e-Sharif in Afghanistan, Pakistan, Indonesia (Aceh, Sumatra) after the tsunami, Papua New Guinea, Kyrgyzstan and more.

Bill was awarded the HOSM (Humanitarian Overseas Service Medal) with East Timor clasp by the Australian Government in the mid-90’s.

Bill is quite keen to share his experiences with service groups, school groups and other interested people. He has prepared a Powerpoint presentation so that people can see firsthand the sort of work that international agencies do in many countries of the world.

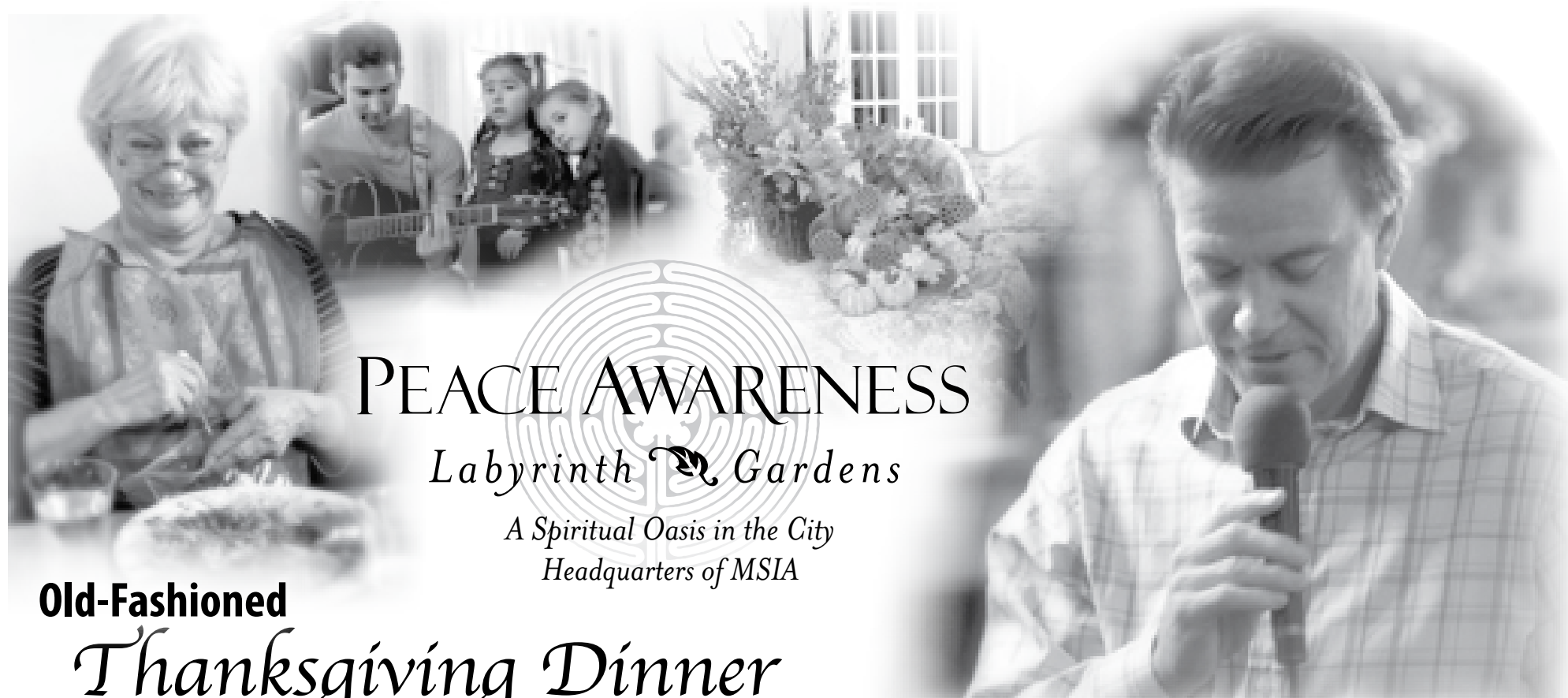

MUSIC

FOR HEALING AND BALANCE

A MEDITATIVE CONCERT

In the relative cool of the evening on October 6th, Peace Awareness Labyrinth & Gardens, in the historical district on Adams Boulevard, was lit up for the Prana Concert Series like a grand lady trotting out in her best attire. There were multiple rows of chairs in the large foyer for the audience, and at the other end, circled around the grand piano, were the seats for the musicians. I observed many familiar faces among the attendees, as well as a number of new faces. All seemed ready for a few "Gasp!" moments.

Cheri Jamison, the MC and co-coordinator of the Music Series, began the event with a welcome, a short prayer, and an introduction of each musician participating. Then she announced that all of the music to be presented would be played intuitively and 'extempore,' meaning a completely improvised program, with no intermission.

The musicians blended together, collaborating as a single unit, beginning with "Beloved Lord," Marjorie Eaton taking the lead on her celtic harp. Each piece was designed to activate and balance a particular chakra (psychic centers in the body), evoking the color spectrum and the audible spectrum for that chakra (each one having its own hue and key note).

Pianist Merrill Collins Chausseblanche gave flow and continuity, while Heather Williamson on Indian Tabla (Hindu hand drums) provided a rhythm that was both gentle and strong. Percussionist Forrest Robinson brought in cymbals, bells, chimes and other instruments, which he used artfully and with care and consideration.

There was such an attunement among the musicians, shifting rhythms, changing keys, modulating phrases while listening intently to what was coming next.

With each successive piece, the room became brighter and more filled with something . . . Invisible yet very present -- telling an ancient, interior story. I noticed that as the music progressed, I, among many others, found it hard to remain in contact with this world; we were lifted, gently and with great loving, by the ensemble instruments as well as by each individual note. Many images came to mind, with crescendos reaching into bliss and redemption and resolution.

Michael Fitzpatrick played his cello with such joy; and Laura Halladay's flute offerings were a perfect pairing to Alethea Lamb's clarinet. Weaving a carpet of Light and Sound, currents danced among each other, the entire concert finding its way throughout the mansion like subtle paths of light.

The Prana Concert Series, largely spearheaded by Cheri Jamison and me, with cooperation from nearly everyone who lives at the Peace Awareness Labyrinth and Gardens, is a wonderful cultural surprise, beautifully planned, carefully executed, memorable in every respect. A heartfelt thank you goes out to our generous underwriters for this event.

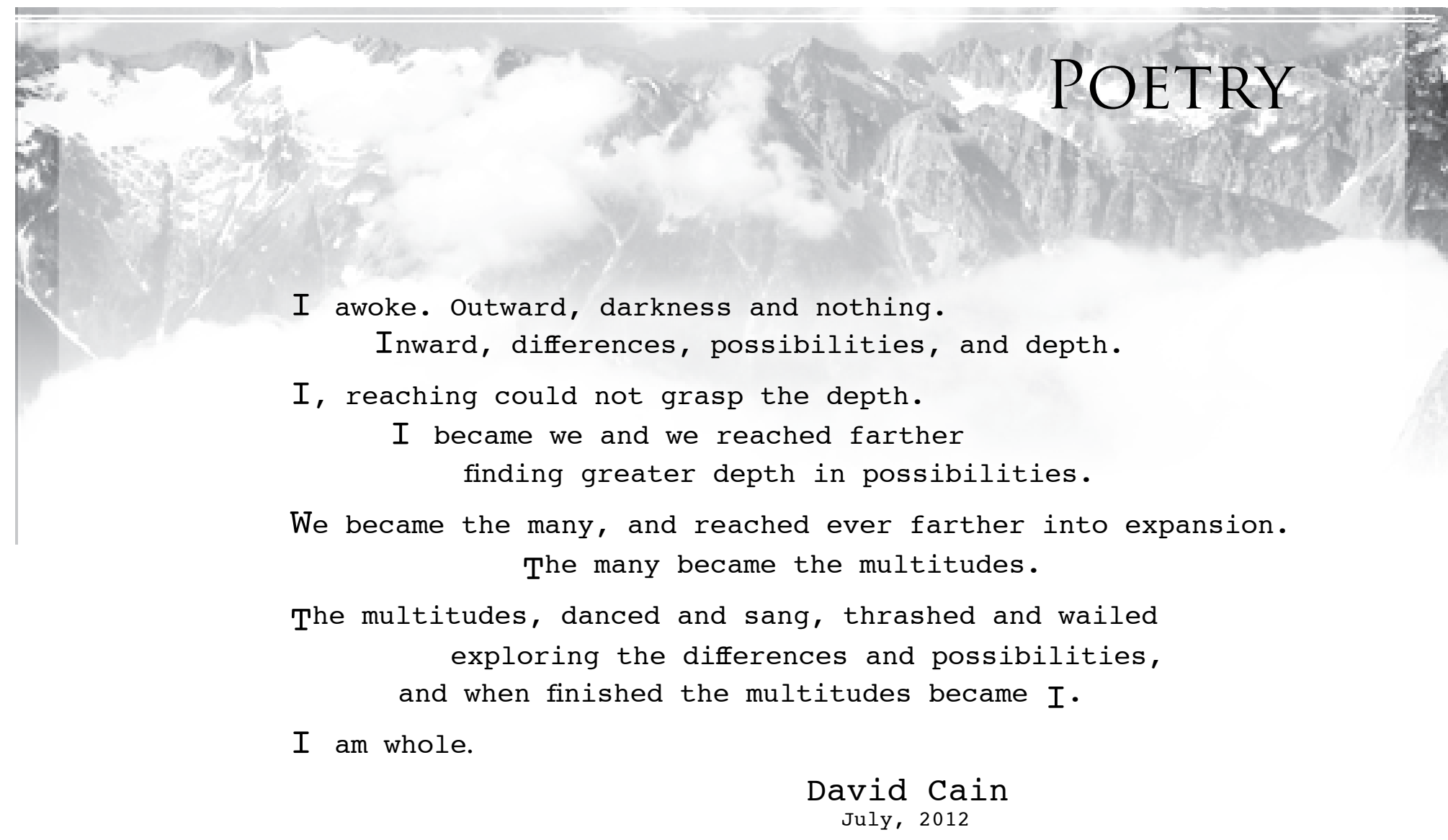

How the Light Works

a story of an ordinary everyday miracle

My name is Louise and I live in Sydney, Australia.

I would like to share with you a miracle which I had the great honor of being part of in some way. I am a person who LOVES children. When they come into the organic store in which I work every Saturday, I light up and I love to interact with them and show them unconditional love. Six months ago, a young girl (who I guessed to be approximately five years of age) started coming into the store with an older woman who I later learned was her grandmother. I would always welcome her with a warm hello, and the child, who I will call Angel, would grab hold of the grandmother's skirt and bury her face in it. They would buy a couple of items and leave.

I decided this reaction from Angel would not deter me from always treating her with love and enthusiasm. For several weeks Angel and her grandmother would come into the store on a Saturday. Angel would always turn away, burying her face in her grandmother's skirt, in what I perceived to be terror at being spoken to by a stranger. One day her grandmother said to me, "She is very shy."

One Saturday I happened to be near the front of the store when I saw the grandmother with Angel skipping and joyfully singing over and over "I love you, I love you." As they entered the store I said, "Wow what a beautiful song." Immediately, Angel closed right up and grabbed her grandmother's skirt, burying her face in it. I looked at her grandmother and said, "Wow she really is shy isn't she!" She responded by saying, "Well actually, she has been badly abused by her mother from the word go. Her mother was taking drugs and drinking all the way through the pregnancy, and continued ever since. I do what I can, and would take her in full time if I was allowed, but DOCS [Department of Children's Services] keep giving her back to her mother."

We had a discussion about how unfair the system can be, and I acknowledged her for doing what she could to help. She expressed to me her concern that, "too much damage had been done for Angel to ever be ok." I shared with her that I really believe recovery is possible with the right support. I knew this because I had experienced extreme trauma throughout my childhood and into early adulthood, with very little support. Fortunately, I have the right support now, and I have overcome the impact of the trauma in profound ways. It was at this time that I learned that the child's name was Angel. I said "Hello Angel, it is really nice to meet you. Would you like a lollipop?" Like many children she said "Yes." Unlike most children, she was

still hiding in her grandmother's skirt, too terrified to look at me. After establishing that Angel would like a pink lollipop, and that she would like me to unwrap it for her, I gave it to her. She thanked me from under her grandmother's skirt. Her grandmother thanked me with vast appreciation in her eyes, and they left the store.

I felt so many emotions. I wanted to do everything I could to support Angel, and yet I didn't even know if I would ever see her again. A fellow employee discussed this with me and said, "You made a good call giving her the lollipop." When I got home from work that day, I sent an email to John Morton. I outlined the situation, and asked for guidance on how I could best be of service to Angel, without my own "stuff" getting in the way.

I was fully aware of myself having reactions—seeing myself as a terrified child and wanting so much help. I also knew that it would do more harm than good if I allowed my "stuff" to get mixed up with Angel's. The most profound advice I received from John was "not to expect any response from Angel," so I processed this information. Each time I thought about Angel, I gauged my emotions and reactions, asking "for the light for the highest good." I kept handing it over to The Lord.

The morning after sending the email to John, I woke up enthused with the idea of buying Angel a teddy bear. In the week just past, a friend of mine had bought me a tiny bear from a fundraiser for a local children's service. I thought it was fitting to buy another for Angel. I found one that had a gold heart-shaped badge on it engraved with a bird with its wings expanding over a heart.

I took the bear with me the following Friday evening to a home seminar at Ruth and Andrew's. Ruth sat it on a cushion in the middle of the room, and everyone at the seminar put it in the light and sent blessings to Angel, her mother and grandmother. The next day I went to work with the teddy bear, very excited at the thought of giving it to Angel. I had the image of Angel being showered with the blessings, and me seeing this amazing transformation. I kept reminding myself of John's words, "not to expect anything."

It was the first Saturday in weeks that Angel did not come into the store. I thought about whether the grandmother felt embarrassed after opening up to me. I had certainly experienced that many times in my life—not knowing how safe a situation or place really was, regardless of how safe and freeing it initially felt to open up.

The next day was our Sydney monthly ministers meeting. I decided to take the bear and

share about my experience, and asked my fellow ministers to hold the light for Angel and her family. I also held the bear on my lap during prayer communion. For the next several weeks I took the teddy bear to work, but did not see them. During this time period, each day I let go a little bit more, experiencing the blessings of freedom and healing inside of myself, aware of great gifts Angel had in fact brought to me, aware of my humility and deep gratitude to the miracle and mystery of God's ways in this world. Eventually I let go and stopped thinking about Angel and her grandmother. I began to consider that the bear might in fact be meant for me.

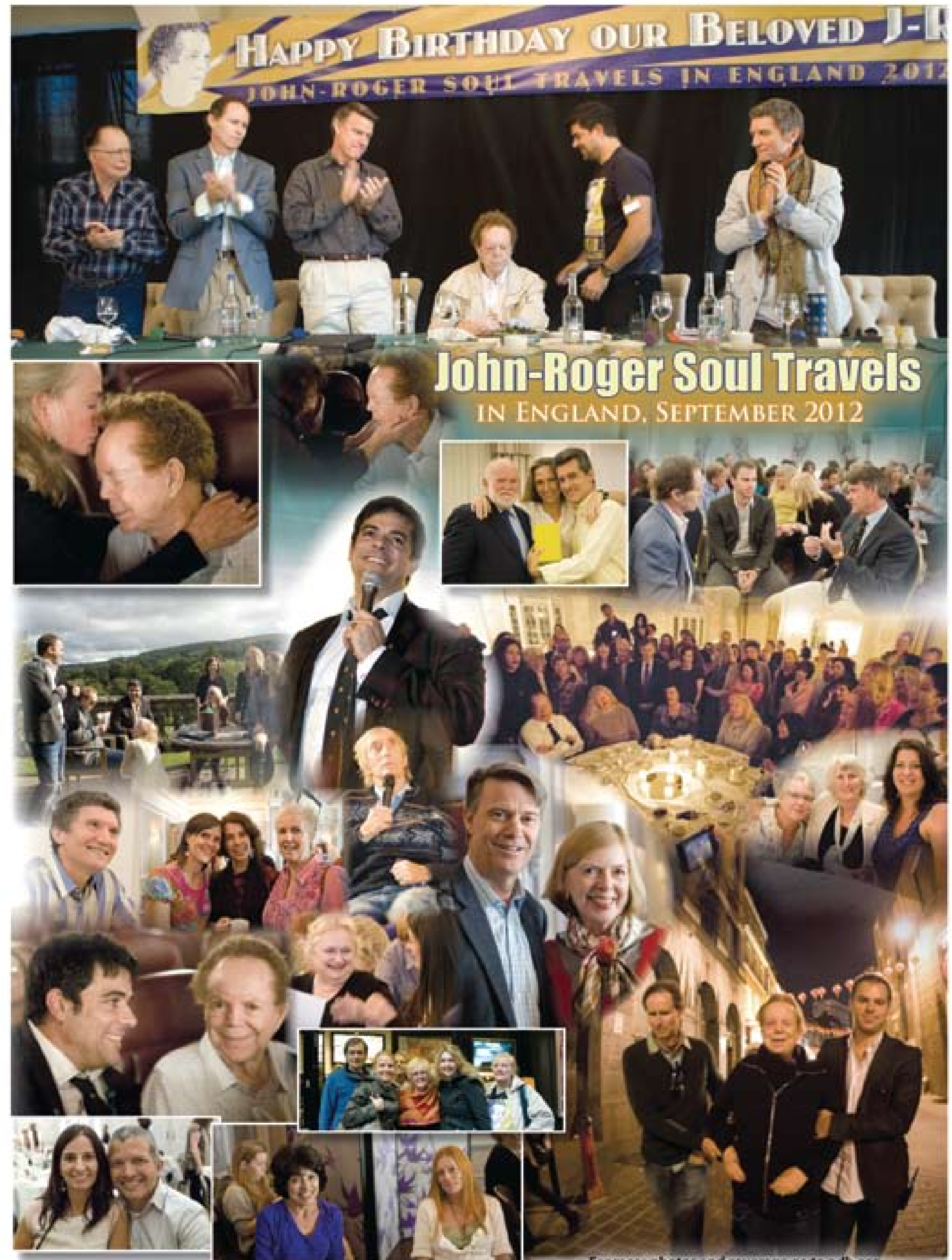
Then last Saturday they came in to the shop. I was having my lunch when my work colleague said, "Louise, the little girl is here." I went straight to the front of the store and said hello and began telling Angel's grandmother that I had bought a teddy bear for Angel. She was very touched, and even more grateful that I remembered Angel's name. I looked at Angel and said hello. That is when I saw the miracle.

Angel looked in to my eyes and said hello. I offered her another lollipop, which she accepted while thanking and looking at me. She still seemed timid, but the change in her ability to interact was truly remarkable. I told her grandmother that I had put them on a prayer list, and many people were sending their prayers. She said with much enthusiasm, "You know, after I saw you last time I felt the whole weight of it taken off my shoulders, like it was lifted. I stopped praying for what I wanted and thought was best, and started praying for what is best for Angel. My daughter got cable TV installed and started watching "Touched By An Angel." She came to me and said, 'I can see I need to make some changes.' She put Angel in day care twice a week. Whatever you have done, it has worked."

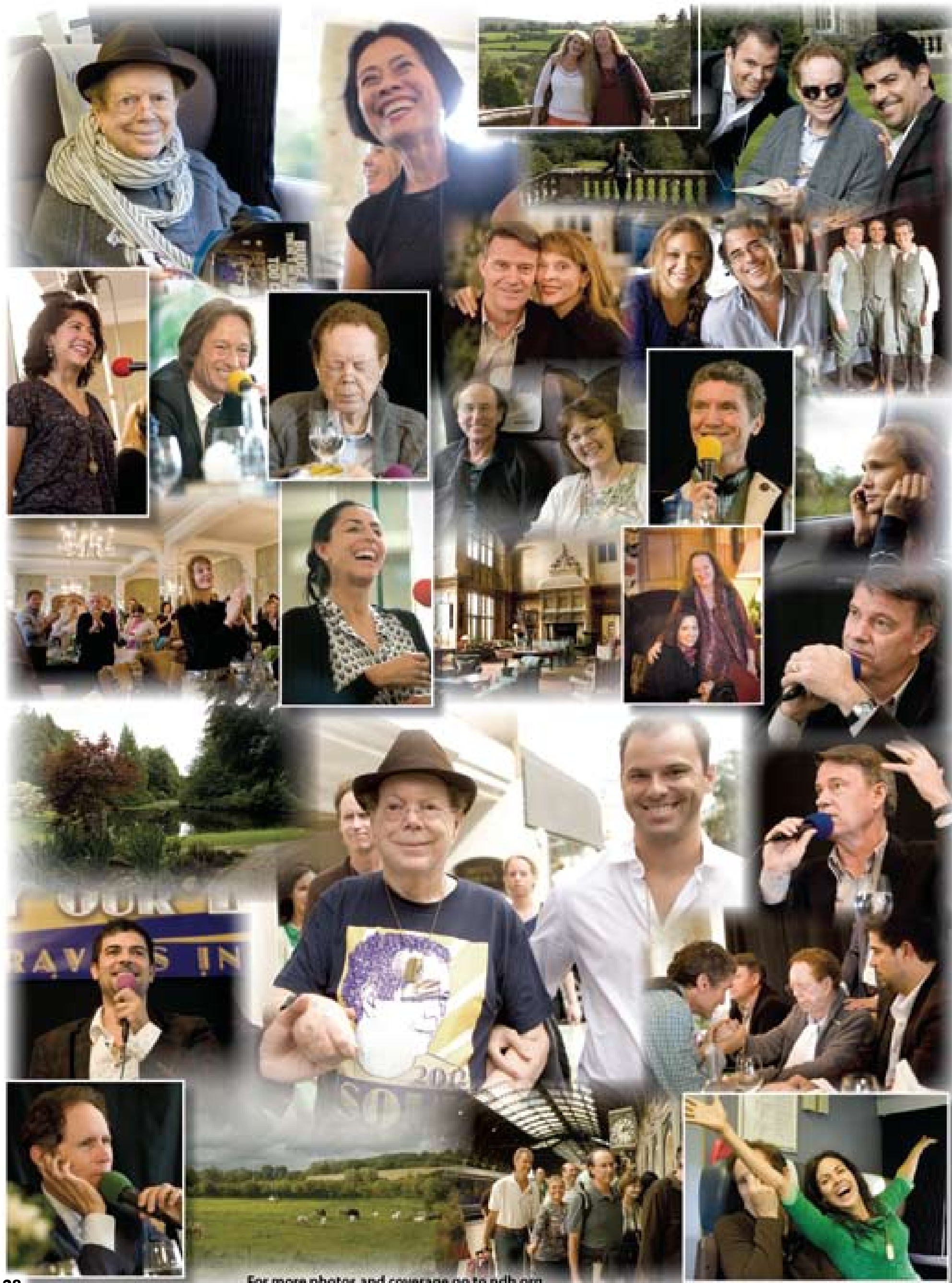
I am moved to tears when I think of this. I'm so aware of the miracle working for everyone involved.

As Angel left the shop that day, I said, "I am looking forward to hearing you sing again Angel. You have a beautiful voice." The entire time I was talking to her, Angel looked into my eyes. How blessed I am! What an incredible miracle to witness. The Lord works in mysterious ways. I really see it is about trusting and releasing and letting go, allowing and, most of all, knowing that I am simply a vessel for the Lord. There is nothing simple about that and yet there is.

Sculpting J-R

If you have visited Prana you may have spotted a bronze portrait of John Morton that I sculpted about 10 years ago. I remember sitting with John, measuring & photographing him for the sculpture, and thinking how lucky I was to have the opportunity to do so. The project was a gift of loving, but it was also a lovely opportunity to just be with John at that time.

Since then I have always had it in my Heart to one day sculpt J-R too. For whatever reason I didn't act on that Heart impulse for quite some time. Indeed, it wasn't until about 3 years ago that I asked J-R if I could sculpt him. He said "set it up with my people"... and it took me another 2 years to get around to doing that!

Finally in 2011, in London, I sat down with Jsu Garcia and we discussed what this sculpture might look like. Jsu high-lighted his love of J-R's gaze (the Twaji) and we looked at the different 'looks' J-R has had over the past decades. There was one in particular that stood out from around 1989, so that became the starting point and the aim in terms of composition.

David Sand helped out with images from that time period, sourcing photos from different angles so I had something to work from 'in the round'. Normally I would also measure and sculpt from life, but as our faces change so much over time this wasn't going to work. That said, it's become clearer to me over the years that the greatest asset I have when sculpting someone is an intuitive sense of who they are, or at least my feelings for who they are. And in this, when sculpting J-R, I have a deep well to drink from.

David Wynne, my friend and sculptor hero, says "the purpose of art is praise." So each piece becomes a love song for the subject. It was such a joy to embrace this

approach in sculpting J-R as of course the loving I have for him is so profound. My experience is also that the inspiration behind each sculpture resonates to a specific chord or sound, and so my job becomes one of following that sound throughout the process of creating the work.

Another constant with every sculpture is a "giving up" in the making of it, in that I say "You do it, Lord." I don't follow a particular technique for sculpting people, so there is always a sense of unknowing in the process. Indeed, my first attempt at this portrait I scrapped. It was ok, but it didn't communicate what I was aiming for. So it was a case of "Lord, where I fall short, help me to get out the way so you can do it." I think many sculptors will know the experience of coming into the studio in the morning and finding that fairies have been working on their sculpture during the night! It's important we stay open to this kind of possibility I think.

As a love song, this was also a gift for Jsu. Watching Spiritual Warrior, The Wayshower, and now the documentary that he has created, I am struck by how each is really a love song for J-R. This was very present for me throughout the portrait project. So it really became a celebration of loving J-R, and the love we each have for J-R.

It has been an honour and a joy to create this sculpture.

The local newspaper covered the event, and here's a translation of what they wrote:

Pinamar is now integrated to the net of caretakers of peace Pinamar, Argentina

Yesterday Marta Galucci and a group of neighbors of Pinamar planted a "Peace Pole" in the space located in Ave Bunge and Playa in Pinamar, Argentina (near Buenos Aires). Present at the event were: The Secretary of State and Security, Juan Jose Rodriguez; Secretary of Tourism Carlos Bucheli; the President of the City Council, Alberto Germain; and Cristina Rivero, IIWP Representative, who explained the symbology of the Peace Pole and invited Pinamar inhabitants to share this message of peace.

Cristina mentioned the origins of the Peace Pole in 1946 after the Nagasaki bombing and then talked about the principles of IIWP. The institute focuses on finding and choosing peace personally in everyday life.

After the Ceremony, Cristina conducted an open IIWP Workshop.

The statements "may peace prevail on earth" and "peace is present" can be read in the peace pole.

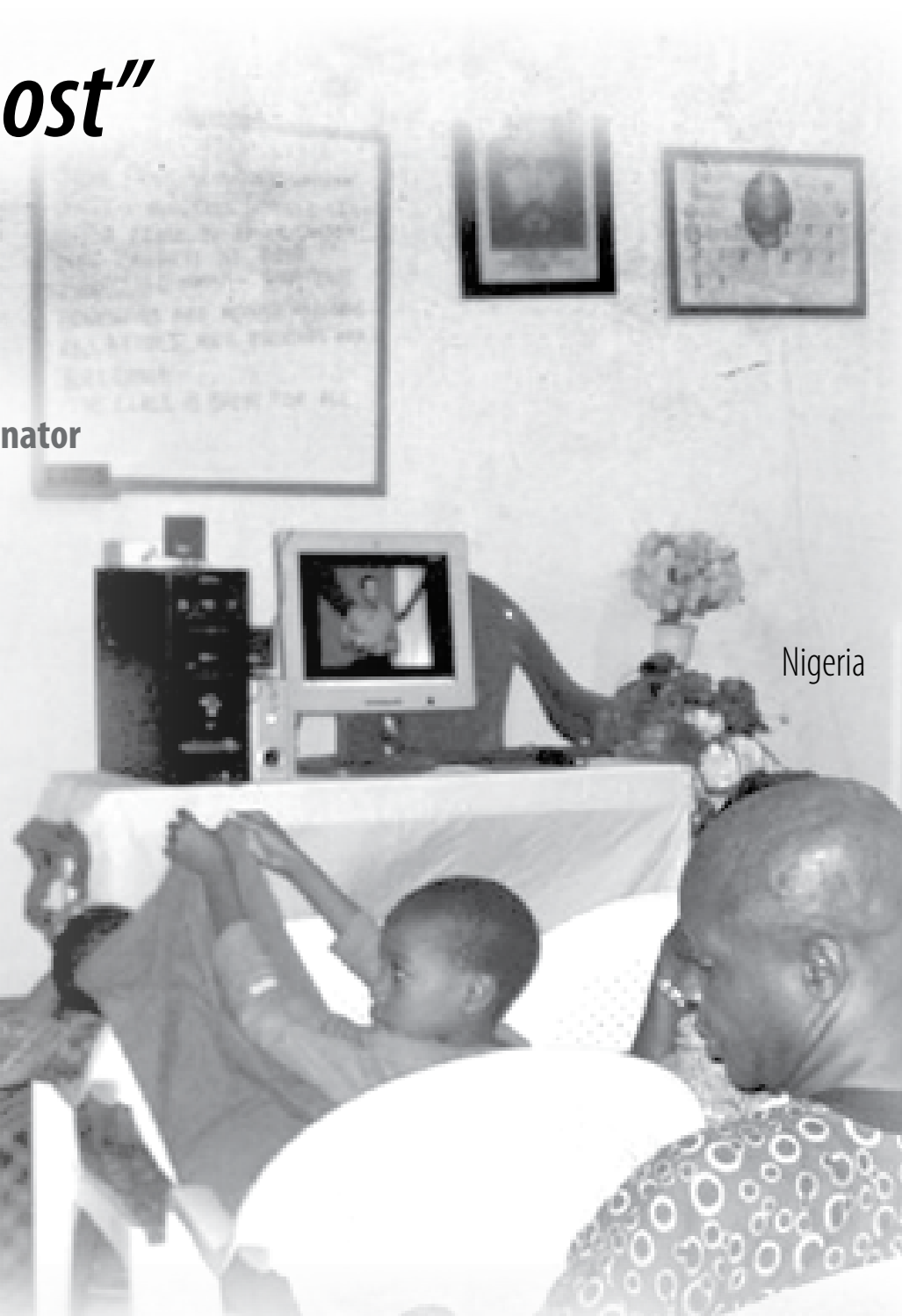

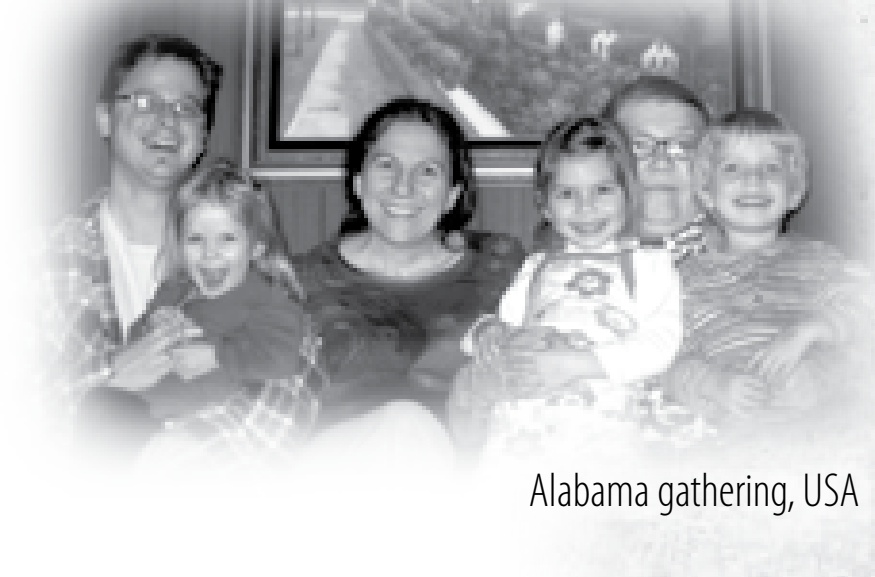

INITIATION

If you are just starting the Soul Awareness Discourses, Discourse #1 explains initiation into the Sound Current. You may choose to study the Discourses with the intention to be initiated on this path, or to simply read them as information. If you do choose to study toward initiation, the Traveler works with you more closely, and you may notice a greater spiritual awareness in your own consciousness as this work goes on.

If you are studying toward initiation, you need to write and mail a letter to the Traveler that this is your intention. If you have written and mailed your intention to the Traveler, you can apply for initiation when you have completed Discourse 24.

THE MSIA MINISTRY

The MSIA ministry is for initiates of the Traveler who are called inwardly to serve the spirit of their hearts.

Service may be in any form, from volunteering for the Church to assisting people in need or organizations that serve those people, and anything in between. The only requirement is that the ministry is active and done regularly.

MSIA ministers may perform services, like marriages, that clergy of other denominations are authorized to do as long as they comply with the laws of the locality in which they serve.

WRITING TO J-R & JOHN

Sometimes people reading Discourses, especially those studying toward initiation, want to write to John Morton or John-Roger. Writing often helps you let go of a troubling situation and open more to the Traveler's assistance inwardly.

As soon as you write to John Morton or John-Roger, they get the message on the spiritual levels, and they do what Spirit allows. Then, to let go of the situation in your consciousness, you burn or mail your letter. Whether you burn or mail what you wrote, you may find that you get your answers on the inner levels, sometimes very quickly. You may also experience greater calm, clarity, or peace, which can help you go through whatever challenges you face.

We suggest that you place the situation in the Light, ask for clarification during s.e.s, dreams, etc., and then look for the answers within you. Often reading a Discourse or listening to an MSIA tape (either at home or at a seminar) will provide keys to assist you in handling your situation. You can also refer to any of the numerous books by J-R and John to find information that relates to what you are dealing with. These two have shared so much with us over the years, and we encourage you to send your letters via e-mail, using these addresses:

If you live in the United States and if you send your letter to J-R or John in hard copy via the mail, you need to include a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) if you want a reply from either of them.

Many hundreds of people write personal letters each month to J-R and John, so please note that even if you do send a letter by e-mail or if you do send in an SASE with your letter, you may not receive a response back. This does not imply that your concern is not important or that you are being ignored. There simply may be no need for a physical reply, or there may be no answer available to you at the time you write.

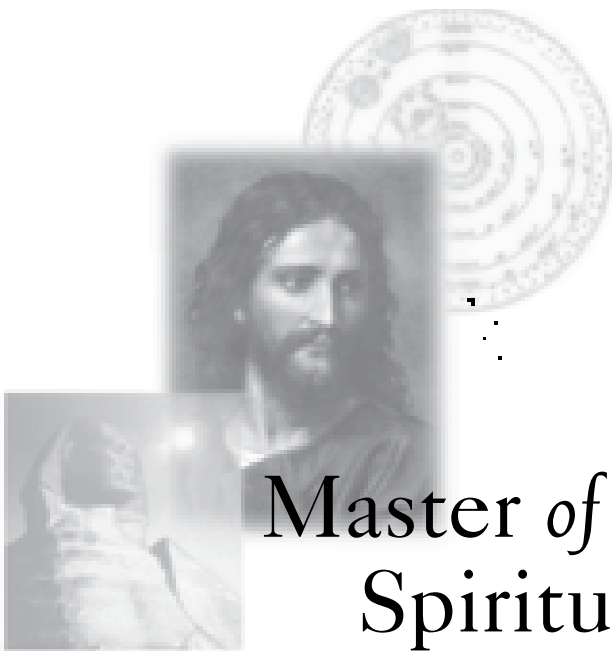

The Master's Program

Year One: Creating Through Grace

During year one, Creating Through Grace, students gain greater awareness of how they live their lives—physically, emotionally, and mentally—and of how they can bring these levels into greater alignment and cooperation with their spiritual intention. In doing this, students can increase their singleness of purpose so that, regardless of outer circumstances, they can experience God as their partner, and grace can be extended to them in greater ways.

Year Two: Fulfilling the Spiritual Promise

During year two, Fulfilling the Spiritual Promise, students focus on aligning more with the Christ and awakening more to the promise that they were “born the Lord.” Processes are designed to give students greater freedom in letting go of the past and rediscovering the innocence of living in the present. As the course develops, students move more fully into the Beloved, “where the Soul replaces the personality as the center of consciousness and energy.” The spiritual promise is then experienced as an ongoing, living reality that one chooses into each day.

Year Three: Living From The Inside Out (Optional)

By referencing all of the Master's Program, the student can put into practice those things that are the most impactful for them in the moment to initiate significant, profound, and effective growth. The student has the opportunity to take the teachings to deeper levels of awareness, where simple changes can become invaluable lessons for living an ordinary life. Taking this class is truly a way to become aware on a daily basis how you are living the teachings from the inside out. The possibilities for growth, expansion, and revelation are unlimited.

Active subscription to MSIA Soul Awareness Discourses for at least one year prior to beginning of program (12 complete) and Active subscription to Soul Awareness Teachings (SATs).

Year Two Doctoral Program Prerequisites:

YEAR 4

Advanced Ministerial Studies, Part 1

Optional course work for students who have successfully completed DSS Years One, Two, and Three and also meet the course prerequisites. The primary emphasis of this course is in-depth development of the ministerial skills that the student has worked with in the course of the three years of the DSS program. In addition, the course provides information on the legal and ethical issues pertinent to ministers who are actively serving their communities.

Throughout the program, students develop and apply a model or protocol using their Individual Study topic as their specialty. In addition, there is a focus throughout the program on self-healing. When a student receives their DSS degree they qualify for a certificate in Advanced Ministerial Studies.

Year Four Doctoral Program Prerequisites:

Successful completion of the PTS DSS Program Year Three, active subscription to MSIA Soul Awareness Discourses and Soul Awareness Teachings (SATs), active MSIA initiate and MSIA minister in good standing, regular tithing to MSIA, three Reader approvals for Individual Study direction, and official acceptance by PTS administration.

YEAR 5

Advanced Ministerial Studies, Part 2

Optional DSS course work for students who have successfully completed DSS Year Four and meet the course prerequisites. In Year Five, the students continue developing their ministerial skills. In addition, each student designs and implements a year-long ministerial project.
