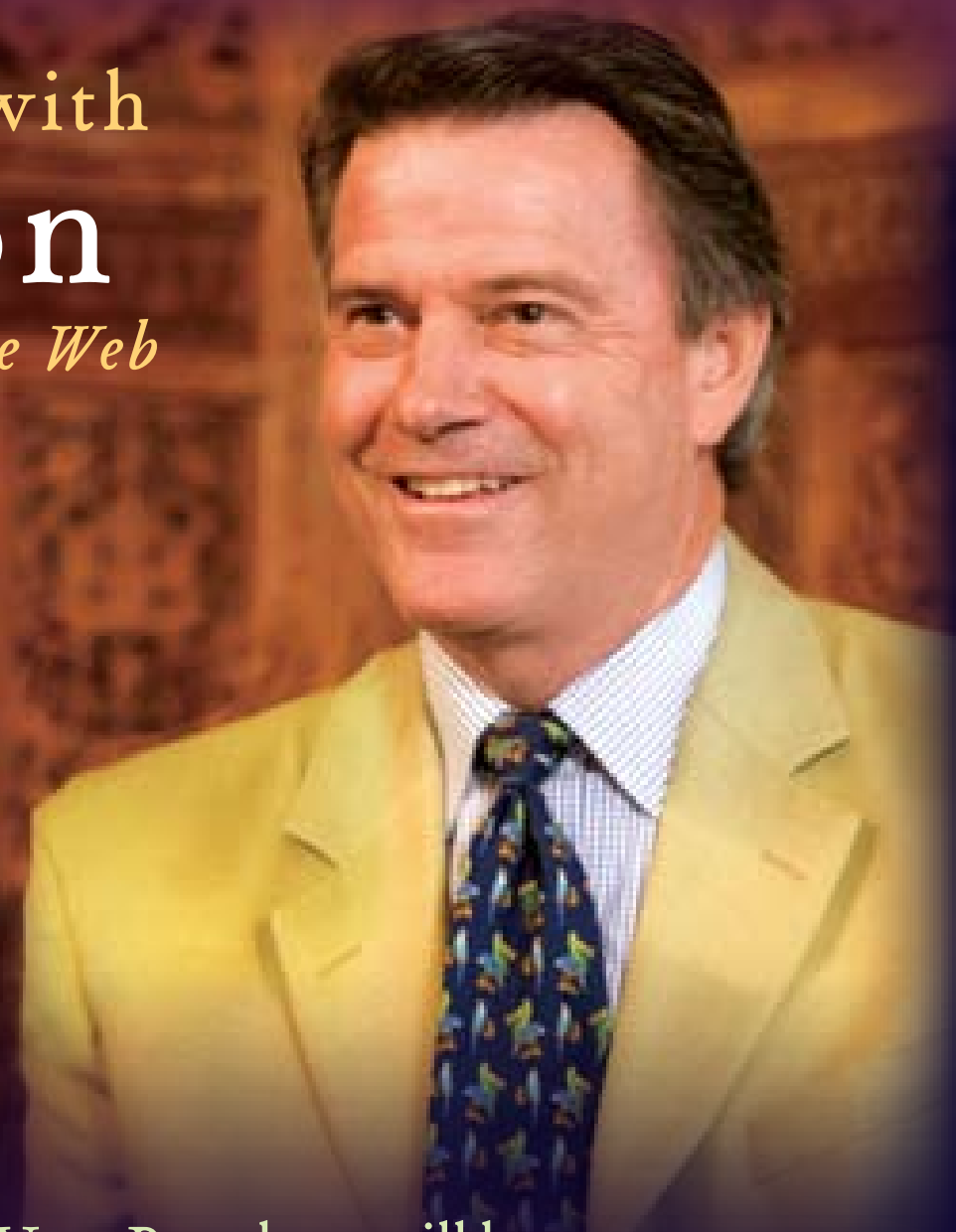

ARE YOU A RESURRECTED BEING?

BY JOHN-ROGER, DSS

From my experiences I found out that God is the resurrection, and also our willingness to do that which is necessary to bring our consciousness back around and awaken it. . . As soon as we get up we start to call forward the abilities of our beingness.

When I have reflected on the meaning of resurrection, it's always been a mystery. I asked a half dozen ministers what resurrection means, and everyone, without fail, went back to the cliché, "This was the time after Jesus was crucified. He'd been in the tomb for three days and then he came out. He resurrected out of the tomb."

That's just about as nondescript as saying, "There's traffic on the freeway." We all know that, but what does it mean and why would they use such a word? We know the word "Passover" but we may not know that in ancient times the Angel of Death passed by the doors of Israelites who believed in the one God. The doors were marked with the blood of a lamb so that the

Angel of Death would pass by and not kill the firstborn in that house. But the firstborn of everything else in the land, even animals and birds, were all slain by the Angel of Death.

When you see movies about this, the Angel of Death looks like a green gas that creeps under the doors and chokes somebody. No one has really looked at the Angel of Death in the true sense of what it is. Maybe—just maybe—we might not want to be passed over. Maybe we would want to be slain, because the Angel of Death is the Angel of Liberation. It is liberating us from the toils of being slaves in Egypt—which is forming our own karma, which we have to conform to and carry as a burden. But where we go from there has been the mystery. We say,

Look at resurrection as awakening, and each morning I resurrect to the newness that is present. Each day there is a responsibility that goes with that resurrection, which is that I must choose back to God and call forward God's name and say, "Here I am."

"Oh God, where will I go after I die, oh God? Please don't let me go to hell."

One of the ancient saints who traveled to hell said that hell was better than earth, and if people knew that, they would just die because heaven has got to be better. This information was given to me and I was asked what I thought about it. I said, "I think that saint must have been masquerading as a saint, because even though our God has His Holy Spirit and His Messiah, the Angel of Death also has his Holy Spirit and his Messiah, and they have duplicate powers and abilities."

It's very hard for someone to come up against a metaphysical energy and say, "that is not of God," or "that is of God," because that metaphysical energy can do things that we can't, so we immediately assume that it must be of God. It is not necessarily attributable to God as though it is in a direct line with God. It may be attributable in the sense that all things come from God, and therefore so does it, and since God loves all of His creation and that's part of Creation, therefore it's also loved by God. But those are philosophical statements, and we have to watch that we don't live by a philosophy, because most of the time it will fail us. The philosophies are man-made—man-originated, man-talked-over, intellectually taken apart, put together—and then we try to live that. Some religions have gigantic amounts of material in books, disks, tapes, cassettes, or papyrus that come out of man's thoughts about what's going on. Usually, people's thoughts are just people's thoughts.

If you were to be resurrected, would you first have to die? Jesus had a good friend named Lazarus. He was told by some friends that Lazarus was ill, and they asked Jesus to come and speak the "Word." Jesus said, "He's not dead. He's sleeping," or some words to that effect. Jesus showed up much later and they berated him: "Why did you not come sooner? He's been dead for a couple of weeks." And he said, "Lazarus, come forth." People were astounded that Jesus was going to call him up from the tomb and they said, "He's dead. He's been dead." One ven-

tured the idea that if he comes forth, he's going to stink up the place.

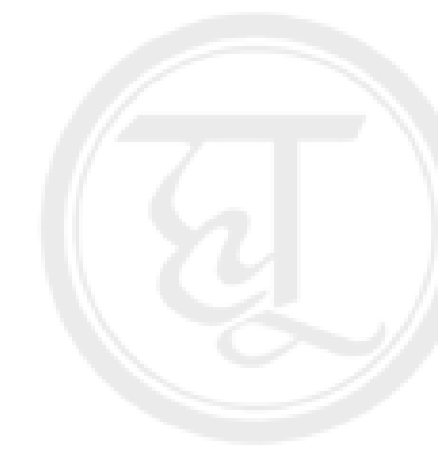
I had an experience with a relative who had passed away. I said "Put the telephone by the person's ear," and I said, "Hi, this is Roger." And they said, "Hello," and the next day they left the hospital. The fact that it happened is absolutely profound. But the fact that I said what I said and did what I did was courtesy, or good manners. I don't know if good manners has inherent within it the ability to call forward the dead, but do we really want to call forward the dead? If I were to die now, and people asked, "Well, are you going to resurrect?" I would say, "No." Would I want to resurrect for some reason? No. Jesus did and I know he did that to accomplish a purpose and a direction. That's been done, and now it's time to move on to the next stage of our being. I look at resurrection as awakening, and each morning I resurrect to the newness that is present. Each day there is a responsibility that goes with that resurrection, which is that I must choose back to God and call forward God's name and say, "Here I am."

From my experiences I found out that God is the resurrection, and also our willingness to do that which is necessary to bring our consciousness back around and awaken it. We call ourselves forth by getting out of bed. Prior to getting up, we're lying there in a thinking process or daydreaming. We are a being, but not a productive process. As soon as we get up we start to call forward the abilities of our beingness. Often, that's when our thinking starts. Some people's thinking doesn't start until after they have that first cup of coffee, and others have to go out and go for a walk or a run. Others have to do some morning breathing exercises. All of these methods are valid because they bring you awake from the sleep of the dead.

Some of you don't even remember that you dream, and you sleep the dead sleep of the dead. Others remember parts of their dreams. Most of the rest of us recall parts of our dreams and we wake up because of that. "It's coming after me. It's going to

get me. Oh my God!" You hear a voice screaming, and you open your eyes and that's you. What a way to wake up.

When you're coming out of the resurrection into life, is there a prescribed procedure? The Bible only gives one but it does not say it's prescribed that way. It's just a narration that says, "Here's something that happened and here's how you can go on." We've studied the inner qualities of spiritual awareness in MSIA for many years. We've tried them out and we've worked them. We've seen how they work and we've seen how they don't work. They might work on Monday and Tuesday, but not Wednesday. Don't complain about Wednesday. It might start again Thursday. Don't avoid picking it up on Thursday because it didn't work on Wednesday.

We must be as flexible as the wind and as steady as the North Star. That means we're focused on something, and that focusing and foundation-building are very important to our spiritual development. The more we do it, and the more we do spiritual exercises, the more Spirit's strength appears. But if we don't watch out, we'll switch over into stubbornness or resoluteness. We'll fight for the right to remain stuck exactly where we are and complain about the stuckness of our life. There are so many opportunities that resurrection offers us.

Do yourself a favor and go and look up the word "resurrection" and see what each part means in each of its segments, because resurrection doesn't appear as a puff of smoke and we're there. It seems to come in a process of energy that comes through in waves, and those waves come through at different times.

It's much like giving a seminar. I come up here with no knowledge and there's nothing here, and the first part of the resurrection is dropped down in front of me, which is often just a colored light that says, "The Spirit of God is present, and you will speak through that." If I'm speaking through that, am I speaking to you or am I speaking to the presence of God in you? If I'm speaking to the presence of God in you, why do I do that? Wouldn't it already know?

The presence of God inside of us doesn't care if we're asleep or not because it is present in a nowness, and not on a timeline. Have you ever gone to a party and somebody there had a cold and you thought, "Oh my God! They've the flu or a cold. I'll stay away from them." And two days later you come down with the flu or the cold. Some part of you resonated to the illness they had. You pick up that resonance and produce the illness yourself. And then if we're in harmony with each other we pass this illness around until everybody's got it, and then we get rid of it.

But what if you're not in harmony with that? Then everybody gets sick and you don't. And then you brag to yourself, "I am healthy." No, you're not healthy. You just didn't get that one. Because healthy people don't die—and so far, they're all dying. Will they resurrect? The first question to ask is, "Did they pass over or did they get stuck on the way and they're not there yet?" because you can't be resurrected from a place where there is no resurrection.

Is there a resurrection from the planet earth? Indeed, there is. We can enter into the process of resurrection. How do you think Jesus did it? Did he just say one day, "Oh, I'll just resurrect.?" I'll bet he read some scriptures that said there's a resurrection that went on. Maybe he practiced some yoga to learn how to hold his breath. Maybe he learned how to swim under water for long distances. What was the training that Jesus went through for thirty-three years to prepare him for that moment when he ascended and transcended death?

Some have said that because Jesus died and resurrected he overcame death, and that infers that we can too. I'd like to tell you right now that that's nonsense. He may have done what he did, and there are a lot of questions about that. I don't have a question about that because I know who he is in Spirit. But I know who others are in Spirit and I have no question about that either. So it doesn't matter to me if I believe or not, because I don't have a belief in Jesus Christ, nor a disbelief in Jesus or the Holy Spirit. You don't have to believe what you know. Do you have to believe you're sitting in a chair? Or can you, just by your own experience, know you're sitting in the chair?

If resurrection is truly initiation, then when someone does the Archimedes approach (which is "Ah-ha!, Eureka, I have discovered it. I am awakened to this new idea.") do we automatically believe them? We cannot. We can only take their information and see if it works for us, and if works, it is self-validating and we do not have to get stuck in beliefs. We can get stuck in the energy of how things work and move forward under the volition of our own consciousness, our soul, our spirit, our Lord of the Kingdom of Heaven and God who resides in the Kingdom of Heaven, and put all that together and have a life that is tremendous here—and still fraught with disasters and our ego desires, because this planet comes under the egoic movement of life, while our body comes under the soulic ego movement of spirit. Those are not the same.

Some people might say we were resurrected from spirit to the material world. Sometimes it seems like that. Or sometimes it seems as if we were born into

something that's terrific, or we were born into something less than that and we're supposed to make it better. Since moral issues and good-and-bad are always man's point of view, we have a very hard time living them. We have a very hard time fighting against them. In some countries when you're riding in a vehicle you can go very fast. And in other countries if you went half that fast, you'd be in very deep trouble with the local authorities who police that activity.

How can we possibly judge or evaluate people's behavior, when our own behavior is not really under our own control? In the Bible Paul said, "That that I would do, I don't do and that that I don't want to do, I end up doing." He wasn't in control of what was going on, and certainly not in control of himself. I'd be willing to bet there are people who have said, "Yes, I'm going on this diet and I'm not going to eat this food," and you ate it. Or you said you're going to drink so many ounces of water every day and you didn't. You gave your word and you broke your word. And why not? Everybody lies. There's no end to the creativity of man. If a lie assists you in the creation of something you want, I think there's no question that you would lie to have that take place. You might not totally lie but you might fudge around with the figures a little bit.

We're here as part of the divine comedy. We see people do things and we go, "How dumb and stupid." It isn't dumb and stupid, it's funny and hilarious, so we might as well get with the laughter. We have workshops that are of a divine nature and divine origin and divine prompting. The energy of the divine is all through it—and yet somebody will tell a joke that we know is profanely dirty and we don't want to laugh, but we just crack up and things pop loose from us. God uses anything and everything in order to reach us. He did with me. To reach me he said, "Wake up."

The hardest time I've ever had trying not to laugh has been in the sacredness and silence of a church, when a thought comes through that is not mine and there's no way I'm going to be able to keep from telling somebody. The more I try not to laugh and cover my face, the more I snort and the more trouble I make until somebody else gets caught in the disease of the laughter. The laughter just starts rolling around and people start to say, "What's so funny?" And the reply is, "I don't know, ha, ha, ha, I don't know what's funny." And the other person laughs too because it's not funny.

How do we know what's funny and what to laugh at? There's a mechanism in us that is joy and the manifestation of that joy is laughter. It is often the most difficult to maintain when we hold it back and try not to show that we're not reverent in a rever-

ential situation. I gave up being reverent a long, long time ago. I said, "Lord, if you want me reverent, you're in charge here, just go ahead and do it. And if you don't care one way or another then I'll just have to put up with people's opinions." I found that the people whose opinions I cared about were laughing right along with me. The people whose opinions I didn't care about were the bosses, and they would come down and say, "Why are you disturbing the service?" And the answer was "I don't know." They would say, "You don't know?" "No." "You're laughing and causing disturbance and you don't know why you're laughing?" "Nope, I don't know why I'm laughing." They would say, "That's stupid and ridiculous." They would walk away and sit down and all of a sudden you would see them putting their hankie around their face and their eyes—and if you watched, you'd see their stomach moving.

In one minister's church people are falling out of chairs on the floor, laughing hysterically. He keeps right on going, stepping over people who are on the floor. They stand up to tell him something and they can't because they start laughing so hard. That man's either got very thick skin, or he doesn't care, or he has a church where the presence of the Holy Spirit is known by people's laughter. I would much rather be in that church so that if something strikes me funny, I would be able to laugh. I got a video of it. He was lecturing and things were just funny. He didn't say anything funny; he was quoting scripture. I could hear other people in the background laughing so I turned up the volume and I realized that this is the laughing church. I watched that video three times and if I watch again, I'll probably laugh again. The minister's church has now been condemned by other Christian churches because they laugh during the services. But those people will continue laughing and continue with their life and their loving, and every chance they get they resurrect to a new state of awareness.

One man who was a minister of a church stood up laughing and said, "I've agreed to take on the forty million dollar debt of my father's church," and broke out laughing, saying, "And I don't have a penny." A serious Christian television station interviewed him and asked, "Why in God's name did you do that?" And he said, "Precisely, in God's name." They said, "No, *you* don't understand." He said, "No, you don't understand." They said, "You took on forty million dollars worth of debt." He said, "And I did it joyfully and I'm joyful now. I'm going to do it, and we've already got half of the money," because when he went back to his congregation and told them what he had done, they decided to help the poor simpleton out (which is what they had to do anyway). I heard just recently that he has now collected over forty million dollars and the people of his church laugh during all of the services.

I've heard that there's going to be a Christian association that's going to have a name meaning something like, "Come into our church and laugh," or The Laughing Churches Association. It probably won't be as big as the Southern Baptist Conference or an Ecumenical or Evangelical church, but it's going to exist. I would hope that if you were depressed one day there would be one around so that you could go in and try it, and see if you could lift yourself by your laughter.

Every once in a while when we're working together that spirit, the Holy Spirit—which in that church is the laughing spirit—comes through here and we all just crack up and we have no really good idea why. But it feels so good for it to come from some place so profoundly deep and wonderful. And I've tried to anchor ways back into it to find it. I haven't been able to do it. But all I have to do is think of doing something really seriously and it starts to show up as laughter as I think, "I'm going to do that? I'm not going to do that. I would like to do that. Yeah, but I'm not going to do that." But I'll think of doing that. And then I start thinking about it and I just start laughing and then I sit there wondering, "What was it that I was going to do?" But I know it must have been good.

I started keeping a little pocket record with me so that when I'd get an idea about something to do, I'd write down one or two words so I could remember, and after I laughed I could come back and say, "This is what it is. Think of doing that again. Have a good laugh." These are not just good laughs. These are laughs where the eyes run, the nose runs, the mouth drools, you're having a hard time with the bladder and you know you're not going to be able to outlast any of it, so you surrender yourself to the inevitability that you're going to have a mess on your hands in a few minutes. And the mess never appears because you're surrendering to God Almighty, who is not a mess nor an author of chaos, nor the author of destruction. And yet, at the same time, that God is in us all.

We know that as a man thinketh, in his heart he becomes. If you think "happy" and "joyful" and "abundant," you cannot think "unhappy," "not joyful," and "poverty" because then you go into confusion and doubt, and you die inside with your own thoughts. But once you know that you're resurrected and you're a new being, you will continue to be a new being as you stick to that path of knowledge of Light, of love, of sound, and as you keep lifting higher.

There is a book called *When Bad Things Happen to Good People*. It looks at questions people ask, such as why their loved ones die when they were such wonderful people. If you ask those kinds of questions, you haven't seen the big picture, which is who you really are and what you've really done. That's payback time in your creation. Karma is not like a jury in a court dealing with the law of the land. It can't be persuaded by your emotional appeal, but it's functioning according to the actions that you have created and put forward in some other time and place. You're responsible as God the creator and you're getting it back as God the creator, because it is yours. It will not be painful to you; it is painful only to the people who write books like *When Bad Things Happen to Good People*. They have the same pain as

all of us who are left behind, when good people die early and we say "Why God? Oh, why? Why not me instead of them?" God says, "because you're going to have your misery and punishment from arthritis, from old age, from not getting what you want." This one got their payment back this way, but before they were born they agreed to it. They chose it, and they chose that which would be their passing over and that which would be their resurrection. And who are we in the undeveloped part of our brain to challenge the developed part of God's spirit, whose brain has to encompass every brain, even the unused part of our brains?

Do we challenge that or do we once again come back to the wisdom of what really is, and say, "Lord, thy will be done?" That is what Jesus the Christ said. If you can take this cup from me, if you can relieve me of this karmic responsibility, please do so and if you don't, I accept that your will is done.

What about Jesus' own will? He would not exercise his own will against God, the Father's. He said, "I will exercise my will IN God's will," and thereby set up the dispensation for all of the millions of us who follow, so that we can become resurrected beings and enter into God's loving. Then we can bypass our ego of certainty and doubt and move into what we feel that is the loving, the laughing, and the understanding that all of us are equal in God's eyes, that we are all children who are growing up and maturing, and that we will reach out and help others.

Love and Light to you, and may God place His hand upon your heart, upon your children, and upon your family and turn them into spiritual beings that God will indeed be proud of, so that He will say, "These are also my only begotten children."

Claiming, Creating and Completing with Joy

Joy is a spiritual promise. It's our natural way of being from the Spirit. This world has a way of knocking us for a loop every once in a while or maybe quite a bit, depending on how your life flows. That to me is just another way of saying we're going to be tested. But the joy is still present always.

Over the years, John-Roger has said that we are to have joy and to have it more abundantly. There is a reference in Scripture, "These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full" [John 15:11]. I see that like a law. You could say, "It's my right to have joy because God said."

What's important in experiencing the joy is to ask yourself where is your faith? Where is your trust? Do you claim your joy? If you do claim it, do you claim it in full or do you claim it only when you feel joy? When you don't feel joy, do you still claim the joy for yourself?

Claiming the joy is a process that is part of our learning and part of how we can evaluate if we're keeping the faith. Do you have the patience, to trust and to hold while you find the joy? Joy is a spiritual promise. It's our natural way of being from the Spirit. This world has a way of knocking us for a loop every once in a while or maybe quite a bit, depending on how your life flows. That to me is just another way of saying we're going to be tested. But the joy is still present always.

Consider what you are aware of in this moment. What are you giving your awareness over

to? Do you give it over to fear and doubt, things that you don't like, or things that bother others? Do you let those concerns be the focus of your awareness? If you do, then where's the joy?

It may seem at times that joy is missing. It may seem to be asleep inside of us, taking a rest, and waiting to come awake again. The joy is never missing. Joy is always present. It's up to us to awaken to it.

Have the intention and that claiming of your joy so it's part of how you identify yourself. Claim to yourself, "I'm a joyful person. I create joy. I find joy in my life and my circumstances." I find it's along the lines of St. Patrick's prayer about the Christ being with us in every way. Joy is in front of me, behind me, on my left, on my right, under my feet, behind my eyes. Joy is always there.

Claiming the joy is a movement. It's rising up one more time to meet the joy. It's taking the responsibility to create the joy in what you're doing. John-Roger has said, "If you want to be happy, do happy things." So it follows that if you want to be joyful, do joyful things.



If you find yourself envisioning and starting to manifest but you stop part way through rather than finishing, you may have a habitual pattern of not completing what you started. Because it's familiar and because you know what it is, then it tends to run like a course. It's as if it has its own track. It just repeats itself, which in and of itself can be disturbing. You might ask yourself, "Why would I recreate and do over and over again something I don't really like, where I get disappointed and frustrated? Why would I go half way instead of finishing?" Instead, ask yourself, "What would change the pattern?"

The answer is for you to continue. At the point where you might want to stop, you don't stop. You keep going.

Claiming Your Spiritual Promise

To know yourself as a spiritual being, claim it. Identify with it. You are spiritual. It is your heritage. You can't lose your spirituality. You may displace it. You may forget about it. You may act as if it isn't yours, but it remains yours. You are always a spiritual being.

We really can't mess with who we are spiritually. We may mess with ourselves, but who we are spiritually, that divine treasure, is held intact. It's not tarnished. It's not broken. So if we act as if it is, that's when we're off. And then our life is going to reflect that we're off.

As John-Roger has said numerous times, we get sick and tired and then we get sick and tired of being sick and tired. That's around the time we let it go. Sometimes that's with a sense of desperation, like, "I give up because I don't know what else to do." Amazingly, what may happen then is that at long last, you're open. Because you were desperate, you created your openness. Now you're reachable. You're touchable. Your focus can be directed into who you are, rather than what you think you are or what someone else thinks you are.

Letting Go of Judgments

Would you like to shift your awareness from judgments to more awareness of your joy? That's fairly simple. Just change what you're looking at. Change your focus. What would help you do that is to release the judgments.

A dynamic in a judgment is that something or someone should be different, including you. You might judge yourself that you should have more money, more things, or be more successful. If that's the case, then I think if you look carefully at yourself, you're going to find that you are the one who assigned those things to yourself. You created an expectation for yourself about what you should be accomplishing in your life, particularly around the results.

The reality is it's just a dynamic where you are in conflict with the results in your life. You assigned an expectation to yourself. It could be an attachment. Sometimes the attachment is to where things were in the past. You might say, "I used to have this" or "I used to have this job," and then focus on what occurred in the past. That then becomes a victim story rather than a story of learning, growth and ever-increasing joy.

Instead of focusing on what once was, connect to where you are in this moment. Ask yourself "How am I?" Look at your life as it is. Look at what you're wearing, where you live, where you are right now, and what's present with you, here and now. Take notice and claim the joy already present in your life. It's a good idea to update yourself regularly so you're in tune with your life as it is now, rather than wishing it was different than the way it is.

Although it's fairly common to judge ourselves, it's a source of dis-ease when you do that because you're out of alignment with who you are. When we become aware and connected with who we truly are, we often find it's a good story --- a story of success, abundance and prosperity. There's a lot for us to be thankful for. As soon as you start that process of waking up your thankfulness, you'll start feeling better because joy follows naturally. Gratitude is a good attitude. It lifts us. So if you want to experience more joy about your life, move into your thankfulness.

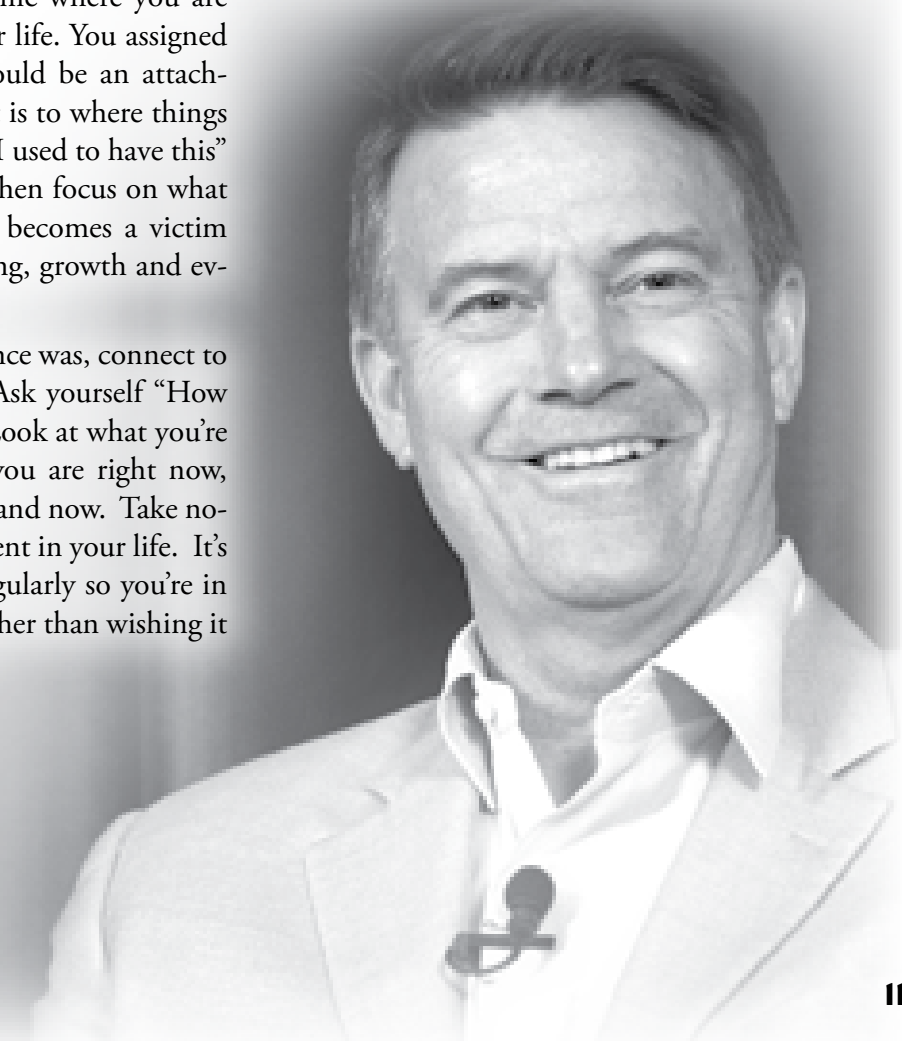
Manifesting the Joy

As you become more aware of your judgments, you can change your focus. If you think, "I should have more money. I should have nicer things. I should have a job I enjoy more," you can change that from "I should have it" to "I can have it." Your life isn't over. It's still being created, and you are a co-creator with God.

As you choose into the joy that is present, there is a practical aspect that has to do with manifestation. Consider what you want to create in this world. What do you want to make your life become? What results are you looking for? Energy follows thought. So the more you can be specific, the better. If energy follows you in some vague, general concept, then the results will match with unclear results.

Consider that even if you were in a garbage dump, you could be happy, content and at peace. That's possible. In fact, you might not even want to change that situation for yourself. But if you do, if you're aware, "I do want to change it. I want a nice house. I want a nice car. I want a job that's interesting to me," then energy starts to follow your lead. And there's a responsibility to bring it forward.

Claiming, Creating and Completing with Joy

I suggest you put in writing your intentions because that has a way of concretizing it. If it's difficult to put it into words what you're envisioning, it can be done with pictures. You can envision an ideal scene, where you cut out pictures from magazines and create a collage of what you want to manifest in this world. Put it in a place where you can look at it and focus upon it.

Perhaps you have an ideal scene from a long time ago. Is your current vision the same? If it hasn't materialized as of yet, you might need to update it. Maybe it needs to be re-energized and re-done so it matches your intentions here and now.

The most important part of envisioning what you want is your energy. So if you don't have energy on what you want to create, then you're adrift. You're kind of at the mercy of whatever winds are blowing. Those tend to be karmic. So if you want to set a new course and change the karma, ask yourself, "What do I want to focus upon? Where am I in relation to where I want to go?"

Overcoming Distractions

When we are faced with distractions or things that annoy us, we can choose to increase our awareness. It may be a toothache or a headache, a jackhammer, a noisy store, or any number of things that bother you such that you register, "I don't like that." Actually, it may be more like, "I don't really seem to have the opportunity or the willingness to change it." So now what?

You can overcome distractions through your observation and the willingness to embrace whatever it is rather than resist it. That's a key over and over again for all of us in this level. Can you embrace what it is rather than move into some form of resistance where you're contracting? Can you let go of protesting and judging?

It's a choice point to accept or reject whatever is distracting you. Rejecting and resisting the annoyance tends to add to its persistence and even increase its magnitude. Acceptance starts creating a lesser annoyance and allowing for greater enjoyment.

We always have the opportunity to take distractions on as a kind of puzzle or riddle that is already solved. God already solved it. God loves the annoyance, so you can love it too. You can even enjoy it. Let's consider God knows that, so God says, "Your turn. Your move." If you know that you can solve the puzzle because it's already solved by God, then you can move to the loving and joy of whatever is that experience.

Because of our intention, we can find a way to find the good, to find the joy and upliftment in any distraction. It may take our patience and our willingness to endure. I encourage you to have that willingness, like "Okay, I'll hang in there. I'll use whatever this is as a process for my upliftment and learning."

Completing Karma with Joy

If you find yourself envisioning and starting to manifest but you stop part way through rather than finishing, you may have a habitual pattern of not completing what you started. Because it's familiar and because you know what it is, then it tends to run like a course. It's as if it has its own track. It just repeats itself, which in and of itself can be disturbing. You might ask yourself, "Why would I recreate and do over and over again something I don't really like, where I get disappointed and frustrated? Why would I go half way instead of finishing?" Instead, ask yourself, "What would change the pattern?"

The answer is for you to continue. At the point where you might want to stop, you don't stop. You keep going. Notice markers along the way, such as how you got closer to the finish. Remember, we're not trying to do everything all at once. If you can, go for it. Sometimes we can resolve something instantly. But many times it's a gradual process and it's important to note and honor our progression.

Part of what brings us happiness and success is having a willingness to be gradual, to do what's available now and appreciate it as a gain, improvement, or advancement of some kind. Celebrate your victories in the action cycle. If you're done with what you wanted to do, but you don't acknowledge it, you don't celebrate it, you don't thank yourself or whatever helped you including God, then you're missing something. You're missing out on appreciating what you're doing with your creation. So part of completion is celebration.



If you have a reference point from your past actions where when you finished something and then you were harmed or betrayed in some way, that experience tends to set up in the unconscious a sense of, "I don't want to finish because I just get hurt." If you experienced it as a death experience, where you carried it over and it wasn't finished, then it can hold as a pattern of fear into this lifetime. You may then say to yourself, "When I'm successful, I lose. Something is taken away from me or they give me greater responsibility. So now I have expectations that I just had my first success and now they want me to do it better. And I don't even know how I did the first success." That's a fairly common thought process in which people feel set up negatively by finishing and creating success. It becomes something that is registered as an experience that didn't work for you rather than an experience of joy in your process towards completion.

It's important to realize that you're growing and maturing as you gain your life experiences. You don't need to let things that happened to you when you were younger and less experienced govern where you are now. Have the awareness that the right thing to do, the correct approach, is to keep going. Choose to finish in ways that are complete and in celebration.

Even if it isn't accomplishing what you originally set out to do, choose to come into a completion and celebration, which can simply be an inner experience of satisfaction. That's one of the ways to work the karma --- make sure it's complete inside of you and not just done outwardly. Often what is done in the world doesn't mean it's complete within. That's where the acknowledgment comes in.

Being complete means you're clear. You can move on. There's a next step available to you, and you can move to that next step. You're not being held back or stuck. You are complete.

In this path with the Traveler, we are actively finishing the karma. We are completing the karma so that we can make our move into the oneness and the love of God that's available. That means that whatever we created in our past actions, which we often refer to as karma, we need to work out and clear. Whatever we're carrying as the karma surfaces, and it can surface on all levels --- physically, mentally, emotionally, and psychically. It doesn't necessarily mean that the way your lifestyle is and what you're doing is bad, wrong, or needs fixing. It may just mean to have some patience with yourself. Your karma is at work, so things are surfacing to be completed and cleared for your highest good.

Whatever you're working through from past lives is being delivered at a rate you can handle. If you're studying with MSIA, then you have a wonderful support system with you and around you. The MSS and DSS classes give tremendous support and remind you how to keep going and how to work through and clear patterns of judgment. So when you need help, when you need support, call out. That's what friends are for. That's what we have in our ministries --- heartfelt reaching out to one another. Clearly that's going to help. Part of it is to do some of that yourself, to take care of and minister to yourself first.

We are born with the blessings of health, wealth and happiness, abundance, prosperity and riches. They already are in us. Yet we need to learn how to claim them for ourselves and then stand up so that we create them. We express them in this world and wherever we go in our creation, so that we're in a place that's finishing the karma. Choose to be happy and healthy with what you have. If you can create more that helps, then do that. But we can also have some contentment and appreciation for the blessings that already are.

Karma is addressed in some way in just about every Discourse. The focus is on the law of cause and effect. What is it that we need as experiences for our learning and growth? We need experiences so that we balance out whatever is off, where we're not in harmony and understanding the divine plan.

God created it all perfectly. It's all in perfect order so that we're never in a place that's actually lacking. All the circumstances and the conditions that we ever encounter have something that we can use for our upliftment. One of the aspects of the karma that we all need to realize is it is set up for completion, and that completion would register as a loving consciousness that's honoring, blessing, forgiving, and not holding againstness in any way.

The essence there is that God sets the tone for all of us by loving what it is. Consider that's the truth and not some theory. God's love is real, and it's real for every single person, place and thing.

Discover the Blessings in Your Creatorship

We're all working out our creatorship. So this is the level where we discover and expand our creatorship as divine beings, however long that takes. The more we're doing it as a form where we take the divine energy that comes into us and we issue it forth as an energy, that goes to whatever we're looking at, wherever we are, and whatever we consider.

We can attend to things in the world in ways that are uplifting, honoring and respectful, rather than something negative like a bother or irritation. Negativity often reflects our ignorances. Those are also opportunities for us to wake up, pause and hold while we discover the blessings that are present.

John-Roger gave us one of his great directives about the soul and Soul Transcendence which is to look for the good in all people and things and leave the rest to God. I've said that for me blessing is simply greater good --- taking the unmanifest good and being a vehicle, channel, a person who has the intention to make something better. When we do it through us into the world, that same energy field comes to us from our divine source within, so we too become a greater blessing as we co-create with God.

We step in to a new day, a new opportunity, our intention to follow, to cooperate, to step into this life every day in greater appreciation. We ask to be those who exemplify Your bounty. We can call it forward into the world in ways that people may realize that we are all in a field of glory, a place that has been infused from the beginning with great and ever greater blessings.

FREEDOM TO CHOOSE: TRANSFORMING PRISONERS THROUGH FORGIVENESS

YOU PEOPLE ARE LIKE DINOSAURS: A (VERY, VERY) OLD-FASHIONED PRISON MINISTRY

We have to admit that even though we had co-facilitated 25 Freedom to Choose workshops to more than 2,700 men and women in prison or on parole/probation over the past 10 years, we were somewhat at a loss for words. Is it a good thing when someone calls you a "dinosaur?" Hmm...

"You people are like dinosaurs" one man told us during a large group sharing at our first Freedom to Choose Workshop for Men at Valley State Prison in Chowchilla, California. We have to admit that even though we had co-facilitated 25 *Freedom to Choose* workshops to more than 2,700 men and women in prison or on parole/probation over the past 10 years, we were somewhat at a loss for words. Is it a good thing when someone calls you a "dinosaur?" Hmm...

Before we go any further, we'll give you a little background. We had co-facilitated 20 workshops in women's prisons (the University of Santa Monica Prison Project) and five Freedom to Choose (FTC) workshops in Santa Barbara County for men and women on parole and probation, along with their counselors and criminal justice staff. But this was the first time we had offered a workshop in a men's prison.

In 2010, with the encouragement and blessing of Ron Hulnick, Ph.D., the President of University of Santa Monica (USM), we formed a non-profit corporation, the Freedom to Choose Foundation, to provide the structure and financial support to expand the work that began (and continues) with the USM Prison Project. Our purpose was to respond to the numerous requests to bring this work to men and women in prison, on probation, in addiction recovery, and for at-risk youth. Freedom to Choose Workshops teach skills that are based on the principles and practices of Spiritual Psychology that Drs. Ron & Mary Hulnick have been co-facilitating at USM for the past 35 years. We are faculty members at USM, along with volunteer co-directors of the USM Prison Project and the Freedom to Choose Foundation. It has been our great blessing to answer Spirit's call to service in this way.

The road to this first Freedom to Choose workshop in a men's prison was paved by Spirit. We had worked at this same prison for ten years when it was a women's prison. Over the years as we talked with officials in the criminal justice system, one of the most oft-re-

peated comments was: "It's very nice that you work with women, but the important question is *will it work with men?*" Our favorite answer has always been to laugh and say, "Men are people too!" If we had any doubts, this project proved it.

After Valley State Prison was converted to a men's prison, we received an invitation from the new warden to offer a program for male inmates. We spent time deeply listening for Spirit's guidance, and then we explored the idea by meeting with a core group of 15 inmates to learn if they might be interested in this type of work. By the end of a one-hour conversation, their one question was: "How soon can you start?" As we continued to ask for inner guidance, we noticed that every time we considered the project or spoke to anyone about it, our hearts filled to overflowing with joy. We have learned to trust that as guidance from Spirit, so we took it as feedback to "go forward!"

We scheduled our first workshop a few months later. In November, 2013 we worked with 75 inmates, men who are primarily inmate facilitators of self-help groups such as Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, etc. Our team of 35 USM graduate volunteers joined us for two-day workshop in Rumi's field. Few of us had worked with male inmates before, and we didn't know what would happen. It was a leap of faith.

When the male inmate said to us, "You people are like dinosaurs" during group sharing on the first day of our workshop, we didn't know quite what to say. Our minds immediately jumped to a couple of possible interpretations: "Does this mean I'm old fashioned and out-of-date? Do I need to pick up a book on aging gracefully? Have I been eating too many leafy greens—a.k.a. I'm starting to resemble a brontosaurus?" But fortunately our "Inner Facilitators" recognized the opportunity for demonstrating a communication skill we had worked with earlier that day. So, instead we asked, "That's interesting, can you say a

little bit about what that means?" The male inmate participant went on to explain that, "I've heard about people like you, I've read about people like you – just like I've heard and read about dinosaurs – but I never thought people like you existed, so genuine and loving."

Here's what the men shared with us:

"This weekend has been one of those events that is a turning point in my life. I've run into some issues that I protected most of my life. With what you guys did... in two days I accomplished more than in 14 or 15 years."

"I don't care what religion we practice but what I do know is that it was a beautiful spirit that was here and I know we connected with all you people. I can't put a price on this. This will forever be embedded in my spirit."

"I did go back to my room and share what happened and a lot of people said, 'Sign me up!' I tried to explain how it felt to look in your eyes and feel no judgment and share with compassion. Reminded me of the Island of Misfit Toys in the Rudolph movie: Ya give 'em a little love and they start working and functioning."

The next question we heard from the volunteers and the men of Valley State Prison is: "When are you coming back?" Our all-volunteer organization is exploring ways to support the expansion of this heartfelt work and to once again, answer the call of Spirit in this way. FREEDOM TO CHOOSE:

TRANSFORMING PRISONERS THROUGH FORGIVENESS

An interview with

David Paul, M.D., Ph.D. & Bonnie Paul, Ph.D.

NDH: *What's the basic aim or goal of the Freedom to Choose Workshop?*

DP: What comes forward for me is “to share the healing power that comes through God’s loving.” We help people do that by teaching them skills that help them connect with the loving part of themselves, with who they are as Spirit inside. We do that mainly through forgiveness of judgments and also by holding a clear focus for Spirit to do its work.

NDH: *Do you do this workshop outside the prisons as well?*

DP: We’ve done workshops outside of prison in Santa Barbara county, for people on probation and parole, and for people in addiction recovery and for their counselors simultaneously. And they were very successful.

NDH: *Does the workshop differ when it's done outside of prison?*

DP: Yes, we do some programs that are very similar, and some different programs outside the prison, but the response is similar.

NDH: *And what are the basic methods that you're using?*

DP: We do a combination of mini-lectures, questions and answers, large group sharings, and trio processes. When possible we translate all our handouts into Spanish and do simultaneous Spanish interpretation, using similar equipment to what MSIA uses.

We’re very clear that we’re holding a loving space for Spirit to do its work. We meet with our volunteer team—all of them USM graduates—and we spend about four to five hours orienting them. We set a very clear intention that our primary mission, and the highest thing we can do, is to hold in the loving and be in acceptance while we teach some skills. We do our best to model the skills ourselves and walk the talk. We want to “be the change that we want to see in the world.”

There’s a whole lot of science behind why that’s effective, dealing with the fact that people learn unconsciously by imitation. This is hardwired into the brain through the mirror neuron system. When we’re hold-



ing in the loving, our actions are speaking so loudly that it doesn’t matter so much what we say. It does matter to a certain extent because we are teaching people skills that they can use in their daily lives, but while we do that we’re demonstrating the value of that work. We’re holding a container of loving and everyone is very clear that we’re in selfless service.

We do our best to have Spirit work through us. We set an intention for one accord in all our teams, which very often occurs. It helps lift everyone who comes in. The energy in the room is so palpable that first-time participants come in and they notice it. Our volunteers leave with much more than they ever expected to get. People fly in from both coasts and even other countries, and we have a consistent waiting list.

In the men’s prison workshop that we recently did, we had men standing up saying, “I was given this pass to come to this workshop not knowing what it was, and I work all week and didn’t want to give up my weekend. I wasn’t planning to stay, but the loving in the room was so strong that I thought, ‘I’ve got to stay here.’” Of the 80 men who got passes to attend, 75 showed up and all 75 stayed for the whole weekend. That’s remarkable. We felt like fronds of kelp waving around in this ocean of love and mercy. That’s the only way I can describe it.

BP: We have some MSIA ministers who join our team, but they are not in the majority. And yet everyone comes together and holds in the loving. It’s such a great demonstration of how J-R says that the only ministry is the ministry of love.

NDH: *What kinds of changes do you see in people?*

BP: The most remarkable thing is watching people who are completely closed when they come in. As the workshop progresses, they have this incredulous look on their faces like, “I can’t believe what’s happening to me.” Some say that they’ve been in prison for twenty, thirty, or forty years and they’ve never told their story to anyone. The opportunity to share who they are and what they’ve been through in a nonjudgmental environment makes such a difference. They open up and they share their hearts and their softness. Even the men in this latest workshop said things like, “I can’t believe that I cried. We don’t

cry in here. You just don’t do that in a men’s prison. But here we are doing that.” Once someone experiences that it’s truly transformative. They let go of their judgments of themselves. So many of the participants said things like, “I felt like I wasn’t in prison this weekend.”

There’s so much in the prison culture that supports people’s belief system that there is something wrong with them, that they’re the “bad” people and the people in the “free world” as they call it are the “good” people. The way we designed the workshop is that all the assistants go into the trios. This was one of those “Spirit coincidences” that happened by accident in the first workshop when we miscounted the number of participants. But we found that it levels the playing field, and as we share authentically about our own challenges, it dissolves the illusion that the teacher is at the front of the room and has it all figured out. They get to see that we’re all the same, we all have similar challenges, and we all feel the same pain and joy.

DP: Bonnie and I demonstrate how to do the processes in front of the class and we work with our own real issues. It’s authentic. We’ve been told that that is helpful for people because we are together for such a brief time: 2 or 3 days. I’ve never seen anything like the kind of transformation that can happen in that short period of time. A lot of the women take the workshop over and over again, and we watch them transform over the years. We had been doing this work for around eight years, when a woman stood up to share who was a gang enforcer, and she used her gang name, we’ll call it X so we don’t use her actual gang name, and she said, “You know, X has hurt a lot of people in this room and I want you to know that X apologizes to anyone that she’s hurt. And I want you to know that my real name is Susan (again I’ve changed the name) and I’ve been using drugs since I was eight years old. And I’ve stopped. But I stopped growing when I started using drugs, so right now inside I’m eight years old. And I could use a hug.” And then another inmate raised her hand and said, “I want to give Susan a hug, can I do that?” And the whole room cheered.

We’ve asked the women what they experience: More than 90% experience more peace, less conflict, and less violence. Over 80% of the women have taught the skills to at least one other person. We write the handouts so all the processes are step-by-step so people can take them back to their cells and share them with others. That’s often how we get people into the next workshop. It transformed the culture in the prison yard in Valley State Prison for Women, where

we worked for ten years. It has since been converted to a men’s prison, and that’s where we did our first workshop for men.

After we started doing this, a large number of the women started self-help groups. A lot of the culture shifted to one of service where the “lifers” taught women who were “short-termers” how to succeed when they got out. Pretty amazing—and we have a front-row seat.

NDH: *Have you been able to document some of these long-term changes?*

DP: The State does not give us any information so we can’t do any long-term academic studies. Even the re-entry committee can’t get information from the State about the people who are assigned to them. And we’re all volunteers, although we just hired our first part-time person, a former inmate.

We think that our program works so well because it reduces the propensity for shame. Guilt is a judgment about what one has done. Shame is a judgment about oneself. And we work directly with the forgiveness of the judgments of oneself. Although we can’t get detailed reports about the people who are still in prison other than anecdotal information, we’ve talked to a lot of the women who have been released from prison, and they consistently mention how the forgiveness skills they’ve learned have reduced the shame that was motivating their addiction and their violence. We just wrote a mini-paper comparing the Freedom to Choose workshop with other prisoner rehabilitation programs. A study was just published in January that showed that people with high levels of shame are more likely to re-offend because the shame drives violence and blame, and prevents people from taking responsibility. I don’t know of any other program that effectively deals with this.

NDH: *You’ve just completed the first workshop in a men’s prison. How does it differ from doing it in a women’s prison?*

DP: When we did the first women’s prison project, I said if I would have had expectations about the program they would have been exceeded, and with the men’s program I would say they were exceeded by several orders of magnitude. The loving and the presence of Spirit were so strong, and that was com-

pletely unexpected. The response was universal that this was the best thing they had experienced, and there was no holding back in the workshop. They took the tools and they used them effectively. It was like watching people who were given a glass of water after being in the desert for forty years. We heard comments pretty consistently that were like, “I learned more here in two days than I did in twenty years of programs.” I think that their receptiveness and ability to use the skills that were taught to them was even greater than the women.

BP: The men were also more orderly, which was very unexpected for us.

DP: In the women’s prison it takes three assistants to help people in the group find their seats. There is resistance and disorder, and they want to be with their friends and not be split up from each other. In the men’s program they didn’t need any of this kind of assistance. It was like a regular classroom. We’d say, “Find a new trio partner,” and it was done quickly without any fuss. It was way easier and as a result we had more time for sharing, which is an opportunity for people to stand up and let Spirit lift all that stuff. And they really went for it. When they went back to their cells people asked them, “What are you on? What’s going on over there? Whatever it is I want it.” And the word got out pretty fast.

BP: One man stood up and told us that he had been in prison for over twenty years, had grown up in inner city gangs and had developed and facilitated a lot of self-help workshops in prison, but this was different from anything else he had done. He said that self-forgiveness was the “juice” that would supercharge all of the other programs.

Other anger-management programs use awareness and mindfulness, and are aimed at reducing anger behavior, but not at really working with the issue underpinning the anger. A lot of the participants aren’t even aware of the issues underneath the anger. We taught them, “when you get angry, here’s what’s really going on.”

We’ve all heard so much about men in prison, and there’s so much stigma attached to that, and I had some trepidations going in. But when I heard them sharing so openly on the first day, I thought, “If this is what men in prison are capable of, there’s great hope for the planet.”

DP: In the women’s prison we developed a way for the inmates to be of service to their peers. We gave them advanced training programs and many of them have become very skilled, they serve as mentors for new participants. They became the leaders and role models for their peers. The people who are in for life set the tone for the prison, and that’s what created the transformation at the women’s prison. When the State of California got some funding to train some of the inmates to be drug and alcohol counselors, almost every one of them was a mentor in our program. The mentoring approach worked so well that we’re looking to do the same thing with the men, so that we have people within the prison who can keep it going between. The ability to be aware of and work with emotions and resolve the ones that are negative and destructive is something we want to see as an ongoing practice within the prisons.

NDH: *What are the differences in doing a workshop in a prison and outside of a prison?*

DP: Two major differences: The logistics of doing a workshop in a prison are several orders of magnitude more difficult because of the security precautions. Every volunteer goes through a screening process and every piece of equipment has to be itemized and inspected (a whole truck full of sound equipment and other supplies for 350 people, with every battery and wire counted going in and counted going out). Also, the time we have to do the workshop is more limited because of the prison timetable.

It’s a challenging environment, and some of the prisons have a culture of punishment. At one recent workshop the women prisoners who were mentors arrived early, and some of the correctional officers didn’t think that was a good idea, so the women were taken out, locked behind a gate in a different area, and taunted by the officers to get them to react so they could be locked down and prevented from going to the workshop. The women said they used their skills from the program so that they didn’t react, and eventually they were allowed to go.

But once you’re in the workshop, there is no difference inside or outside of the prison. There’s the same level of transformation.

BP: Outside of the prison we were able to invite some of the criminal justice system support staff, so we had alcohol and drug counselors, police officers,

parole and probation officers, along with ex-prisoners, and we mixed everybody together. At first there was some reluctance, but once they got in and started to talk with one another there was so much healing that occurred for all. Everyone got to experience that everyone else was just like them, not a stereotype or role. It created an opportunity for the dissolution of prejudices and stereotypes. That's something that is not allowed within the prison.

DP: Outside of prison there were actually a lot of people who attended the workshop involuntarily. Bosses or parole officers said they had to go or there would be consequences. But at the end, 95% of the participants said they would take the workshop again and recommend it to someone else. The biggest issue we heard about in the non-prison community workshops was, "Can't you do more, more often, in more places?"

NDH: *How has the program changed or evolved since you started?*

DP: It's been a constant evolution. Every time we do the program we ask, "What did we learn, how can we do it better, how can we rewrite this?" Bonnie and I both have had training in quality improvement. I was a quality improvement consultant and Bonnie has done that kind of work in manufacturing. So we're continuously improving.

BP: The main way that the workshops have shifted since the beginning is that we work more with the actual language that the prisoners use, and we use examples and stories that they connect to. These are things we learned as we came to know about how they live and the challenges they face. They have taught us what needs to be done. A long time ago a mentor of mine said, "Your students will show you what to teach." It's been a great co-creative experience.

NDH: *What's your biggest challenge in doing these workshops?*

DP: The biggest challenge is funding. If we had more funding we could do more workshops.

BP: The biggest challenge in the prison is the lack of cooperation in getting people to the workshops on time. It makes it difficult to start on time. It's routine that we could start an hour late—or more.

NDH: *What's your biggest personal challenge in doing these workshops?*

BP: For me, it was challenging at first to face my fears of being in the prison. I would have nightmares, even though when I was actually there I felt completely safe, and never threatened at all. It was an ongoing challenge for me to discern between my fears and my inner guidance telling me if the situation was safe or unsafe. Also I had a terror of speaking in public. My voice would get choked and that fear was exacerbated by being in the prison. It was a great personal journey to move through that fear and to express it, which was the last thing I wanted to do, but ironically it helped the prisoners feel more connected to me—much to my surprise.

Now when I stand up in front of the group in the prison I feel relaxed and happy to be there. And I'm grateful to the women in the prison for helping me to work through all that.

DP: For myself, I would say that when we started I was really nervous. It's not the kind of teaching I was used to, even though I had spoken before large groups before, giving medical talks to over 1,000 people. But this was different. It was about transparency. Early in the workshops I was buzzing with the intense energy and I had to learn how to adjust to that. I just set very clear intentions to be open and authentic. We're working with real issues, even crying on stage if that's present, and my love of doing this work was strong enough to move me through the fear I felt about feeling exposed and vulnerable.

For me it's been a transformational process related to tuning into my inner guidance in how Spirit works with me, and trusting that. That's translated into all areas of my life. Now I'm very aware of Spirit's guidance when I'm working with someone. It's rather incredible. It's a direct knowing, and I'm still growing in my ability to attune.

NDH: *What would it take to get the program more widely adopted?*

DP: Data. Data regarding the effectiveness of the program.

BP: If we had additional funding a lot of places would accept it without the data.

DP: We've had invitations that we have not been able to respond to because there's no way we can do that as an all-volunteer organization.

BP: The prison systems will not pay for it unless we have the data. We've had many invitations to do it as a volunteer project. They would love that.

DP: Preparation takes hundreds of hours every time we do one of these. We've tracked it. Plus all the expenses, which are now covered by the foundation. At least there are enough donations now that it's self-sustaining for two workshops a year. To go past that it needs to transform from all-volunteer to full-time staff because it takes so much work to put one of these things together.

We have a garage full of storage for equipment and handouts. We start preparation months before the workshop. We have job descriptions for 90 people, assistants and facilitators, who come to work together, often for the first time. That takes training and coordination, and it all has to be communicated to the assistants in one orientation the day before the workshop starts. Somehow it always works out.

Because of the difficulty of getting the data from the California State system, we're hoping to do a retrospective study with people who are now out of prison. Retrospective studies are what sparked the early studies on smoking. Once we have retrospective studies we can start to draw some inferences about causation, and maybe get some funding. For example if we can get data to support the inference that self-forgiveness reduces shame levels, then we might have the basis for a prospective study. Then we might be able to introduce these skills into existing programs and measure the outcomes. That's the next step.

We've always felt like we're stewards of this project. We're holding the space for it. And at some point it's going to have a life of its own because if the work is really good it will get out there. But it might be someone else whose mission it is to do this work. It's a tremendous ministry and service project, and it needs professionals to take it to the next step. We're starting to train our first facilitators-in-training. We've never trained facilitators and they've never facilitated, so it's a learning experience for everyone.

There are so many possibilities. We'd like to expand this work into the other women's prisons in California. I'd like to see this program get into the California county jails, which are becoming mini-prisons without services, and powder kegs of violence. There are so many possibilities.

BP: This is a fun little image: Imagine if instead of people going to prison and being shamed for it, they learned to take personal responsibility to do self-forgiveness and how get their lives back on track?

NDH: *And what's been your biggest win in this work?*

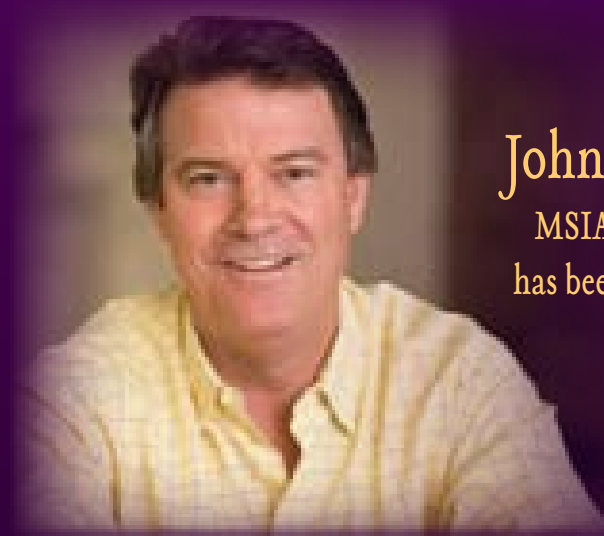
BP: For me it's the freedom to be myself that I've found in this process. I feel tremendously more safe in the world because I've gotten to meet all kinds of different people that before I had been afraid of. It's also a fulfillment of what I intended when I decided to become a minister—to help people transform into their true selves. The fulfillment for me in my ministry is off the charts. The ability to do that in such a deep and profound way is extraordinary.

DP: Mine is parallel but different. My biggest personal win (which I think of more as a consequence than a "win") is that I now have a tremendous trust in Spirit's guidance in each moment. I'm very comfortable with having Spirit in charge and having my mind figure it out later, because my mind's track record is not nearly as good as Spirit's. My biggest win is to trust that. From my perspective, it's like, "OK, Spirit, what would you have us do next?" Let's see what happens.

IWP's Second
"Planting a Tree for Peace"
Event in Caracas
Venezuela!

On Sunday, February 9, IWP Rep Vania Grimalt and other peacemakers gathered in the garden of the Simon Bolivar University to plant IWP's second tree for peace in Caracas. Here's her report:



It was Sunday, February 2. For this second planting in Caracas, Venezuela, it was a very cloudy day. The day started out with some uncertainty, because there was supposed to be a protest at the University that day due to the conditions that the employees are going through. We moved the time of the gathering earlier so that we could hopefully do the planting. Then, there was an accident that happened that morning with the rupture of a toxic waste disposal about 2.5 miles from where the tree was going to be planted, so everyone was moved out of the area, and the protest was cancelled. The planting was good to go.

We were the only ones allowed to be there. Simon Bolivar University is one of the top higher education institutions in Venezuela and one of the top 50 in Latin America, specializing in Engineering and Sciences. It is also known by its beautiful gardens, having had a tree planted by the Dalai Lama in 1990 and a garden designed by the Venezuelan and international kinetic artist Cruz-Diez. It is located in the Sartenejas Valley at the outskirts of Caracas, and it has a mild climate in addition to being isolated from the hurries of the city.

The tree that we planted was given to us by the University gardeners, and we were asked to bring plastics bags as a donation for the gardeners to help keep the area clean. The place we were assigned was by the main entrance of the University. From an aerial view, it makes a triangle with the tree planting by the Dalai Lama and the art garden.

We started by calling in the Light, chanting 3 *Ani-Hu's* and visualizing a column of Light, Love and Peace that surrounded, filled and protected us. Then we did the planting and surrounded the tree in a circle, placing qualities of peace to spread out to the city, the country and the whole world. The rock with the inscription "**Peace is Present**" –John-Roger, D.S.S was set by the tree, facing

east to witness the rising of the sun and to create peace within every heart.

The Rector Coordinator was present, and she explained to us that they would plant yellow flowers at the foot of the tree to celebrate peace in the world.

The tree donated was a Bucare, described as an invaluable shading resource for coffee and cocoa. They are also often used to make living fences, since they are readily cut. With their handsome orange-red flowers, they are also sometimes planted as an ornament. The flowers of the tree can be eaten in salads and soups. So this tree has quite a range of possible uses.

After we finished we enjoyed a delicious tea, coffee and lemon pie! Peace was once again present as we manifested our sweet intention to celebrate together the planting of a tree for Peace.

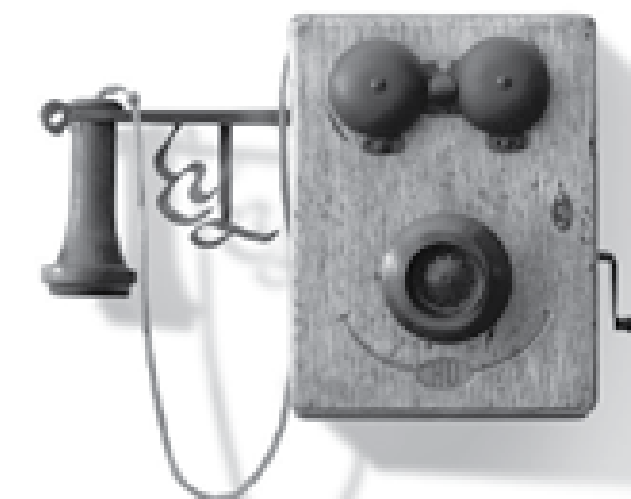

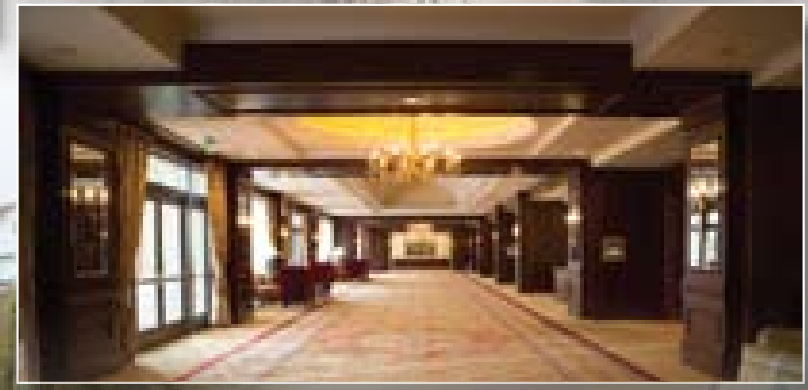
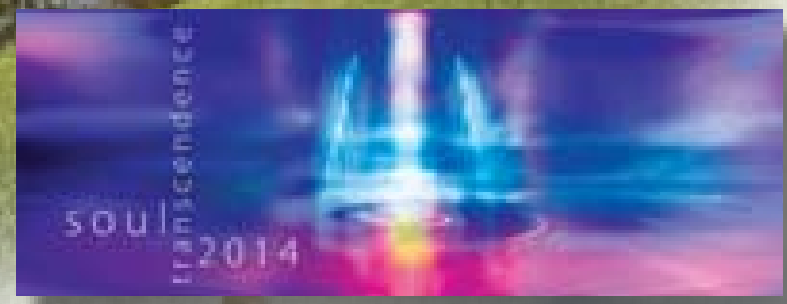

MINISTRIES AROUND THE WORLD

The New Day Herald is pleased to launch a new profile series that highlights the amazing, inspiring ministries of our global MSIA family. The first minister to be interviewed is Rev. Sina Skates, who currently lives with her family in Birmingham, Alabama, and has taken a leadership role in connecting MSIAers worldwide via social media.

Rev. Sina Skates Shining the Light in Alabama by Teri Breier

New Day Herald: *Thank you for your willingness to share about your ministry, Sina. What is the essence of your ministry?*

Sina Skates: The biggest part of my ministry is being true to the light of the Christ and the Traveler within me, and sharing that through what I do in this world. "When you've done it to the least one of these, you've done it unto me." That's a huge part of my intention and how I share my ministry with the world.

NDH: *How long have you been an MSIA minister?*

SS: I was ordained in December 2003 in Los Angeles, having moved there from Boston two years earlier.

NDH: *In L.A., you were on staff at MSIA, is that right?*

SS: Yes, I worked on staff full-time for almost 5 years until I left in 2006 when my first child was born. My husband and I moved to his hometown of Birmingham, Alabama and had three children in three years. My ministry then shifted to taking care of our family for a while. As a mother I changed my point of view on what was really important. In having children, I realized that nothing is more important than them—sharing my love with them and with the people in my life and my MSIA family.

NDH: *That's a beautiful awareness. What happened next?*

SS: A few years later, when I was finally coming up for air, I approached Vincent Dupont about getting involved with some volunteer service. He mentioned a new online project MSIA was work-

ing on, which was an inspirational blog called "Simply Spiritual Living" (www.SimplySpiritual-Living.org). Vincent, Debbie Roth and myself met on the phone and basically I was given the reigns of the creative content for the associated Facebook page, while another stellar volunteer was in charge of the promotional aspects of the website itself. I started using a photo technique of putting the quotes on top of beautiful images taken from our Windermere calendars, the Living in Grace retreat and other MSIA events. This made a huge impact on the site and we grew from about three thousand likes to more than 100,000 likes in about a year and a half. Through the virality of the posts and our awesome marketing from volunteers, we actually reach anywhere from 200,000–600,000 people each week. With all these people getting

touched by the Light of the Traveler and sharing these posts and inspirational messages, it's a huge blessing to be a part of this project.

NDH: *I really love seeing the SSL Facebook posts go viral...I have even noticed some of my non-MSIA friends somehow finding and sharing them! I believe you also participate in other MSIA-related Facebook pages?*

SS: Oh yeah! In fact, most folks tend to see me on Facebook through the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness group, which I help moderate, and through the Baruch Bashan Network, which was originally called the Friends of MSIA, but was renamed in February due to some confusion between the two groups.

For me, the gift of volunteer service is around the process of releasing karma and healing. There is also so much joy in what I get to do... I truly appreciate having so much play in my life. I really don't see what I do as very special. There are so many other ministers doing amazing service around the world. I'm just grateful to be involved...

NDH: *What was the confusion about?*

SS: Primarily, the Movement of Spiritual Inner Awareness Facebook group is sponsored by MSIA, while the Baruch Bashan Network (BBN) is a volunteer-run group. While the MSIA group is geared to share about MSIA, our experience of the teachings of Soul Transcendence and to ask for the Light, the BBN was created as a space for marketing and networking among our community. It is a way for us all to connect regarding business promotions, ride shares, places to stay during Conference, requests for giving or receiving, and sharing advice, recipes, home remedies, etc., within our community. I couldn't have started the BBN without you, Teri, and I wouldn't have done it without your support as a sounding board and co-visionary for the group.

NDH: *Thank you, Sina, it is a blessing to be a part of this wonderful online community.*

SS: I think that we have built a really beautiful space to support people in their ministries through this group. Because the group is smaller, it feels more intimate and creates a space for getting to know others on a deeper level. We can follow along with the ups and downs with people's projects and ministries and what's going on and really build a sense of community in that way. I enjoy getting a wide variety of participation with folks who are looking for feedback and physical (or otherwise) support from the community.

NDH: *How do you experience your "social media" ministry overall?*

SS: I like to say that this is really a selfish choice for me...Living way out in Birmingham, AL, somewhat isolated from the large Los Angeles community that I grew up in, I wanted a way to stay connected with folks. Being a part of these groups and monitoring the posts has kept me really connected to everyone. I'm so blessed because I get messages all day long of light and loving and support. Even if they are "for" me, I allow myself to take all that in and bear witness to our incredible support system for each other online.

NDH: *Are there other ways that you are being of service out there in Alabama?*

SS: Not only am I still doing the mom thing with my kids, and the wife thing with my husband, but I also teach weekly ballet and creative movement to about 350 children ages 1-12. One of the biggest blessings in my life is having the opportunity to work with very young children, aged 1-3, who have severe mental and physical disabilities, and other children who are at risk for developmental delays. I'm not even sure I could say this is my ministry...when in reality it is their ministry for me and for all the volunteers who work with these children on a weekly basis through this early intervention program.

I have also had the opportunity to write children's musicals with a professional theatre company. Even though I get paid to write these musicals, I see it as an extension of my ministry. The musicals I write contain messages of the light and loving. My latest show features characters who learn how to be true to themselves—it's what is on the inside that counts and when you take that step to face your fears you become free inside; there's a lightness that comes over you. I'm about to start work on a

new show that tells the story of a classic folk hero from a feminist perspective, which also addresses the theme of bullying. This runs very deep and is so healing for me, because I was bullied as a child. As I share these blessings through my work, I am also touched personally with this ministry, in this and in each of my shows.

NDH: *Sina, I find your ministry to be so creative and inspiring. What blessings do you receive as you are giving your time and energy and essence?*

SS: In living my life, I realized that I was afraid to be myself (in some situations), and I didn't know if I was worthy of love. I wasn't being true to myself, but I found my voice through this authentic expression of myself through my writing and through creating the content on the Simply Spiritual Living site. I found my self-worth and my confidence.

For me, the gift of volunteer service is around the process of releasing karma and healing. There is also so much joy in what I get to do... I truly appreciate having so much play in my life. I really don't see what I do as very special. There are so many other ministers doing amazing service around the world. I'm just grateful to be involved with the projects that I'm doing. The connection for me is so far greater than anything else. Service gives me so much more than I could ever give back. I'm so grateful for all of it.

NDH: *Is there anything else you would like to share with our global MSIA family?*

SS: We are all drawn to MSIA for different reasons—perhaps we are sensitive to the "light" energy. Perhaps we all want to see the good in this world and make this our heaven on earth. Perhaps we have answered that calling within us to follow the light and sound and make our way home to God. Our stories are all unique, but we all answer that same calling from within. And as a ministry I see that calling is to be of service to the Light where we are needed. Service for me is like walking, talking spiritual exercises. It's a part of who I am. If I can help, I will. If I can be of service, I will. And the Light takes us at our willingness and gives us the ability to do. It's the Light that does the work through us, and if we can get out of our own way...miracles can happen. And all of a sudden you find yourself being a part of something much larger than you could have ever possibly dreamed.

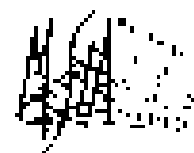

INITIATION

If you are just starting the Soul Awareness Discourses, Discourse #1 explains initiation into the Sound Current. You may choose to study the Discourses with the intention to be initiated on this path, or to simply read them as information. If you do choose to study toward initiation, the Traveler works with you more closely, and you may notice a greater spiritual awareness in your own consciousness as this work goes on.

If you are studying toward initiation, you need to write and mail a letter to the Traveler that this is your intention. If you have written and mailed your intention to the Traveler, you can apply for initiation when you have completed Discourse 24.

THE MSIA MINISTRY

The MSIA ministry is for initiates of the Traveler who are called inwardly to serve the spirit of their hearts.

Service may be in any form, from volunteering for the Church to assisting people in need or organizations that serve those people, and anything in between. The only requirement is that the ministry is active and done regularly.

MSIA ministers may perform services, like marriages, that clergy of other denominations are authorized to do as long as they comply with the laws of the locality in which they serve.

People who have received initiation into the Sound Current through the Traveler may request an Application for Ordination packet from:

WRITING TO J-R & JOHN

Sometimes people reading Discourses, especially those studying toward initiation, want to write to John Morton or John-Roger. Writing often helps you let go of a troubling situation and open more to the Traveler’s assistance inwardly.

As soon as you write to John Morton or John-Roger, they get the message on the spiritual levels, and they do what Spirit allows. Then, to let go of the situation in your consciousness, you burn or mail your letter. Whether you burn or mail what you wrote, you may find that you get your answers on the inner levels, sometimes very quickly. You may also experience greater calm, clarity, or peace, which can help you go through whatever challenges you face.

We suggest that you place the situation in the Light, ask for clarification during s.e.’s, dreams, etc., and then look for the answers within you. Often reading a Discourse or listening to an MSIA tape (either at home or at a seminar) will provide keys to assist you in handling your situation. You can also refer to any of the numerous books by J-R and John to find information that relates to what you are dealing with. These two have shared so much with us over the years, and we encourage you to send your letters via e-mail, using these addresses:

If you live in the United States and if you send your letter to J-R or John in hard copy via the mail, you need to include a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) if you want a reply from either of them.

Many hundreds of people write personal letters each month to J-R and John, so please note that even if you do send a letter by e-mail or if you do send in an SASE with your letter, you may not receive a response back. This does not imply that your concern is not important or that you are being ignored. There simply may be no need for a physical reply, or there may be no answer available to you at the time you write.

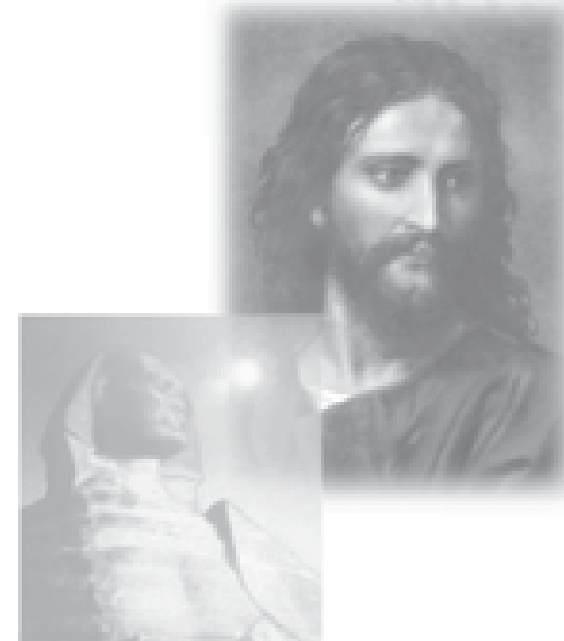
